In game two of the week, Muffley once again hit the game winner; this time a jumper with seven seconds left on the clock to give the Tomcats a 65-64 victory over W&J. It was the first win for the Tomcats over the Presidents in Greenville in 11 years. Muffley averaged 12.5 points and 5.0 rebounds on the week.

**THOMAS MORE RANKED NO. 1:** Thomas More extended its season-opening winning streak to 19 games last week with a pair of PAC wins ... The Saints were named the top-ranked team in both Division III national polls last week ... It's the first time in Thomas More history that any athletic team has been ranked No. 1 in the nation ... The Saints defeated Chatham, 90-40, the day after being ranked No. 1 and then defeated Westminster, 53-37, in their first road game as being the No. 1-ranked team.

**NEWS AND NOTES:** Christine Slater led Grove City with 23 points while Megan Gebrosky had 11 in a 63-55 win over W&J ... Thomas More's Nicole Dickman and Moriah Corey led the Saints in scoring last week with 10.5 ppg ... Saint Vincent was led by Maria Baroffio's 20 pts, while Brittany Sedlock tallied her seventh double-double of the year with 16 pts and 14 rebounds vs. Westminster ... Kelly Barzak led the way for Thiel with 18 points and 10 rebounds and Ashley Davis chipped in 16 vs. W&J.

**AROUND THE LEAGUE:** Christine Carugati scored 21 points for Geneva in a victory at Bethany ... Kayla Taormina led all scorers with 17 pts and grabbed 10 boards in Bethany's win over Waynesburg ... Westminster's Gabby Holko averaged 9.5 ppg last week ... Waynesburg's Elisha Jones averaged a team-high 16 ppg last week ... Courtney Walsh led W&J with 15 pts, and added four rebounds off the bench vs. Grove City ... Against Thomas More, Courtney Smith scored 14 points for Chatham.

# PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

## Bethany Bison (9-10, 4-6 PAC)



The Bison went 1-1 last week, including a big road win at Waynesburg ... Bethany trailed the Jackets by 9 in the 2<sup>nd</sup> half before rallying and **Tara Harris** scored the final 5 pts of the game to lift BC to a 63-59 win ... **Kayla Taormina** led all scorers with 17 pts and grabbed 10 boards for her 2<sup>nd</sup> double-double of the year, while Harris' big finish gave her a season-high 16 pts ... Bethany finished with a 47-23 advantage on the boards over Waynesburg, who leads the PAC in rebounding ... The Bison led Geneva by 3 at halftime, but the GTs shot 60 percent in the 2<sup>nd</sup> half to come back for an 82-70 win ... **Anne Wilson** led the Green and White with 17 pts and **Katelynn Hackathorn** posted 14 markers and 8 boards.

## Chatham Cougars (6-13, 2-9 PAC)



The Cougars tipped off against two nationally ranked teams in Presidents' Athletic Conference (PAC) play this week ... The defending champions, the Thomas More Saints, earned their first victory at the top spot 90-40 over the visiting Cougars on Tuesday ... The Saints shot an astounding 62% from the field en route to victory ... Leading Chatham was senior guard **Courtney Smith**, who finished the game with a high 14 pts ... On Saturday, the Cougars hosted #22 St. Vincent College and fell 69-46 ... Sophomore **Colleen Kiss** finished with a team-high 12 pts on 5-12 shooting from the field ... Senior **Felicia Brown** also scored in double digits, finishing with 10 pts and tying a career-high. Kiss also grabbed six rebounds in the loss.

## Geneva Golden Tornadoes (8-11)



After suffering one of the most heartbreaking defeats Wednesday, Geneva showed tremendous character in going on the road to defeat Bethany 82-70 on Saturday ... Wednesday, Geneva's 11-point second half lead disappeared, only to have **Christine Carugati** knock down a 28-footer with 0.2 seconds remaining in regulation to tie the game ... In the ensuing celebration, the officials issued a technical foul on Geneva for leaving the bench with time left on the clock ... Thiel won the game 68-66 but the GTs found some motivation after the loss ... Saturday, Carugati scored 21 points while teammates **Alyse Scarsella** and **Valerie Hamilton** each posted 17 in Geneva's victory at Bethany.

## Grove City Wolverines (10-9, 6-5 PAC)



Grove City went 1-1 in a pair of road PAC games ... The Wolverines opened the week with a 63-55 win at W&J ... Grove City led by as many as 22 points in the second half ... The Wolverines shot 17-of-28 (61%) from the field in the first half ... **Christine Slater** led Grove City with 23 points while **Megan Gebrosky** had 11 ... **Alison Wells** set a new single-game school record with eight blocked shots ... **Leah Gibson** handed out eight assists ... GCC has won two straight games at W&J ... Saturday, Grove City fell a game behind Waynesburg in the race for third place in the PAC as the host Jackets earned a 58-44 home win over Grove City ... Slater (15) and Gebrosky (10) led Grove City in scoring.

## Saint Vincent Bearcats (17-2, 10-1 PAC)



The 22<sup>nd</sup> ranked Bearcats improved to 17-2 on the year, and 10-1 in the PAC, with wins over Westminster and Chatham ... In the 82-46 triumph over the Titans, SVC jumped to a 25-5 lead midway through the first half, enroute to a 47-19 halftime lead ... Four players scored in double-figures for the Bearcats, led by **Maria Baroffio's** 20 pts, while **Brittany Sedlock** tallied her seventh double-double of the year with 16 pts and 14 rebounds ... The Bearcats used tough defense in their 69-46 win on Saturday over the Cougars, limiting the hosts to just a 26 percent showing from the floor and forcing 18 turnovers ... Sedlock had a game-high 20 pts with nine rebounds, while **Devin McGrath** added 16.

## Thiel Tomcats (5-14, 3-7 PAC)



Thiel won back-to-back games for the first time this season as **Kelly Muffley** made game winning shots in both games last week ... Against Geneva, a technical foul on the GTs with just 0.2 seconds left sent Muffley to the line, where she knocked down the pair to give the Tomcats the 68-66 win ... In the second game of the week, Muffley once again came up big in the clutch as she hit a base-line jumper with just seven seconds to go, giving the Tomcats a 65-64 win over W&J ... **Kelly Barzak** led the way for Thiel with 18 points and 10 rebounds and **Ashley Davis** chipped in with 16 pts of her own ... It is the first two-game win streak for Thiel since the 2008-09 season.

## Thomas More Saints (19-0, 11-0 PAC)



Thomas More extended its season-opening winning streak to 19 games with a pair of PAC wins ... The Saints were named the top-ranked team in both Division III national polls last week ... The Saints defeated Chatham, 90-40, the day after being ranked No. 1 and then defeated Westminster, 53-37, in their first road game as being the No. 1-ranked team ... **Nicole Dickman** and **Moriah Corey** led the team in scoring last week as they each averaged 10.5 ppg ... Dickman also led the team on the boards as she averaged 6.0 rpg, while **Devin Beasley** led the team in assists with six and **Lauren Hargett** led the team in steals with four.

## Washington & Jefferson Presidents (8-11, 5-5 PAC)



W&J dropped both its games last week ... W&J fell 63-55 to Grove City Wednesday... Grove City caught fire from the field, dropping in 42 points on 61% shooting in the first half ... **Courtney Walsh** led W&J with 15 points and four rebounds off the bench ... **Catlyn Kriston** made three shots from beyond the arc to finish with nine points ... W&J dropped a heartbreaking 65-64 game at Thiel Saturday ... W&J rallied from nine down with 4:31 remaining to take a 64-63 lead with 17 seconds left, but a Thiel basket with seven seconds remaining doomed the Presidents ... **Ashley Kirkpatrick** scored a team-high 12 points ... **Vanessa Rivera** scored six points and dished out five assists.

## Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (14-5, 7-4 PAC)



The Waynesburg women's basketball team split a pair of home PAC contests this week and maintained control of third place in the conference standings ... After dropping a disappointing four-point loss to Bethany on Wednesday, the Yellow Jackets bounced back with a solid 58-44 victory over Grove City on Saturday ... With the win, the Yellow Jackets snapped a seven-game losing streak to the Wolverines ... **Elisha Jones** averaged a team-high 16 ppg over the two contests ... She dropped a game-high 20 pts in the win over Grove City ... **Hannah Hunter** and **Jessi Drayer** averaged 11.5 and 11.0 ppg, respectively, for the week.

## Westminster Titans (4-15, 0-11 PAC)



Westminster ran the gauntlet of playing two nationally-ranked teams in one week with an 82-46 loss at No. 22-ranked Saint Vincent Wednesday before losing to No. 1-ranked Thomas More, 53-37, at home Saturday ... The Titans played the final 18:40 vs. TMC without their leading scoring PG **Kaitlin McCarthy**, who left the game with an injury ... Still, the Titans limited the Saints to their second-lowest scoring output of the season and were within 10 with 2:33 remaining ... **Gabby Holko** averaged 9.5 pts in the two losses including a team-high seven points with a career-high 21 minutes vs. Thomas More, after leading the Titans with a career-best 12 points on 4-of-6 three-point shooting vs. Saint Vincent.
