PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

SHERELLE VOSSEN Bethany College

5-8 Freshman Guard Wheeling, W.Va./John Marshall H.S.

Vossen averaged 18.5 ppg to help the Bison maintain sole possession of first place in the PAC with league wins over Thiel (82-48) and Westminster (82-64). She tied her career-high with 16 points against the Tomcats, then set a new career-best with 21 markers against the Lady Titans. She shot 59 percent from the floor (10-of-17) and 57 percent from three-point range (8-of-14) for the week.

Also nominated was senior F **Misty Wadowsky** of Grove City, freshman G **Nicole Valentino** of Thiel, senior G **Shawndra McDonald** of Washington & Jefferson, freshman G **Katie Lewandowski** of Waynesburg, and junior F **Erica Tallo** of Westminster.

PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison

Bethany extended its winning streak to 10 games with wins against Thiel and Westminster last week ... The Bison have now won 13 of their last 14 contests ... With two wins last week, head coach Jina DeRubbo is now 123-56 in seven-plus years at Bethany and is four wins away from becoming Bethany's all-time leader in women's basketball coaching wins ... Lisa Campanell Komara is currently first with 126 victories in her 12 seasons at Bethany ... With nine rebounds against Westminster, senior C Kelley Richardson now has 909 in her career and needs just 13 more to break the Bethany all-time record of 921, accomplished by **Denise Doster**.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

The Presidents handed Westminster its first PAC loss of the season Wednesday. but were then routed by Grove City Saturday in Washington ... Senior G Shawndra McDonald helped W&J climb out of an 8-0 hole early to Westminster by notching a game-high 20 points to go with five rebounds and four steals ... Sophomore F Amanda Stanonik added 18 points, while sophomore G Leigh Sulkowski finished with 11 points and seven rebounds ... W&J jumped out to a 6-0 lead on Saturday, but a 27-10 GCC run over the next 10 minutes gave the Lady Woverines the lead for good ... Sophomore F Lauren Slampak led W&J with 12 points in the loss ... W&J was 0for-16 from three-point range on Saturday against Grove City.

Grove City Lady Wolverines

Grove City stretched its win streak to three with a pair of PAC wins last week that put the Wolverines in a tie for second place ... Against Waynesburg, Grove City rallied from a 17-point deficit with 8:28 left to pull out the victory ... Abby Moose ignited a 28-2 run by scoring seven points in a three-second span in the second half ... She finished with 23 points and became Grove City's all-time leader in three-point goals with 120 ... Misty Wadowsky added an 18-point, 10rebound double-double while forward Leigh LeGare added 10 points ... At W&J Saturday, LeGare tossed in 16 points on 8-of-11 shooting while Jocelyn Kempema added 15 points and Rachel Romance chipped in with 13 points.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg is winless in the PAC at the midway point of the league schedule ... The Jackets lost their 17th-straight against Grove City on Wednesday, 76-69, despite leading by 17 points with 8:28 remaining, as GCC went on a 28-4 run to end the game ... Waynesburg lost to Thiel on Saturday, 53-50 ... The Jackets previously owned a four-game win streak over Thiel, after beating the Tomcats four times last year ... Freshman G Katie Lewandowski had her best week of the season averaging 17.5 points per game, including a career-high 23 points against Grove City ... She was also the team's leading scorer against Thiel with 12 points ... Prior to last week, Lewandowski scored in double figures three times during the season.

Thiel Tomcats

After falling to Bethany 82-48 on Wednesday the Tomcats snapped a six-game losing skid by defeating Waynesburg 53-50 at home Saturday ... Thiel managed just 19 first-half points and shot 32.7 percent from the field in the Bethany loss ... Sophomore G Heather Abate, freshman G Nicole Valentino and junior G Laura Simonetti each had 10 points ... Valentino, Simonetti and freshman F Fontella Jones each had 12 points in the home win over Waynesburg, their first PAC win of the season...Jones had a game-high 12 rebounds in the win... The teams battled through eight second-half ties before a three-pointer by Valentino gave the Tomcats a three-point edge, 49-46, with 2:42 remaining.

Westminster Lady Titans

The Lady Titans had their three-game win streak snapped as they suffered their first PAC losses of the year last week, falling at W&J (66-49) and at home to league leader Bethany (82-64) ... Junior F Erica Tallo posted team-best totals of 12 points and nine rebounds against Washington & Jefferson, while freshman G Desiree Sterling added 11 points, seven rebounds and four assists in the loss ... Junior G Alyson Gasper led the Lady Titans with five assists and three steals ... Tallo had a team-high 18 points against Bethany, while Sterling added 14 ... Tallo and junior F Mary Jane Eaton tied for team rebound honors with eight apiece, while Gasper added team-best totals of four assists and four steals.

BETHANY BISON (15-4 Overall, 5-0 PAC)

at Ohio-Eastern (2/4 - 7 p.m.) vs. Grove City* (2/7 - 2 p.m.)

Upcoming Game Notes: Bethany will look to extend its 10-game winning streak this week against Ohio Eastern and Grove City ... The Bison are also enjoying one of its best starts in school history in PAC play ... The 5-0 start is the best since the 1999-2000 team went 8-0 in the PAC for the season ... The Bison are 8-0 all-time against Ohio Eastern, including an 83-40 win last season. In that game, **Katie Hardie** led the way with 19 points and 10 rebounds ... Bethany is now 17-24 all-time against Grove City after a 72-65 win on Jan. 17 in the PAC opener for both teams as **Kelley Richardson** recorded 17 points and five rebounds.

THIEL TOMCATS (6-13 Overall, 1-4 PAC)

In their 55-43 loss to the Lady Titans earlier this seaon, the Tomcats were paced by freshman F **Fontella Jones**, who finished with gamehighs in both points (15) and rebounds (12) ... That doubledouble was her third of the season ... Junior G **Laura Simonetti** had nine points and four assists while freshman G **Nadene Kotuby** and Valentino each added six in the loss.

The Jackets lost to the Presidents by a combined 64 points in their last three meetings, including a 68-48 setback at W&J this season on Jan. 17 ... The Presidents went on a 13-0 run during the game, and had four players score in double figures led by **Jordana Gracenin**'s 19 points ... Waynesburg's leading scorer **Candice Eyerman** (13.3 ppg) is averaging just 6.6 points per game in three career games against W&J.

Bethany won this year's first meeting, 72-65, on Jan. 17 ... Moose now has 755 career points, 14th on Grove City's all-time list ... She needs 10 points to pass Stephanie Murphy (1998-2002) for 13th ... Monday's game with La Roche is the 27th anniversary of Grove City's first-ever women's basketball game.

W&J ran away with a 68-48 win in Washington on Jan. 17th behind a career-high 19 points by sophomore guard **Jordana Gracenin** ... Sophomore forward **Lauren Slampak** also added 16 points and seven rebounds.
