after averaging 25.0 points, 9.5 rebounds and 3.0 assists per game during a 1-1 week for the Wolverines. Wednesday, she became the 10th 1,000point scorer in the program's history while firing in a game-high 24 points in a 61-58 loss to #20-ranked Washington & Jefferson, Saturday, Slater recorded 26 points, eight rebounds and four assists as GCC was victorious at home against PAC foe Waynesburg, 66-54. For the week, the junior forward shot 75 percent (21-of-28) from the field.

Also nominated was sophomore G Audra Droginske of Bethany, junior G/F Kayla Hilko of Chatham, sophomore G Katie Tierney of Thomas More, sophomore G Vanessa Rivera of Washington & Jefferson, senior F Elisha Jones of Waynesburg, and senior G Amy Dolsak of Westminster.

TMC-W&J SHOWDOWN: A battle of nationally-ranked PAC women's basketball powers is on tap for Saturday at 1 p.m. at the Connor Convocation Center, as #16 Thomas More hosts #20 Washington & Jefferson in a game that will go a long way towards determining the PAC regular season title and hosting rights to the 2010 PAC Tournament. The two teams each have one conference loss to date, while W&J won the first meeting between the programs, 61-57, in Washington on January 7.

NEWS & NOTES: Junior F Christine Slater became the 10th 1,000-point scorer in Grove City history Wednesday ... Maria Baroffio averaged 19.0 ppg last week for 2-0 Saint Vincent ... Westminster senior G Amy Dolsak averaged 17.5 ppg and 5.5 rpg last week for 0-2 Westminster ... Senior F Elisha Jones averaged 19.0 ppg, 3.0 rpg and 3.5 bpg last week for 0-2 Waynesburg ... Thomas More sophomore G Katie Tierney averaged 11.5 ppg and 6.5 rpg for the 2-0 Saints.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Chatham is 6-2 in nonleague play after a 63-39 win at Franciscan, as Julianne Speeney led a balanced attack with eight points ... Thiel freshman F Kelly Barzak posted a 13-point, 10-rebound double-double with five blocks vs. Geneva ... Sophomore G Vanessa Rivera of W&J scored a career-high 15 points vs. Grove City ... Sophomore G Audra **Droginske** averaged 11.5 ppg, 5.5 rpg and 3.5 apg for 1-1 Bethany ... Val Hamilton scored 19 points Saturday to lift Geneva past Bethany.


Bethany Bison (5-14, 2-7 PAC)

points, while Anne Wilson notched 14, Audra Droginske matched her career-high with 13 and Katelynn Hackathorn totaled 11, all in the second half ... A nine-point second half lead got away from the Bison Saturday at Geneva, who rallied for a 61-57 victory ... Bethany outrebounded the Golden Tornadoes 44-30, including 21 offensive boards. but Geneva shot 58 percent (15-26) in the second half ... Tara Harris and Taylor Kress each scored 11 points to lead BC, while Droginske fired in 10 markers and passed out six assists.

The Bearcats improved to 15-4 with a pair of victories last week ... Wednesday at Westminster, SVC came back from a 50-48 deficit to outscore the Titans 18-10 over the final eight minutes for the 66-60 win ... Four players scored in double-figures for the Bearcats, including Maria

Baroffio (16 pts), Emily Fenton (12), Devin McGrath (11), and Melissa Mansur (11) ... Mansur also added seven steals, as the Bearcats forced 32 turnovers while committing just 12 ... The Bearcats completed the perfect week with a 69-56 home win over Chatham Saturday ... Baroffio led both sides with 22 points, while Brittany Sedlock finished with a 14-point, 15-rebound double-double.

Thomas More Saints (17-2, 9-1 PAC)

The Saints, ranked No. 16 nationally by the WBCA, won a pair of PAC games last week as they defeated Chatham (74-61) and Westminster (76-49)

... In the win over Chatham, the Saints were led by junior C Nicole Dickman with 13 points, nine rebounds and three blocks ... In the win over Westminster, freshman G Samantha Van Atta scored a careerhigh 11 points, while Dickman scored nine points to move within 10 points from being the 13th player all-time to score 1,000 points for the Saints ... For the week, sophomore G Katie Tierney led the team in scoring and rebounding with 11.5 points and 6.5 rebounds per game ... Freshman G Chelsea Tolliver leads the team in scoring with 13.9 ppg.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (6-13, 3-7 PAC)

Despite a stellar scoring effort from junior F Elisha Jones, the Waynesburg women went 0-2 this past week ... Jones averaged 19 points per game for the

Yellow Jackets, including a team and personal season-high 22 points in Waynesburg's loss at Bethany.

Chatham Cougars (8-11, 2-7 PAC)

Chatham had a full week of competition this week; first stop was a non-conference contest at Franciscan ...

The Cougars had no trouble, finishing with a 63-39 victory ... All 11 players contributed points in the victory including first-year guard Julianne Speeney, who tallied a game-high four steals and also chipped in with eight points on 2-of-3 shooting from behind the three-point arc ... Next up, was #17-ranked Thomas More ... The Saints were able to hold off a Chatham rally late in the game and came out with the 74-61 victory ... Lizz King led all scorers with 13 points, while Courtney Smith and Libby Soeder each finished with 11 points ... Finally, the Cougars traveled to Latrobe to take on Saint Vincent Saturday, falling 69-56.

Grove City Wolverines (9-10, 6-4 PAC)

Grove City is 6-4 in the PAC after splitting a pair of home games last week ... Wednesday, junior F Christine Slater became the program's 10th all-time 1,000-point

scorer as she fired in 24 points in a 61-58 setback against W&J Grove City trailed by 13 at halftime but rallied to tie the game at 55 in the second half ... However, three late turnovers proved costly to Grove City ... Saturday, the Wolverines rebounded for a 66-54 home win over Waynesburg ... Slater posted 26 points, while sophomore G Megan Gebrosky added 11 ... Krista Beechy pulled in 10 rebounds ... GCC shot 16-of-26 (62 percent) in the second half ... Grove City has won 16 straight home games against Waynesburg.

Thiel Tomcats (6-12, 2-6 PAC)

The women of Thiel basketball defeated Geneva, 57-53, Wednesday to continue their winning ways in the friendly confines of Beeghly Gymnasium ... Kelly

Muffley led the way for the Tomcats as she scored 19 points, converting on 4-of-5 treys, and grabbed three rebounds, while freshman Kelly Barzak registered a double-double with 13 points and 10 rebounds, while swatting five shots ... Thiel fell to 6-12 Saturday, when they suffered a 69-34 loss to the Presidents of Washington & Jefferson ... Thiel was led by Barzak, who tallied 10 points, seven rebounds and two blocked shots ... Losing the battle of the boards (28-48) and field goal percentage (20 percent - 48 percent) proved to be too much for TC.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (17-2, 8-1 PAC)

The Presidents increased their win streak to 10 games after edging Grove City and routing Thiel this past week ... W&J has not lost since Dec. 29 ... W&J squandered a 13-point halftime lead Saturday and held off a late GCC charge to record the three-point win ... Washing-

ton & Jefferson forced 17 turnovers, including three key miscues, in the final 90 seconds ... Sophomore Vanessa River contributed a careerhigh 15 points, while senior Maggie Gibson produced 11 points, 11 rebounds and three assists ... W&J led 21-2 at the outset of Saturday's game and cruised to the win ... Thiel's nine first-half points was the fewest allowed in a half by a W&J squad in 30 years.

Westminster Titans (7-12, 5-4 PAC)

Westminster has now lost four out of five games after two losses last week, a 66-60 setback at home against Saint Vincent on Wednesday, fol-

lowed by a 76-49 loss at No. 16 Thomas More on Saturday ... Senior G Amy Dolsak was the only Titan to average double figures in scoring with 17.5 points per game, including 21 points in the loss to Saint Vincent and a game-high 14 points in the loss at Thomas More ... Freshman F Andi Ridge tied a career high vs. Saint Vincent with 10 points, all in the second half, while adding 10 rebounds for her second career doubledouble ... The Titans led by three points with nine minutes remaining in the loss to Saint Vincent.


