PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

LEIGH SULKOWSKI

Washington & Jefferson College 5-11 Freshman Guard Upper St. Clair, Pa./Upper St. Clair H.S.

Sulkowski averaged 21.7 points, 8.7 rebounds, 2.3 steals and 1.7 assists per game in leading W&J (15-1, 5-0 PAC), ranked #3 in the Great Lakes Region, to a two-game lead at the PAC halfway point. She scored 27 points in wins over both Grove City and Penn State-Altoona, giving her nine 20+ efforts this season. For the week, she shot 50 percent (24-of-48) from the field and 77 percent (13-of-17) from the line.

Also nominated was junior F Katie Hardie of Bethany, senior F Christy Faller of Grove City, junior G Amanda Swanson of Thiel, senior F Kyana Bradley of Waynesburg, and senior G Jaime Lynn of Westminster.

Bethany Bison

The Bison rebounded from a tough loss at Thiel with a victory over Westminster to complete the first half of the PAC slate with a 2-3 mark ... Bethany's shooting woes continued against the Tomcats, as the Green and White shot just 30 percent (17-56) from the floor... Thiel also enjoyed a 45-27 rebounding advantage, despite 16 points and 10 boards from Katie Hardie ... The Bison found their stroke against the Titans, as Bethany shot 57 percent (28-49) for the game, including hitting 15 of 23 in the second half ... Hardie posted another double-double with 17 points and 10 boards, while Nikki Babik hit for 15 and Kelley Richardson tallied 14... Kiki Cohen added eight points, seven assists and three steals.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J is ranked No. 3 in the Great Lakes Region, the highest regional ranking in school history ... The Presidents' 15-1 record also marks the best record in school history after 16 games ... W&J has won eight straight games and is ranked seventh in Division III in scoring defense (49.3 ppg) ... Freshman G Leigh Sulkowski is ranked 14th in the nation in scoring ... Sulkowski topped the 20-point mark twice this past week, giving her nine 20+ point games in 13 contests this season ... Her 27-point, 14-rebound effort on Saturday lifted W&J past Grove City ... Senior F Amy Strosnider and junior G Shawndra McDonald both added 17 markers ... McDonald will become the eighth 1,000-point scorer in W&J history with 14 more points.

Visiting W&J rebuked the Lady Wolverines' bid to grab a share of the PAC lead Saturday ... Grove City made just 7 of 32 second-half shots Saturday as W&J broke the game open ... Sandy O'Keefe led the Lady Wolverines with 11 points ... At Waynesburg last Saturday, Grove City rallied from a 13-point deficit in the first half to pull out the 53-52 win ... Leigh LeGare scored the eventual game-winner with 29 seconds left off an inbounds play ... Christy Faller racked up a double-double with 12 points and 10 rebounds, while G Abby Moose added 11 points, seven rebounds, seven steals and six assists ... The victory ran Grove City's win streak over Waynesburg to 11 games dating back to the 1995-96 season.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg was a 17-foot jumper away from winning three straight PAC games ... Wednesday, the Jackets lost to Grove City, 53-52, as Trista Murphy missed a fast break jump shot at the buzzer after the Jackets dropped a 13-point lead on the visiting Wolverines ... Waynesburg redeemed itself Saturday by handily defeating Thiel, who was on a two-game PAC win streak, 59-36 ... Kyana Bradley recorded her fifth double-double of the season against Thiel with 11 rebounds and 16 points, while also tallying four assists and three steals ... She scored a gamehigh 19 points against Grove City to go with her team-high eight rebounds ... Her three steals was enough to surpass Bobbie Jo Graham (258) as Waynesburg's career steal leader with 261.

Thiel Tomcats

The Thiel women split a pair of PAC games last week and are currently 2-3 in the conference ... The Tomcat reserves played a major role in their 69-66 victory over Bethany Wednesday, contributing 32 points and 29 rebounds ... Junior G Amanda Swanson hit a three-pointer with 3:04 to put Thiel up two, 63-61, which proved to be enough for the Tomcats to hang on to the win...Swanson finished with 20 points and eight caroms ... Freshman G Heather Abate and sophomore F Adrienne Mowry each finished with nine markers ... The 'Cats shot just 23.4 percent from the floor in their 59-36 loss at Waynesburg on Saturday ... Swanson led the Tomcats with 14 points and six caroms in defeat.

Westminster Lady Titans

The Lady Titans' losing skid hit four games last week with PAC losses to W&J (68-57) at home and at Bethany (73-54) ... Westminster led 15-1 W&J 27-26 at halftime, but could not hold on ... Senior G Jaime Lynn was the lone Lady Titan to reach double figures with 13 points. Sophomores Erica Tallo and Alyson Gasper added nine points each, with Tallo also snaring eight rebounds, while classmate Erin Morrow chipped in eight markers off the bench ... The Lady Titans has four players reach double figures against Bethany, led by senior F Samor Himes with a team-high 14 points ... Tallo added 12 markers, followed by sophomore F Mary Jane Eaton with 11 and Lynn with 10 ... Lynn also grabbed a team-high six rebounds.

Upcoming Game Notes: The Bison open the second half of the PAC schedule looking for revenge at Grove City ... The Lady Wolverines took advantage of a cold shooting Bison team to record a 67-57 upset Jan. 18 ... **Kelley Richardson** had 18 points and 13 rebounds and **Katie Tetzlaw** fired in a career-high 15, but Bethany shot just 24 percent (10-41) in the second half as they lost a four-point halftime lead ... For the game, Bethany hit just 21 of 73 attempts from the floor (29 percent).

Junior G **Amanda Swanson** finished with game highs in points (14) and rebounds (9) ... Swanson was ranked 16th in the last NCAA Division III statistical rankings (through 1/26) with a 4.1 steals per game average.
