PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL 2008-09 - Week 9 Conference Notes

TMC, W&J KEEP ROLLING: The battle for the top seed and hosting rights to the 2009 PAC Tournament has been whittled down to a two-team race with three weeks to play in the regular season. Thomas More and Washington & Jefferson each continued to march through the league schedule, with the Saints holding a half-game lead over the Presidents. Both teams are equal in the loss column (one) and are on target for a crucial matchup in Kentucky on Wednesday, Feb. 11.

WHO'S HOT: After starting the season 4-9, Bethany has won five of its last six games ... Sophomore **Courtney Smith** averaged 20.0 ppg for 1-1 Chatham and posted a school-record five three-pointers in a 69-63 loss to Saint Vincent ... Junior G **Stephanie Smith** averaged 17.0 ppg and 4.5 apg for 2-0 W&J ... Senior G **Gabby Johnson** averaged 11.0 points and 3.5 assists per game for 2-0 Thomas More ... Sophomore F **Christine Slater** averaged 16.5 ppg and 6.5 rpg for 1-1 Grove City.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Saint Vincent freshman **Emily Fenton** scored 20 points, 18 in a three-minute span in the second half of a 55-41 win over Waynesburg ... Thiel freshman **Shelly Warren** posted a 23-point, 11-rebound double-double in an 86-83 OT loss to Chatham ... **Michawn Rich** of Geneva posted 17 points and 10 boards in a loss to W&J ... Junior G **Amy Dolsak** averaged a double-double (13.5 ppg, 10.0 rpg) for 0-2 Westminster ... Sophomore F **Elisha Jones** averaged 15.0 ppg and 6.0 rpg for 0-2 Waynesburg.

PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison (9-10, 4-5 PAC)



Big second halves propelled the Bison to wins over Waynesburg and Geneva last week ... **Caelyn DiSanti** scored 11 of her 13 points in the second half to help BC outscore the Yellow Jackets by 10 after halftime in a 69-56 triumph ... **Stacy Goode** joined DiSanti in top scoring honors with 13, while **Kaitlyn McCormick** added 12 ... BC shot 59 percent (19-32) in the second half against Geneva, as they turned a nine-point halftime lead into an 81-60 victory ... Bethany scored a season-high 45 points in the second half and also controlled the glass with a 55-32 margin over the GTs ... Eleven different Bison scored in the contest, led by McCormick, who went 9-for-11 from the floor for 20 points.

Chatham Cougars (9-10, 2-7 PAC)



Chatham dropped its contest at Saint Vincent by a score of 69-63 despite a strong scoring effort by sophomores **Courtney Smith** and **Kayla Hilko**, who scored 18 and 21 points, respectively ... The Cougars got back on a winning track by defeating Thiel 86-83 in overtime ... Smith stayed hot by connecting on 6-of-8 shots from behind the arc and connecting on a pair of free throws with 20 seconds on the clock to force overtime ... Hilko and **Barb Petty** added 22 and 20 points in the win ... Chatham returns to action on Wednesday when the Cougars host Grove City College.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (8-10)



Geneva's losing streak matched a season high three games with a pair of losses last week ... The Golden Tornadoes dropped an 84-47 decision to W&J before falling 81-60 at Bethany ... The Golden Tornadoes were in each game at the half before watching both clubs take control ... Wednesday, Geneva trailed W&J by only 12 at the half and then trailed Bethany by only nine ... In both cases, the Golden Tornadoes were unable to get a bucket in the first four minutes of the second half ... **Michawn Rich** scored 17 points and pulled down ten rebounds against W&J ... Saturday afternoon, the Golden Tornadoes were just 3-of-21 from three-point range and shot just 32% for the game.

Grove City Wolverines (8-11, 4-5 PAC)



Grove City remains in third place in the PAC after splitting two conference games last week ... Thursday, GCC completed its first sweep of Westminster in six years by picking up a 57-45 win ... **Christine Slater** fired in 18 points on 9-of-10 shooting while **Laura Miller** added a dozen points ... The Wolverines allowed an average of 40.5 points to Westminster in the two meetings this year ... Grove City had not won on a Thursday night in over eight years ... Saturday, Grove City placed three players in double figures at W&J ... Slater and Miller each had 15 points while Megan Gebrosky fired in 11 ... Freshman **Jayme Caldwell** made her first two collegiate starts last week and averaged 7.0 points and 3.0 assists per game.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (13-5)



The Bearcats improved to 7-0 at home on the season with comeback wins over Chatham and Waynesburg ... In Thursday's 69-63 win over the Cougars, SVC came back from a 36-29 halftime deficit ... **Lauren Reilly** and **Maria Baroffio** each scored 14 points, while **Maura Wahl** added 13 ... Reilly finished 4-of-4 from the floor and 6-of-6 from the foul line while adding a team-high nine rebounds ... In Saturday's 55-41 win over Waynesburg, freshman **Emily Fenton** scored 20 points, including 18 in a three minute span midway through the second half ... Reilly and **Brittany Sedlock** shared game high honors with 11 rebounds, while **Ashley Campbell** dished seven assists and tallied four steals.

Thiel Tomcats (9-9, 4-6 PAC)



The House was definitely full of thrills Saturday, but the Thiel women came up short in overtime, losing to the Chatham Cougars 86-83 ... The Tomcats were lead by outstanding performances by **Shelly Warren** and **Amber Bodrick** ... Each player worked their way to double-doubles, Warren scoring 23 points, grabbing 11 boards and dishing out 5 assists while Bodrick piled on 24 points, tallied 15 rebounds and dropped 6 dimes ... Freshman **G Rianne Thornton** played the role of defensive stopper with five steals, a blocked shot and a handful of forced turnovers ... The Tomcats were outmatched on Wednesday, January 28 when they faced nationally-ranked Thomas More on the road, losing the game 64-31.

Thomas More Saints (17-2, 9-1 PAC)



Thomas More, ranked No. 14 in the D3hoops.com Top-25 and No. 15 in the WBCA Top-25, swept its two games last week, defeating Thiel, 64-31, on Wednesday and Westminster, 79-42, Saturday ... In the win over Thiel, senior G **Jayme Thiem** led all scores with 14 points and sophomore center **Nicole Dickman** added 10 ... Thiem and Dickman both pulled down a game-high six rebounds against the Tomcats ... Against Westminster, senior G **Gabby Johnson** scored a career-high 19 points in 16 minutes of action as she was 7-of-8 from the field ... Also scoring in double-figures in the win over Westminster was freshman forward **Whitney Cundiff** with a career-high 11 points and Dickman with 10.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (17-2, 8-1 PAC)



Washington & Jefferson breezed through last week's schedule and now sits just a half-game out of first place in the PAC, trailing Thomas More (9-1) ... The Presidents posted a 21-0 first-half run against Geneva on Wednesday and a 25-2 run to open the second half against Grove City Saturday ... Senior F **Emily Hays** is now just 10 points shy of 1,000 career points after netting a game-high 18 against GCC ... Junior F **Maggie Gibson** remains at the top of the conference's rebounding list, pulling down 11.4 rebounds per contest ... Junior G **Stephanie Smith** continues to carry the hot hand from outside the arc for W&J, firing in a league-best 47 three pointers.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (6-13, 3-6 PAC)



The Waynesburg women's led in both of their games last week, but couldn't hold their advantages in a home loss to Bethany and a road defeat at Saint Vincent ... Against the Bison, the Yellow Jackets led by one (29-28) with just over 16 minutes left to play in the contest, but the visitors pulled away down the stretch for the win ... The Waynesburg forward combination of freshman **Callie White** and sophomore **Elisha Jones** each scored 16 points in the loss ... Against Saint Vincent, the Jackets were up 18-15 with 3:33 to go in the first period, but the Bearcats overcame the deficit and went on to victory ... Jones led the Jackets in scoring with 14 points.

Westminster Titans (6-12, 3-6 PAC)



The Westminster women's basketball team went 0-2 in two PAC road games last week losing to Grove City, 57-45, on Thursday and to Thomas More, 79-42, on Saturday ...
