Kegg led Grove City in scoring in PAC wins over Bethany (75-73) and Waynesburg (64-37) last week, moving the Lady Wolverines into sole possession of the PAC lead. She averaged 12.0 points on the week. In the win over the Bison, she tallied 16 points, three assists and three steals.

Swanson averaged 20.5 points, 8.0 rebounds and 3.0 steals per game for the 1-1 Tomcats last week. She tallied 27 points and five rebounds in a 74-72 overtime loss to Washington & Jefferson after recording 14 points and 11 rebounds in a 60-43 Thiel win over Waynesburg.

Also nominated was junior guard **Kiki Cohen** of Bethany and sophomore guard **Shawndra McDonald** of Washington & Jefferson.

PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison

Bethany suffered a pair of crushing losses to PAC opponents before rebounding for a win over Pitt-Bradford ... At Grove City, the Bison fell behind by as many as 15 in the first half ... **Katie Hardie** tallied 17 points and 16 boards in the loss ... Bethany was forced to recover from a double-digit deficit against Westminster ... Late in the extra session with the score tied at 71, the Bison called a timeout it did not have and the Titans hit three of four foul shots for the win ... **Kiki Cohen** played all 45 minutes and fired in a career-high 24 points ... **Kelley Richardson** tossed in 20 and **Nikki Babik** had 18 in the victory over Pitt-Bradford ... For the week, Cohen averaged 16.3 points and 5.7 assists.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

The Presidents finished the week with a 1-2 record after dropping contests late in the game at Pitt-Greensburg and Westminster and defeating Thiel in overtime ... **Rachel Armitage** scored 24 points to lead W&J against UP-G, while **Shawndra McDonald** added 16 points and nine assists ... W&J trailed by as many as 18 points at Westminster on Wednesday, but fought back to tie the contest ... Westminster won the game on a pair of free throws with 1:13 remaining and held W&J off the scoreboard in its final two chances ... McDonald totaled 16 points, nine rebounds and seven assists ... McDonald scored 22 points and notched eight steals, seven assists and five rebounds in the 74-72 overtime victory over Thiel.

Grove City Lady Wolverines

The Lady Wolverines assumed sole possession of first place in the Presidents' Athletic Conference with wins over three-time defending PAC champion Bethany and Waynesburg last week ... Senior **Kristy Kegg** and junior **Jessica Jenkins** sparked the win over Bethany with 16 points apiece ... Senior **Stephanie Murphy** contributed a team-high six rebounds and six assists ... Kegg accounted for three of the team's nine three-pointers in the game ... Grove City made 18 of 23 free throws in the victory ... Fourteen Lady Wolverines dented the scoring column at Waynesburg led by Murphy and Kegg, who had eight points each.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Jackets broke a season-long five-game losing streak with a 62-53 win over La Roche, before falling to PAC rivals Thiel (60-43) and Grove City (64-37).

Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats snapped a four-game losing skid with a 60-43 road victory over Waynesburg on Jan. 30 ... The Tomcats finished the week 1-1 after losing at home to W&J 74-72 in overtime ... Thiel hit a potential game-tying basket at the end of the overtime period against W&J, but was waved off by the officiating crew ... Sophomore guard **Amanda Swanson** and senior forward **Sara Snyder** had 27 and 24, respectively, for the Tomcats ... Snyder also grabbed a game-high 10 rebounds ... Thiel outscored the Yellow Jackets 38-22 in the second half to push them to their first PAC win of the season ... Four players finished in double-digits, led by Swanson and Snyder, who each tallied 14 points.

Westminster Lady Titans

Westminster ran its win streak to a season-high five games this week, as the Lady Titans toppled PAC opponents W&J (62-60) and Bethany (74-71 in overtime) ... The Lady Titans are now 5-1 against PAC teams this year, 15-1 against the PAC dating back to last season ... Senior guard **Robin Thayer** became the all-time leading scorer in Lady Titan history on Saturday ... A jumper with two seconds left in the first half against the Bison allowed Thayer to pass **Colleen Dion** (1,185 points from 1992-96) as the program's most prolific scorer ... Thayer finished the game with 16 points, bringing her current career scoring total to 1,197 points ... Thayer posted a team-high 15 points in the W&J win.
