Long earned her second PAC weekly honor of the season after averaging 19.5 points, 4.0 rebounds, 3.0 steals and 1.5 assists for 2-0 Thomas More, which took over sole possession of first place in the PAC with the two wins. For the week, she shot 53 percent from the field, including 46 percent from three-point range. Long bucketed 19 points and dished out three assists in an 85-52 home win over Bethany, then recorded team-high totals of 20 points and four steals in an 89-65 victory against Thiel.

Also nominated was senior F **Renee Shepherd** of Bethany, senior G **Lizz King** of Chatham, junior G **Leah Gibson** of Grove City, junior F **Devin McGrath** of Saint Vincent, senior F **Ashley Kirkpatrick** of Washington & Jefferson, senior PG **Hannah Hunter** of Waynesburg, and junior F **Katie Hughes** of Westminster.

SAINTS MARCH IN: For the first time this season, the five-time defending champion Thomas More Saints are alone in first place in the PAC ... TMC went 2-0 on the week, while Saint Vincent (which began the week in a first place tie with Thomas More) fell out of a tie for first in the PAC following the Bearcats' second loss of the season to third-place Waynesburg Saturday ... Thomas More, which lost at Saint Vincent in the first meeting, hosts the Bearcats on Feb. 15.

NEWS AND NOTES: Thomas More sophomore G **Katie Kitchen** averaged 19.5 ppg for 2-0 Thomas More ... Grove City junior G **Leah Gibson** averaged 17.0 ppg on the week for 2-0 Grove City, including 20 markers vs. Westminster ... Waynesburg senior PG **Hannah Hunter** averaged 15.5 ppg, 5.0 apg, and 4.0 spg for the 2-0 Yellow Jackets ... Saint Vincent junior F **Devin McGrath** averaged a double-double (19.5 ppg, 10.0 rpg) along with 3.5 apg, 3.0 spg, and 2.0 bpg for the 1-1 Bearcats.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Senior G **Lizz King** had a 23-point, 10-rebound double-double for Chatham vs. Waynesburg ... Senior F **Renee Shepherd** averaged 12.0 ppg and 6.5 rpg for 1-1 Bethany ... Westminster junior F **Katie Hughes** averaged 12.0 ppg and 8.5 rebounds for the 1-1 Titans ... Senior F **Ashley Kirkpatrick** averaged 19.0 ppg and 9.5 rpg for 0-2 W&J ... Junior F **Kelly Barzak** averaged 14.0 ppg for 0-2 Thiel ... **Beth DeLuca** surpassed 900 career points for 0-2 Geneva.

PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison (13-8, 9-5 PAC)



Bethany lost its opening game of the week by an 85-52 margin at PAC leader Thomas More, as the Saints pulled away in the second half by shooting 52 percent ... **Anne Wilson** scored 10 in the loss and **Renee Shepherd** hit for nine points ... Saturday, the Bison trailed by 18 early in the second half, but rallied all the way back thanks to a 29-3 blitz and came away with a 68-60 victory over W&J ... **Audra Droginske** scored 10 of her 15 after halftime to fuel the charge, while Shepherd recorded a double-double with 15 points & 10 boards ... **Kayla Taormina** also registered a double-double with 10 points and 10 rebounds in addition to five assists.

Chatham Cougars (4-17, 1-13 PAC)



In the 81-54 loss against Waynesburg, **Lizz King** posted a double-double with the game-high 23 points and 10 rebounds ... **Marguerite Sargent** also posted 10 rebounds ... Chatham was able to take the lead once at the end of the first, but they could not hold it ... Saturday, the Cougars celebrated a 40-38 victory as well as their Senior Day ... The game against the Golden Tornadoes was close as the Cougars stayed on top for most of it ... King recorded 12 points against Geneva ... Sargent took care of the double-double of the day with 12 points and 12 rebounds ... **Carly Zelenak** tacked on another 11 rebounds ... Geneva had several scoring opportunities in the last five minutes due to fouls from the Cougars, but came up empty.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (3-18, 2-12 PAC)



Geneva put forth two solid efforts only to come up short against both Grove City and Chatham ... **Samantha Fisher** scored 12 points in a 46-36 loss to Grove City last Wednesday, while **Beth DeLuca** scored 16 points in a 40-38 loss to Chatham Saturday ... DeLuca's 16 points made her just the 15th player in school history to reach the 900 point plateau for her career ... The Golden Tornadoes have dropped eight straight games and fell to 3-18 for the season, including a 2-12 mark in the conference ... Geneva will host Thiel on Wednesday looking for a season sweep against the Tomcats before heading to Saint Vincent on Saturday afternoon.

Grove City Wolverines (6-15, 5-9 PAC)



Grove City continued its late-season push in the conference by earning two league wins last week ... Wednesday night, the Wolverines earned a 46-36 win at Geneva ... GCC held Geneva to 29 percent (15-of-51) shooting ... **Leah Gibson** led Grove City with 14 points and **Megan Gebrosky** added 11 ... The Wolverines earned their ninth straight win against the GTs ... Saturday, a strong second half carried Grove City to a 65-54 win over visiting Westminster ... The Wolverines shot 52 percent from the field and outscored the Titans 41-23 over the final 20 minutes ... Gibson paced GCC with 20 points and Gebrosky added 17 ... **Hannah Jo Coneby** posted an 11-point, 11-rebound double-double.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (17-4, 12-2 PAC)



SVC saw its eight-game PAC win streak snapped Saturday with a 74-66 loss at Waynesburg ... The streak was book-ended with losses to Waynesburg, SVC's only two conference losses of the season ... The Bearcats were unable to hold onto a 59-51 lead with just under nine minutes remaining, as the Yellow Jackets out-scored SVC 23-7 down the stretch ... Junior F **Devin McGrath** posted 19 points, 11 rebounds, four steals, three blocks and three assists in the loss and senior F **Brittany Sedlock** totaled 18 points, six rebounds, three assists and two steals ... In the 80-49 win over Thiel on Wednesday, McGrath led all scorers with 20 points and added nine rebounds and four assists.

Thiel Tomcats (5-16, 5-9 PAC)



The women's basketball team went 0-2 last week against Saint Vincent and Thomas More ... In the loss to the first-place Saint Vincent, **Kelly Barzak** was the lone Tomcat in double digits, recording 17 points and grabbed five rebounds ... **Kelly Muffley** and **Ashley Davis** each had seven points respectively ... At Thomas More, Muffley led Thiel with 17 points and Barzak and Davis also notched double figures with 11 apiece.

Thomas More Saints (17-4, 13-1 PAC)



Thomas More went 2-0 last week by defeating Bethany and Thiel both at home ... Sophomore G **Katie Kitchen** and junior G **Allison Long** led the team in scoring as they both averaged 19.5 points per game ... Sophomore G **Devin Beasley** averaged 13.0 ppg., and had a team high 13 rebounds, while sophomore F **Moriah Corey** led the team on the boards with 12.0 rebounds per game ... For the season, Kitchen leads the team in scoring with 15.1 ppg., and Corey leads the team on the boards with 7.5 rpg., while Beasley leads the team in assists with 90 ... The Saints are shooting 42.5 percent from the field as they are connecting on 555-of-1,305 field goals and have forced 431 turnovers.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (10-11, 5-9 PAC)



W&J fell to Westminster 62-55 on Wednesday ... The Presidents cut a 13-point second half deficit to just four before the Titans hung on to win by seven ... Senior PG **Vanessa Rivera** scored a season-high 18 points on 7-of-8 shooting ... Rivera also grabbed six rebounds and dished out four assists ... Senior F **Ashley Kirkpatrick** added 16 points, five rebounds and three blocks ... Bethany rallied from 18 points down in the second half to beat W&J 68-60 Saturday ... Kirkpatrick and freshman **Alexa DelGreco** combined to score the Presidents' first 18 points ... Kirkpatrick recorded a double-double with 22 points and 13 rebounds ... DelGreco added 12 points, four rebounds and three assists.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (16-5, 11-3 PAC)



Waynesburg followed up a 71-52 road win at Chatham with an important 74-66 home win over Saint Vincent ... The victories gave the Yellow Jackets season sweeps over the Cougars and Bearcats and kept their hopes of a PAC regular season title alive ... Both games featured impressive second-half performances, as Waynesburg led by just two at the half against Chatham and trailed Saint Vincent by one after 20 minutes of play ... The backcourt duo of senior **Hannah Hunter** and junior **Jessi Drayer** played a major role in the 2-0 week for Waynesburg as they combined to average 30.5 points, 10.0 rebounds and 6.0 assists per game ... Hunter led all scorers with 20 points in the victory over Saint Vincent.

Westminster Titans (7-13, 7-7 PAC)



Wednesday, down by one at halftime, WC came out of the locker room with a sense of urgency as they produced a 16-4 run in the first 10 minutes of the second half ... The Titans stayed ahead the remainder of the game en route to a 62-55 win over Washington & Jefferson ... Junior **Katie Hughes** led the way for the Titans with 15 points to go along with eight rebounds ... The Lady Titans had their three-game win streak snapped Saturday, following a 65-54 loss to Grove City ... Westminster led 31-24 at halftime, however, GCC went on a 13-0 run to start the second half en route to the victory ...
