She recorded her 3<sup>rd</sup> double-double of the year in 66-58 win over Thiel with 16 points and 12 rebounds, while also blocking 2 shots. Taormina scored 15 of her team-high 20 points in the 1<sup>st</sup> half of Saturday's win at Grove City and hit 4-of-5 from the arc in the win. She also grabbed 7 rebounds and hit 2 foul shots with 12 seconds left to help secure the win.

Also nominated was senior G/F **Kayla Hilko** of Chatham, senior F **Christine Slater** of Grove City, sophomore F **Devin McGrath** of Saint Vincent, sophomore F **Kelly Barzak** of Thiel, sophomore G **Chelsea Tolliver** of Thomas More, junior PG **Vanessa Rivera** of Washington & Jefferson, sophomore G **Jessi Dramer** of Waynesburg, and freshman G **Courtney Zitt** of Westminster.



### PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL 2010-11 - Week 11 Conference Notes

**THOMAS MORE REMAINS NO. 1:** Thomas More extended its season-opening winning streak to 21 games last week with a pair of wins over fellow PAC schools ... The Saints were the top-ranked team in both Division III national polls for the second straight week last week ... Thomas More defeated Geneva 70-41 before receiving a scare by Wash. & Jeff. Saturday, trailing by eight at the half ... The Saints rallied to outscore the Presidents 36-15 in the second half en route to a 61-48 win.

**NEWS AND NOTES:** Bethany's **Kayla Taormina** averaged 18 pts and 9.5 rebounds this week ... **Devin McGrath** led Saint Vincent this week by averaging 17.5 pts and 6.5 rebounds ... Waynesburg's **Elisha Jones** averaged 15.5 pts and 7.5 rebounds ... **Chelsea Tolliver** (12.5 pts) and **Nicole Dickman** (8.5 pts.) led Thomas More in scoring last week ... **Sonjia Hoston** finished with 13 pts while **Kayla Hilko** and **Courtney Smith** each chipped in 11 pts of their own in Chtham's win over Grove City.

**AROUND THE LEAGUE:** **Christine Slater** averaged 23 pts and 10.5 rebounds for Grove City last week ... Geneva's **Alyse Scarsella** posted season highs in both pts (27) and rebounds (17) despite losing to Saint Vincent ... Westminster's **Courtney Zitt** averaged 13.5 points on the week including a career and game-high 19 pts in a loss at Waynesburg ... Thiel's **Kelly Barzak** averaged 14 pts and nine rebounds last week ... **Vanessa Rivera** recorded a team-high 16 pts, six rebounds in W&J's loss to Thomas More.

# PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

## Bethany Bison (11-10, 6-6 PAC)



Two big wins last week vaulted the Bison all the way into 4<sup>th</sup> place in the league ... **Kayla Taormina** scored 7 in a 9-0 run midway through the 2<sup>nd</sup> half to give Bethany the lead for good in a 66-58 win over Thiel ... **Katelynn Hackathorn** scored a game-high 19 and Taormina posted a double-double (16 markers and 12 rebounds) ... A 14-point halftime lead slipped away from BC at Grove City, but they recovered to post a 69-65 triumph ... Taormina scored 15 of her team-best 20 pts in the 1<sup>st</sup> half to push Bethany to a 38-24 halftime cushion and **Tara Harris** tossed in 14 of her season-high 19 in the 2<sup>nd</sup> half to help the Bison hang on for the win ... Harris also grabbed 11 rebounds, while Hackathorn dropped in 13 markers.

## Chatham Cougars (8-13, 4-9 PAC)



Chatham snapped a three-game losing streak this week with PAC wins against both Grove City and Westminster ... **Colleen Kiss** hit a three-pointer at the buzzer to tie the game and send it into overtime against the Wolverines ... Chatham would go on to win, outscoring their opponent in the overtime frame 12-8 ... **Sonjia Hoston** finished with 13 pts while **Kayla Hilko** and **Courtney Smith** each chipped in 11 pts of their own in the win ... Saturday's game came down to the wire as well at Westminster ... **Felicia Brown** hit a baseline jumper at the buzzer for the win ... **Lizz King** led the Cougars with a game-high 19 pts, 15 of which were from behind the three-point arc and Hilko added 14 of her own in the second buzzer beater victory.

## Geneva Golden Tornadoes (8-13)



Geneva's week consisted of back to back games against a pair of PAC powerhouses ... The Golden Tornadoes dropped a 70-41 decision to top ranked Thomas More before falling 80-67 to Saint Vincent on Saturday night ... On Saturday night, **Alyse Scarsella** posted season highs in both points (27) and rebounds (17) despite Geneva falling to 8-13 on the season ... The two losses this past week clinched a losing season for Geneva and thus eliminating the Golden Tornadoes from any NCCAA post-season play ... Geneva opened the season with three straight wins on its home floor but has dropped six straight at Metheny Fieldhouse to fall to 3-6 at home.

## Grove City Wolverines (10-11, 6-7 PAC)



Grove City dropped a pair of four-point decisions last week in PAC play ... At Chatham, four Wolverines scored in double figures, led by **Leah Gibson** with 18 pts ... **Christine Slater** fashioned a 15-pt, 12-rebound double-double while **Megan Gebrosky** (12) and **Jenna Johnston** (10) also reached double figures ... The game featured seven lead changes in the second half ... Saturday, Grove City erased a 16-pt deficit in the second half but could not hold on against Bethany ... Slater poured in a career-high 31 pts, including three three-pointers in the final 35 seconds ... Gebrosky had 13 pts and five assists ... Slater became the second 1,500-point scorer in program history.

## Saint Vincent Bearcats (19-2, 11-1 PAC)



The 19<sup>th</sup> ranked Bearcats improved to 19-2 with wins over W&J and Geneva ... In the 52-45 win over W&J SVC trailed 18-17 after a sloppy first half, but regrouped to out-scored W&J 35-27 in the second half, ending the game on a 21-5 run over the final nine minutes ... **Devin McGrath** scored a team-high 12 pts in the win, while **Brittany Sedlock** added 11 pts with a game-high nine rebounds ... In Saturday's 80-67 win at Geneva, four players scored in double figures for the Bearcats, again led by the duo of McGrath and Sedlock, who poured in 23 and 20 pts, respectively ... Sedlock recorded her ninth double-double of the year with 11 rebounds, while McGrath had game highs of seven assists and six steals to go with seven rebounds.

## Thiel Tomcats (5-16, 3-9 PAC)



The Tomcat women's basketball team was defeated in both contests last week ... In the first game of the week Thiel fell to Bethany 66-58 ... **Kelly Barzak** played a solid game as she had 18 pts and nine rebounds ... **Kelly Muffley** also played well as she added 18 points for the Tomcats ... In the second game of the week, Thiel fell again; this time at the hands of Waynesburg by a score of 72-50 ... Three Tomcats scored in double figures including Barzak (10), Muffley (11), and **Rianne Thornton** (12) ... Barzak also added nine rebounds.

## Thomas More Saints (21-0, 12-0 PAC)



Thomas More extended its season-opening winning streak to 21 games last week with a pair of wins over fellow PAC schools ... The Saints were the top-ranked team in both Division III national polls for the second straight week last week ... It's the first time in Thomas More history that any athletic team has been ranked No. 1 in the nation ... **Chelsea Tolliver** and **Nicole Dickman** led the team in scoring last week as they each averaged 12.5 points per game and 8.5 ppg, respectively ... **Katie Kees** led the team on the boards as she averaged 6.5 rebounds per game, while **Allison Long** led the team in assists with seven and Tolliver led the team in steals with seven.

## Washington & Jefferson Presidents (8-13, 5-7 PAC)



The Presidents dropped a 52-45 decision Wednesday at Saint Vincent ... W&J held a nine-point lead at 40-31 with 8:59 remaining in the second half, but SVC finished the game on a 21-5 run ... **Catlyn Kriston** tied a career-high with six three-pointers also scored a game-high 18 pts, tying her career mark ... **Vanessa Rivera** scored six pts, dished out four assists and picked up two steals ... W&J also lost a lead against No. 1 Thomas More on Saturday, falling 61-48 ... W&J raced out to a 33-25 halftime lead before 4-of-17 shooting and 14 turnovers in the second half did in the Presidents ... Rivera led W&J with 16 pts and grabbed six rebounds and dished out three assists.

## Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (16-5, 9-4 PAC)



Waynesburg swept a pair of PAC games this past week and further cemented themselves into the third-place spot in the conference standings ... Waynesburg took down Westminster by a final score of 63-53 on Wednesday, and followed that with an impressive 72-50 triumph on the road at Thiel ... **Elisha Jones** led a trio of double-digit scorers with 15.5 points per game ... She also pulled down 7.5 rebounds per contest ... **Jessi Drayer** chipped in 13.5 pts, a team-best 11.0 rebounds and 5.0 assists per game ... **Hannah Hunter** added 11.5 pts, 4.0 rebounds, 5.0 assists and two steals in each win ... Waynesburg also forced 41 turnovers, while only giving up the ball 23 times.

## Westminster Titans (4-17, 0-13 PAC)



Westminster's longest PAC losing streak continued with losses at Waynesburg, 63-53 and at home to Chatham, 57-55, on a heartbreaking buzzer-beater ... The Titans' sixth straight loss came after Westminster led Chatham by 14 pts with 9:52 remaining ... The Cougars' Felicia Brown swished a 17-footer after hauling in a rebound as time expired ... **Courtney Zitt** and **Gabby Holko** led the Titans with scoring averages of 13.5 and 11.5 in the two games ... Zitt and Holko each posted career highs against Waynesburg with Zitt sinking a game-high 19 pts and Holko bucketing 14 ... The Titans led briefly in the opening minutes of the second half at Waynesburg ... **Emily Dolsak** led the Titans with 11 pts and eight rebounds vs. Chatham.
