# SHAWNDRA MCDONALD Washington & Jefferson College 5-3 Senior Guard

Houston, Tex./Westfield H.S.

McDonald averaged 21.0 points, 7.5 assists, 4.5 rebounds and 2.5 steals for the 2-0 Presidents last week. Her threepointer with 16 seconds left was the difference for W&J in a 78-75 PAC win at Waynesburg. McDonald canned nine treys and shot 47 percent (16-of-34) from the field, while also moving into fourth place on the W&J career scoring charts with 1,337 points.

Also nominated was senior C Kelley Richardson of Bethany, junior G Jocelyn Kempema of Grove City, sophomore G Kirsten Schrecongost of Thiel, and freshman G Desiree Sterling of Westminster.

# PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

#### **Bethany Bison**

The Bison extended their win streak to 12 games with wins at Ohio Eastern and vs. Grove City ... With a rebound 1:36 into the GCC contest, senior C Kelley Richardson became Bethany's all-time leading rebounder ... She pulled down 10 in the game and now has 931 in her career, passing Denise Doster's mark of 921 ... With two wins last week, Jina DeRubbo moved closer to becoming the all-time leader for coaching wins in Bethany women's basketball history ... She is one win behind Lisa Campanell Komara's mark of 126 wins with a record of 125-56 (691) in seven seasons ... With 14 points vs. Grove City, senior Katie Hardie moved into a tie for seventh on the all-time scoring list with 1,185 points.

## Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Washington & Jefferson's 96 points scored at Lancaster Bible were the most scored by a W&J squad in a span of 248 games dating back to a 98-87 victory against Allegheny in the 1992-93 season ... Senior G Shawndra McDonald moved into fourth-place on the school's all-time scoring list on Saturday as she passed Kim Eisiminger '80 and now has 1,337 career points ... The Presidents led by as many as 18 points in the second half only to see Waynesburg come back to tie the game with 1:20 remaining ... McDonald then gave W&J the win with a three-pointer with 16 seconds left ... Sophomore G Leigh Sulkowski scored 19 points and grabbed eight boards, while classmate Lauren Slampak added 15 points and eight caroms.

## Grove City Lady Wolverines

Grove City's four-game win streak ended Saturday with a six-point loss at Bethany ... The Wolverines limited Bethany to 23 percent shooting from the floor but could not overcome a 17-0 Bison run early in the second half ... Abby Moose led GCC with 14 points, moving into 11th place on Grove City's all-time scoring list with 778 points ... Jocelyn Kempema added 11 points while Misty Wadowsky had 10 rebounds ... Sandy O'Keefe set a new single-game school record with seven blocked shots Monday against La Roche as Grove City completed a season sweep of the Redhawks ... Kempema tossed in a game-high and personal-best 18 points ... Grove City broke the game open with a 26-1 run late in the first half.

### Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg took the defending PAC champions down to the wire Saturday, as W&J needed a late three-pointer to edge the Yellow Jackets, 78-75 ... Waynesburg failed to score on its final possession when junior G Ashley Urban got tied up, forcing a held ball and a turnover ... Waynesburg, which hasn't defeated W&J in 15 tries, lost to the Presidents by a combined 64 points in the previous three games ... Sophomore G Trista Murphy led Waynesburg with 19 points, including 4-of-9 from three-point range while also grabbing a team-high seven rebounds ... W&J led the entire second half, but allowed Waynesburg to go on a 16-6 run before a pair of Rachel Dillon foul shots tied the game for Waynesburg with 1:20 remaining.

## Thiel Tomcats

Thiel went 0-2 last week, falling 55-54 at Pitt-Bradford on Monday before dropping a 53-31 decision at home to PAC rival Westminster on Saturday ... Sophomore G Heather Abate connected on 1-of-2 free throws and gave the Tomcats a 54-53 advantage with 54 seconds to play, but UP-B's Calista Walker buried a jumper with 23 seconds remaining to give the Panthers the one-point win ... Sophomore G Kirsten Schrecongost finished with 11 points and five assists, while freshman G Nicole Valentino added eight points and a career-high 10 rebounds ... Against Westminster, the Tomcats were led by Valentino's six-point, four-rebound effort ... Schrecongost had five points and a team-high six rebounds.

## Westminster Lady Titans

The Lady Titans snapped a two-game losing streak by posting wins over nonconference opponent Penn State-Altoona (82-54) on Monday and at league foe Thiel (53-31) on Saturday ... Freshman G Desiree Sterling led four double-digit scorers against PS-A with 16 points, followed by junior F Erica Tallo with 14, junior G Erin Morrow with a season-high 13, and junior G Alyson Gasper with 12 ... Tallo and Gasper each hauled in six rebounds, while Gasper added three steals and tied Morrow and freshman G Rachel Eaton with four assists each ... Tallo and Sterling led a balanced scoring attack at Thiel with 10 points apiece ... Gasper added team-high totals of seven rebounds and four assists in the win, while Tallo added three steals.

**Upcoming Game Notes:** Bethany will look to extend its 12-game win streak this week against Waynesburg and at W&J ... The Bison lead the PAC with a 6-0 record, its best league start since finishing the 1999-2000 season with an 8-0 PAC mark ... Bethany is 2-0 against Waynesburg and W&J this season, defeating the Yellow Jackets 67-58 on Jan. 21 and W&J 63-40 on Jan. 24 ... Against Waynesburg, **Nikki Babik** led the squad with 15 points ... **Kelley Richardson** led the way against W&J with 19 points and 13 rebounds, while Babik added 17 points on 3-of-6 shooting from beyond the arc.

Abby Moose moved past Jill Sinclair (769 points, 1981-85) and Julie Irons (772 points, 1987-90) into 11<sup>th</sup> place on GCC's all-time scoring list with 778 points ... ... The Lady Titans won at Waynesburg 68-56 on Jan. 24, as Sterling had a game-high 15 points ... Tallo added 12 points and a game-high 12 rebounds, while **Rena Paroz** came off the bench to tally a career-high 11 points.
