PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

SHAWNDRA MCDONALD

Washington & Jefferson College 5-3 Junior Guard Houston, Tex./Westfield H.S.

McDonald scored 21 points and added eight rebounds, five assists and four steals as W&J remained undefeated in PAC play with a 64-50 win over Waynesburg. In the process, she became just the eighth player in the program's history to surpass 1,000 career points.

Also nominated was freshman G **Renee Shehady** of Bethany, sophomore G **Abby Moose** of Grove City, senior F **Kyana Bradley** of Waynesburg, and senior F **Samor Himes** of Westminster.

PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison

Bethany's troubles in the PAC continued as they blew a 10-point lead with eight minutes to go in losing for the second time to Grove City ... The Bison opened up the game with a 19-6 lead but GCC cut it to 32-26 by halftime... Bethany's shooting woes reappeared as the Green and White hit just eight of 28 attempts (29 percent) in losing a halftime lead for the second time this year to Grove City... Center Kelley Richardson went for 17 points and 16 rebounds and guard Renee Shehady had a career-high 15 points, along with five rebounds and four assists ... The four PAC losses are the most for Bethany since a 4-6 league finish in 1997-98, which was head coach Jina DeRubbo's first season.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J continues to be ranked third in the Great Lakes region and has won ninestraight contests ... The Presidents also received three votes in last week's D3Hoops.com Top 25 poll ... W&J boasts the No. 4 ranked scoring defense in D-III (49.3 ppg) ... The Presidents have held opponents to 50 or less points 10 times in 14 games ... Three-time PAC Player of the Week Leigh Sulkowski was also named to the D3Hoops.com Team of the Week last week ... The Presidents ran out to a 19-3 lead over Waynesburg on Saturday and fought off a late Yellow Jacket charge in recording the 14-point victory ... Sulkowski scored a game-high 26 points for W&J on 6-of-16 shooting, while adding 10 rebounds for her fourth career double-double.

Grove City Lady Wolverines

The Lady Wolverines snapped a twogame losing streak with a come-from-behind victory over Bethany Saturday ... Abby Moose drained four second-half three-pointers to spark Grove City's comeback on her way to a game-high 18 points ... Tammy Hess and Leigh LeGare each tossed in 10 as Grove City completed its first sweep of the Bison since 1998 ... Bethany held the lead for the first 38:42 of the game before Grove City took the lead on consecutive threes from Moose ... Bethany led by as many as 13, 19-6, in the first half ... Each team had 37 rebounds ... Moose and LeGare each scored 14 for Grove City in the Lady Wolverines' 62-56 loss to Pitt-Greensburg last Monday night.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg lost its lone game of the week to Washington & Jefferson, 64-50, after cutting a 21-point first-half lead to eight in the second half ... Candice Eyerman hit a three-pointer from the top of the arc with 3:21 remaining to cut the Presidents' deficit to 57-49 ... Neither team scored until the 0:52 mark when W&J's Leigh Sulkowski answered with a three-pointer of her own to put the game out of reach ... Kyana Bradley scored 13 first-half points, including three threepointers, before going on to a team-high 19 points to lead Waynesburg ... Bradley also led the Jackets with 10 rebounds (nine defensive), while adding four steals ... Her second-straight double-double is also her sixth of the season.

Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcat losing streak now stands at three games with losses to non-conference John Carroll (79-59) on Monday and PAC foe Westminster (57-33) on Saturday ... Thiel led by seven in the first half against JCU, but the Blue Streaks finished the period on a 14-2 run to claim a 36-31 lead at the half ... Junior F Danielle Mezzulo finished with 13 points and seven caroms while senior G Mayumi Sasaki added 10 points and junior G Kerry Gutherie chipped in with eight points ... Thiel finished with a 20.3 shooting percentage in their 57-33 loss at Westminster on Saturday ... Westminster outscored Thiel 39-19 in the second half ... Junior F Amanda Swanson led all scorers with 17 points and eight boards.

Westminster Lady Titans

The Lady Titans dropped a 68-57 nonconference game at Penn State-Altoona on Monday, before ending their five-game skid with a 57-33 PAC victory over Thiel on Saturday ... Senior F Samor Himes and sophomore F Mary Jane Eaton tied for team-high scoring honors at PS-A with 11 points apiece, followed closely by senior G Jennifer Petures with 10 points while also grabbing a team-best eight rebounds ... Westminster outscored Thiel 39-19 in the second half to break open an 18-14 halftime lead ... Senior G Ashley Kenney was the lone Westminster player to reach double figures with 15 points (on 7-of-16 shooting) while adding a game-high four assists ... Three WC players hauled in double-digit rebound totals, led by Eaton with 12 caroms.

Upcoming Game Notes: Bethany will be going for its 16th consecutive win against Waynesburg Wednesday... The Bison nearly lost a 26-point second half lead but held off a late Yellow Jacket rally for a 73-66 win Jan. 22... **Katie Hardie** had 16 points and **Kelley Richardson** amassed 14 points and 13 rebounds in the win ... Bethany will try to avenge a 60-48 loss to W&J when the Presidents visit Saturday ... Bethany shot just 27 percent (18-67) in posting their lowest point total since an 80-46 loss at Capital in the 1997 NCAA Tournament ... **Renee Shehady** (13 points) and **Jenny Place** (11) came off the bench to lead BC.
