She scored a game-high 22 points and added eight boards in a 73-52 PAC road win at Waynesburg, then recorded 17 points and six caroms in a 73-40 league road victory at Grove City. For the week, Dickman shot 57 percent (16-of-28) from the field and was a perfect 7-of-7 at the free throw line.

Also nominated was freshman G Anne Wilson of Bethany, sophomore F Christine Slater of Grove City, senior F Emily Hays of Washington & Jefferson, sophomore F Elisha Jones of Waynesburg, and junior G Amy Dolsak of Westminster.

#### PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL 2008-09 - Week 10 Conference Notes

TMC, W&J SHOWDOWN SET: The "Game of the Year" in PAC women's basketball takes place this Wednesday, Feb. 11 in Crestview Hills, Ky. Sole possession of first place in the PAC will be on the line when Thomas More hosts Washington & Jefferson at 5:30 p.m. The Saints currently hold a half-game lead over the Presidents in the PAC standings. However, W&J handed Thomas More its only conference loss of the season on Jan. 10 with a 68-62 victory in Washington, Pa.

WHO'S HOT: Thomas More is ranked 10th (D3Hoops.com) and 13th (WBCA) in the two national D-III Top 25 polls, while W&J is 21st in D3Hoops.com and is the top team also receiving votes in the WBCA ... W&J senior F Emily Hays surpassed the 1,000-point plateau ... Bethany has now won four straight, after freshman G Anne Wilson averaged 12.5 ppg and 5.0 rpg in two wins last week ... Sophomore F Elisha Jones averaged 18.0 points and 5.0 rebounds per game for 1-1 Waynesburg.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Saint Vincent set a new single-game team record with 29 steals in a win over Geneva ... Grove City's Christine Slater averaged 16.5 ppg and 10.0 rpg in a 1-1 week ... Sophomore Katie Sheerer sank two free throws to clinch Chatham's first-ever win over Geneva, 58-56 ... Geneva's Michawn Rich posted 11 points and 13 rebounds in the loss to Chatham ... Amber Bodrick scored 25 points for Thiel in a loss to Bethany ... Amy Dolsak of Westminster averaged 12.0 ppg during an 0-2 week.


#### Chatham Cougars (10-11, 2-8 PAC)

## Washington & Jefferson Presidents (19-2, 10-1 PAC)






## Westminster Titans (6-14, 3-8 PAC)
