Wilson led the Bison to a 2-0 week in PAC action, averaging

19.5 points and 3.0 steals per game, while shooting 64 percent (7-of-11) from three-point range. She sank three treys and totaled a game-high 18 points to go along with three steals in Bethany's 55-52 road win at Thiel. Wilson then recorded a career-high 21 points on four three-pointers to go along with four assists and three steals in the Bison's 69-67 overtime upset win over Grove City.

Also nominated was sophomore G Megan Gebrosky of Grove City, junior C Nicole Dickman of Thomas More, freshman G Emily Abraham of Washington & Jefferson, sophomore G Hannah Hunter of Waynesburg, and senior G Amy Dolsak of Westminster.

PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL 2009-10 - Week 12 Conference Notes

SAINTS IN COMMAND: The battle of nationally-ranked PAC women's basketball powers Saturday was decided early, as #15 Thomas More jumped out to a quick 17-2 lead en route to a 64-38 home victory over #18 Washington & Jefferson. With the win over the Presidents, the Saints now control their own destiny and can clinch the PAC regular season title and the top seed and hosting rights for the 2010 PAC Tournament by winning their remaining conference games.

NEWS & NOTES: In the first NCAA regional rankings (released last week prior tio the TMC-W&J game), W&J is ranked second and Thomas More third in the Great Lakes Region ... Brittany Sedlock of Saint Vincent had a near triple-double in a win over Geneva, posting 19 points, 17 rebounds and eight steals ... Junior G Hannah Hunter averaged 13.0 ppg, 6.0 apg and 3.0 rpg for 2-0 Waynesburg ... Senior G Amy Dolsak averaged 18.5 ppg and 5.5 rpg last week for 1-1 Westminster.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: W&J's loss to Thomas More marked the first game in 11 years (301 games) that the Presidents were held to less than 40 points ... Sophomore G Megan Gebrosky scored a career-high 19 points for Grove City in a win vs. Chatham ... Renee Rawding scored 19 points for Geneva in a loss to Thomas More ... Junior G Barb Petty averaged 11.0 ppg last week for 0-2 Chatham ... Sophomore F Ashley Davis had 14 points and five rebounds for Thiel in a PAC loss to Bethany.

PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison (7-14, 4-7 PAC)

The Bison joined the middle of the pack in the PAC with a pair of thrilling victories last week ... Audra Droginske scored the go-ahead bucket with 45 sec-

onds left and Bethany held on for a 55-52 triumph at Thiel for their 1st road win of the year ... Anne Wilson hit a trio of three-pointers and was credited with 18 points, while Taylor Kress came off the bench to record 13 points and 7 rebounds ... Wilson hit 4 treys, as she scored a careerhigh 21 points to help the Bison knock off Grove City 69-67 in OT ... BC matched a season-best with 9 triples, which helped offset a 39-31 GCC rebounding advantage ... Katelynn Hackathorn registered her 2nd double-double of the year with 13 points and 11 boards.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (7-14)

The Golden Tornadoes dropped a 93-63 decision to nationally ranked Thomas More last Wednesday night ... After pulling to within three points six GOLDEN TORNADOES minutes into the game. Geneva would never get

closer ... The Golden Tornadoes fell to 0-6 all-time against the Saints since joining the PAC three years ago ... Renee Rawding missed her first six shots but turned things around with a team-best 19 points, including 16 second-half points ... The Golden Tornadoes dropped their 10th consecutive road game on Monday night in an 82-60 loss at Saint Vincent ... Falling to 0-10 on the road, Geneva will look for its first road win on Wednesday at Chatham.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (16-5)

The Bearcats split a pair of games on the week, recovering from a tough 66-58 loss at W&J Wednesday with a rousing 82-60 home win over Geneva Monday ... In the victory over the GTs, Brittany Sedlock stole the

show, narrowly missing a triple-double with 19 points, 17 rebounds, and eight steals ... Emily Fenton added 18 points and Megan DePrimio a career-high 10, while the Bearcat defense forced 39 Geneva turnovers and tallied 19 steals ... The W&J tilt featured five ties and five lead changes, with the Presidents ending the game on a 15-7 run to earn the comeback win ... Devin McGrath bucketed a career-high 24 points along with five steals, while Ashley Bellovich scored 11.

Thomas More Saints (19-2, 10-1 PAC)

The 15th-ranked Saints took over sole possession of first place in the PAC with a pair of wins last week, as they defeated Geneva, 93-63, and 18th-

ranked Washington & Jefferson, 64-38 ... In the win over Geneva, junior C Nicole Dickman made a layup with 2:27 left in the first half to become the 13th women's basketball player in TMC history to score 1,000 points ... In the win over nationally-ranked W&J, the Saints shot 56 percent from the field and were led in scoring by freshman G Chelsea Tolliver with a game-high 16 points ... For the week, Dickman led the team in scoring and rebounding with 17.0 points per game ... For the season, Tolliver leads the team in scoring with 14.1 ppg

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (8-13, 5-7 PAC)

Waynesburg enjoyed a perfect 2-0 week against PAC opponents this past week as they downed Westminster and Thiel, respectively ... Sophomore

PG Hannah Hunter led the Yellow Jackets in scoring in each contest ... The Hopewell native dropped 13 points on both the Titans and Tomcats and averaged six assists per contest ... She just missed a doubledouble when she dropped nine assists (which ties her for the highest single-game total in the PAC this season) at Westminster ... Junior F Elisha Jones (11.0 points per game) and sophomore G Morgan Hoone (10.5 points per game) also averaged double digits in scoring ... Hoone poured in a game-high 17 for Waynesburg at Westminster.


Chatham Cougars (8-13, 2-9 PAC)

First up for Chatham this week was Grove City in PAC play ... The Wolverines were able to hold on to defeat the

Cougars 57-40 - Chatham's first loss to Grove City since entering the PAC ... No Cougars finished in double figures in the loss; junior G Felicia Brown finished the contest with nine points ... Chatham hosted Westminster Sunday due to the severe weather conditions ... The Titans had no trouble defeating the Cougars, as three players finished in double figures to propel Westminster to victory, 83-41 ... Junior G Barb Petty led Chatham with 14 points ... Teammate Kayla Hilko chipped in with nine points of her own and grabbed a team-high nine rebounds in the loss.

Grove City Wolverines (10-11, 7-5 PAC)

Grove City is 7-5 in the PAC after splitting a pair of recent league games ... The Wolverines opened the week with a 57-40 win over visiting Chatham Wednesday ...



Thiel Tomcats (6-14, 2-8 PAC)

The Thiel College women's basketball team suffered their 13th loss of the season by the score of 52-55 to the Bethany College Bison Wednesday ... Sopho-

more F Ashley Davis led the way for the 'Cats tallying 14 points and grabbing five boards, while Kasey Landis knocked down 2-of-3 shots from beyond the arc, for a total of eight points, four assists, three rebounds and two steals ... Thiel's shooting touch ran as cold as the weather in their 42-52 loss to the Waynesburg University Yellow Jackets on Monday ... Kelly Barzak led the visiting Tomcats with a teamhigh 12 points, while amassing four blocked shots.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (18-3, 9-2 PAC)

One of the longest win streaks (11 games) in W&J history came to an end Saturday as Thomas More posted a 64-38 victory in Kentucky ... The Presidents were held below 40 points for the first time in 11 years (a span of 301 games) ... Grove City limited W&J to 31 points

on Feb. 2, 1999 ... The first NCAA regional rankings were released this week and W&J is the No. 2 team ... The Presidents extended the win streak to 11 games with an eight-point home win over Saint Vincent Wednesday which was highlighted by a pair of late three-pointers by freshman G Emily Abraham ... Senior PG Kennan Killeen finished with 15 points and seven assists.

Westminster Titans (8-13, 6-5 PAC)

Westminster saw its season-long losing streak extended to three games with a 58-55 loss at home to Waynesburg Wednesday, before break-

ing the skid in resounding fashion Sunday at Chatham, 83-41 ... The Titans' 83 points were a season-high (surpassing their previous best of 76), while Chatham's 41 points were also the fewest points allowed by Westminster this season (the previous low was 48) ... Westminster also shot a season-best 46.4 percent (26-56) from the field and posted a season-high 59 rebounds ... Senior G Amy Dolsak averaged 18.5 points per game during the week, including 19 vs. Chatham and 18 vs. Waynesburg ... Freshman F Andi Ridge averaged 11.0 ppg.
