McCormick averaged 13.5 points, 6.5 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 2.5 steals per game for the 2-0 Bison last week, as Bethany strengthened its hold on third place in the PAC with wins over league rivals Thiel (78-67) and Saint Vincent (66-57). She posted career-highs with 19 points and eight rebounds in the Thiel victory, while adding four steals.

Also nominated was first-year G **Kayla Holko** of Chatham, junior G **Jayne Thiem** of Thomas More, sophomore G **Stephanie Smith** of Washington & Jefferson, and senior G/F **Emilee Ackerman** of Westminster.

Bethany Bison

Bethany scored a pair of wins last week, rallying to beat Thiel at home 78-67 and pulling away from Saint Vincent for a 66-57 triumph ... The Bison trailed by eight at halftime to Thiel, but outscored the Tomcats 51-32 in the second half ... **Kaitlyn McCormick** led five scores in double figures with a career-high 19, while **Kelly Goode** recorded her first career double-double with 16 points and 10 boards ... BC held Saint Vincent to 26 second half points and posted a 52-36 rebounding advantage in scoring a nine-point Saturday ... **Susannah Cartland** posted 19 points and five rebounds, while **Tara Harris** and **Renee Brandenburg** both had 10.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes



The Golden Tornadoes have now won four straight ... Last week, Geneva rallied for a pair of come-from-behind victories over Saint Vincent and Chatham ... After starting the game with a 13-0 lead against the Bearcats, Geneva watched Saint Vincent rally for a 28-25 halftime lead ... **Allyson Clarke** led the charge with 22 points and 17 rebounds ... It was the first time Geneva had beaten Saint Vincent in Latrobe since 1984 ... Saturday, Geneva was forced to come back from ten points down in the second half against Chatham ... Clarke posted 24 points, while **Renee Rawding** was 10-of-10 from the foul line for 14 points in the 62-53 comeback victory.



Saint Vincent Bearcats

The Lady Bearcats lost two close contests at home, falling to Geneva Wednesday and Bethany Saturday ... Against the Golden Tornadoes, SVC enjoyed a five point lead with six minutes left, until Geneva ended the contest on a 13-5 run ... It was a defensive struggle, as each team shot an identical 31 percent from the field ... **Maria Baroffio** came off the bench to lead Saint Vincent with 13 points, while **Caryn Glassbrenner** blocked six shots ... Saturday, Bethany spoiled SVC's Senior Night with a 66-57 win ... **Laura Klimchok** led the Bearcats with 15 points, while adding five steals ... Glassbrenner blocked five shots.



Thomas More Saints

No. 5 Thomas More set a school record, allowing just 23 points in the 59-23 victory over Waynesburg ... **Jayme Thiem** scored a team-high 13 points in the win ... Sophomore **Carrie Fay** scored a career-high 10 points in Thomas More's 82-40 win over Grove City ... **Alex Gee** led the way with 13 points, while Thiem added 11 ... Thiem averaged 12 points and five rebounds in just 18.5 minutes of play ... She added 10 steals, eight assists and just one turnover.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The struggles for Waynesburg continued last week, as the Yellow Jackets extended their dubious school record losing streak to 20 games ... The Yellow Jackets suffered a 59-23 loss to No. 5 Thomas More on Wednesday after shooting just 23 percent (9-of-39) and committing 23 turnovers ... Junior F **Jeanette Wonsettler** led the team with six points and five rebounds ... The 23 points marks the lowest single-game point total in school history ... Waynesburg dropped a 49-26 contest at home to Westminster despite holding the Titans to just 30 percent from the field ... Three Yellow Jackets tied for the team high with six points each.



Chatham Cougars

Chatham earned a season sweep over Grove City College Wednesday with a 63-56 win ... The Cougars were led by first-year **Kayla Hilko** with 15 points ... The win raised the Cougars' PAC record to 4-6 ... Chatham built a 10-point lead in the second half against Geneva Saturday, but the Golden Tornadoes came back to win 62-52 ... Chatham wore pink uniforms for the game as part of the WBCA "Think Pink" campaign to fight breast cancer ... More than \$600 was raised for the Susan G. Komen Foundation in donations.



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City's hopes of hosting a PAC tournament quarterfinal took a severe hit last week as the Wolverines dropped a pair of conference games ... Wednesday, freshman F **Christine Slater** recorded career highs in both points (25) and rebounds (12) against Chatham ... Grove City out-rebounded the Cougars, 46-30, but surrendered nine three-point goals ... Saturday, Thomas More closed the first half on a 21-2 run against the Wolverines ... Junior G **Katy McCready** recorded a career-high nine points to lead Grove City, while freshman **Jenna Johnston** added eight points.



Thiel Tomcats

Thiel fell on the road at Bethany, 78-67, Wednesday before losing at home to W&J, 87-66, on Saturday ... Junior G **Amber Bodrick** finished with 28 points, eight rebounds and five blocks against the Bison, helping the Tomcats get out to an eight-point halftime lead ... Against the Presidents, sophomore F **Jasmin Jones** finished with a game-high 16 points and five rebounds, while freshman F **Kim Stitt** added 12 points and nine rebounds and junior G **Jena Cook** added 10 markers.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents

The Presidents have won seven of their last eight, including a pair of PAC victories this week ... Sophomore Gs **Kennan Killeen** and **Stephanie Smith** both scored 17 points Wednesday to lead the victory over Westminster ... W&J made 22-of-29 free throw attempts, while the Lady Titans only made four trips to the charity stripe ... Junior F **Emily Hays** added 11 points and five rebounds ... W&J avenged an early-season upset loss to Thiel with a 21-point victory in Greenville ... 13 different Presidents scored led by sophomore F **Maggie Gibson's** 14-point, 14-rebound double-double ... W&J held a 56-29 edge on the glass.



Westminster Titans

Westminster snapped its season-long, six-game losing streak with a 49-26 win at Waynesburg Saturday, after losing at W&J 77-65 Wednesday ... The Titans finished the week in fourth place in the PAC standings with a 5-6 league mark, a half game ahead of Chatham ... Senior G/F **Emilee Ackerman** averaged 17.5 points, including 12 at W&J and 23 at Waynesburg to go with 10 rebounds ... The 26 points scored by Waynesburg was the lowest by a Westminster opponent all season ... In the W&J game, senior F **Terese Marszalek** had 14 points and seven rebounds, while sophomore G **Jessica Mueseler** bucketed a career-high 13 points.

Bethany Bison

vs. Grove City* (2/13)

The Bison host a pair of PAC contests this week when Grove City and Chatham come to Bethany ... BC is one win away from clinching a first round home game in the PAC Tournament and two wins away from guaranteeing no worse than the third seed ... The Bison bench outscored Grove City 30-0 in the team's first meeting on Jan. 12, a 56-47 Bethany win, which was their fifth in a row over GCC ... **Kelly Goode** scored 17 of her career-high 23 points in the second half to help Bethany erase a 14-point halftime deficit and win 67-60 at Chatham Jan. 16.

Geneva has defeated Waynesburg in seven of the past nine meetings, including a 60-47 victory back on January 12 ... **Renee Rawding** carried Geneva early in the game with 21 points, including four first half three-point field goals ... The Golden Tornadoes will welcome Thomas More to Metheny Fieldhouse for the first time ... The Saints enter the week at 21-0 and ranked 5th in both NCAA Division III polls ... In the first meeting, Geneva was held to a season low 34 points in a 56-34 loss.

W&J still leads the overall series, 6-2, including all four at Henry Memorial ... In the team's first-ever meeting, Thomas More forced 17 turnovers and limited Geneva to 22 percent shooting in its 56-34 victory ... **Alex Gee** had a team-high 11 points.
