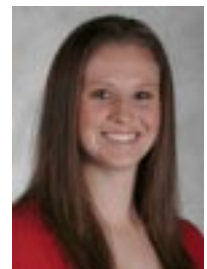

Mitchell averaged 20.0 points and 3.0 rebounds per game for the 1-1 Bison last week. She recorded a career-high 29 points in an 83-65 home win over PAC foe Waynesburg, hitting 10-of-16 shots including 5-of-6 three-pointers. Mitchell then tallied 11 points (her sixth straight game in double figures) in a 67-54 loss at PAC co-leader W&J.

Also nominated was junior C **Rachel McCoy** of Grove City, senior G **Nicole Valentino** of Thiel, junior F **Maria Hillenbrand** of Washington & Jefferson, and senior G **Desiree Sterling** of Westminster.

PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES



Bethany Bison

Bethany won its second in a row Wednesday before falling on the road at W&J Saturday ... The Bison set a season-high in points and field goal percentage (54.4) in an 83-65 victory over Waynesburg, which moved them into fourth place in the PAC ... **Lisa Mitchell** hit 5-of-6 three-pointers and scored a career-high 29 points, while **Kaitlyn McCormick** also established a new personal-best with 17 markers in the win over the Yellow Jackets ... Bethany continued its hot play by rolling to a 36-24 half-time lead against W&J, but couldn't maintain it, as the Presidents rallied to deal BC a 67-54 setback ... **Nicole Thompson** scored 14 points and handed out six assists to stay atop the PAC in helpers, while **Renee Brandenburg** recorded 12 points and 10 rebounds.



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City dropped a pair of decisions last week ... Saturday night, junior C **Rachel McCoy** became Grove City's 9th all-time 1,000-point scorer with a 12-point outing at Saint Vincent ... She now has 1,002 career points ... Junior **Shannon Overdorff** led Grove City with 15 points at Saint Vincent while **Laura Miller** added 13 ... Miller has scored in double figures in four of Grove City's last five games ... McCoy led Grove City with 16 points against Westminster Wednesday night ... After holding Thiel to just 19.7 percent shooting from the floor Jan. 31, Grove City has allowed its three most recent opponents to shoot a combined 52 percent from the floor.



Thiel Tomcats

Thiel dropped a pair of games last week, falling at Saint Vincent 63-69 on Wednesday before losing 58-69 at home to Thomas More on Saturday ... Senior **Nicole Valentino** scored her 1,000th career point during Saturday's loss to Thomas More ... **Amber Bodrick** paced the Tomcats against Saint Vincent with 23 points, 12 rebounds and two steals ... Valentino scored 13 while **Fontella Jones** scored eight with 13 boards ... Bodrick and Valentino each scored 19 in the Tomcats' loss to Thomas More.



Thomas More Saints

Thomas More rebounded from its first home PAC loss ever to defeat Thiel, 69-58, to remain in a three-way tie for first place ... In the win, **Megan Wood** and **Alex Gee** each scored 13 points to lead the way, while **Kristen Humphrey** had eight points and a team-high six rebounds ... Three other players – **Brooke Warner**, **Jennifer Teski** and **Tangie Sellers** – added nine points in a balanced attack ... In the loss to W&J, TMC scored just one point in overtime – a Humphrey free throw ... Wood and Sellers had nine points each to lead the Saints.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents

W&J extended its win streak to four games with a pair of wins last week ... The Presidents, who have won 10 of their last 11 games, forced a three-way tie atop the PAC standings with a 49-48 win at Thomas More Wednesday ... Junior F **Jen Rogers** scored the only field goal in overtime with 1:18 remaining ... Sophomore G **Veronica Kust** and freshman PG **Kennan Killeen** had 11 and 10 points, respectively ... W&J forced TMC into a 28-percent shooting night ... Junior F **Maria Hillenbrand** netted a career-high 18 points and grabbed nine rebounds to help W&J erase a 12-point halftime deficit on Saturday ... The Presidents used a 22-2 run over the first 10 minutes to earn the victory ... Sophomore F **Emily Hays** collected 13 points and 13 rebounds.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Yellow Jackets failed to post a win on the road last week at Bethany (60-43) and at Westminster (83-65) ... This season, Waynesburg failed to post a road victory in six PAC games and have lost four straight overall ... Sophomore F **Jeanette Wonsettler** registered a career game in the loss to the Bison Wednesday, as she tallied her third double-double of the season with 17 points and 14 rebounds ... Seniors **Denise Kennedy** and **Katie Lewandowski** added 11 and 10 points, respectively ... In Saturday's loss to the Titans, no Yellow Jacket player reached double figures in scoring, as Kennedy led the team with nine points and Wonsettler posted eight off the bench ... The game was tied at 27-27 at halftime before Waynesburg shot just 26.9 percent (7-of-26) from the floor in the second half.



Westminster Titans

Westminster picked up two PAC wins with a 71-39 victory at Grove City Wednesday before beating Waynesburg, 60-43, at home Saturday ... The Titans improve to 18-5 as they are now just the fourth team in program's 36-year history to win 18 games in a season ... Four Titans scored in double figures against Grove City, led by senior G **Desiree Sterling** scoring 12 points ... Westminster went on a 27-5 run after trailing early and would go up by as many as 36 points in the second half ... Against Waynesburg, the Titans were tied at halftime before outscoring the Jackets, 33-16, in the second half ... Sterling again led the Titans with a game-high 25 points.



Saint Vincent Bearcats

The Bearcats closed their home schedule with wins against PAC opponents Thiel (69-63) and Grove City (85-63) last week ... Junior **Laura Klimchock** scored a career-high 33 points against Grove City, pushing her to 1,002 in her career ... She went 14-of-16 from the free throw line, giving her 153 (made) free throws on the year, just three shy of the school record which was set in 33 games by **Kelly Morda** in 1999 ... Klimchock will likely break the record in just her 22nd game of the year ... Sophomore **Janelle Reed** had a career-high 24 points in the same game ... Sophomore **Lauren Reilly** had a season-high 16 points against Thiel.

BC seniors **Lindsay Ammirante**, **Courtney Irwin** and **Abbey Scarsella** will be honored prior to Wednesday's game with the Bearcats ... The Bison will try to avenge an 80-56 loss at SVC in their first meeting, which saw Irwin total 19 points and nine rebounds and **Mandi Swiger** record 15 markers and 12 boards ... In the first match-up with Westminster, the Titans used a 34-8 opening run to propel them to a 70-49 victory over the Bison.
