McGrath earned her second PAC weekly honor of the season after averaging 17.5 points, 9.5 rebounds, 4.5 assists and 3.5 steals per game for Saint Vincent, which kept its hopes for a PAC regular season title alive with a pair of league victories. She recorded a double-double with 21 points and 13 rebounds along with four steals and three assists in a 73-61 road win at Washington & Jefferson Wednesday. Saturday, she posted 14 points, six boards, six assists and three steals in just 22 minutes of an 81-45 decision over Geneva.

Also nominated was senior F **Katelynn Hackathorn** of Bethany, sophomore F **Carly Zelenak** of Chatham, junior G **Leah Gibson** of Grove City, senior F **Ashley Davis** of Thiel, sophomore G **Devin Beasley** of Thomas More, senior F **Ashley Kirkpatrick** of Washington & Jefferson, senior PG **Hannah Hunter** of Waynesburg, and senior G **Emily Montone** of Westminster.

PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL 2011-12 - Week 12 Conference Notes

FIRST PLACE SHOWDOWN: Barring a late upset, the top seed for the 2011-12 PAC Women's Basketball Tournament will be on the line Wednesday in Kentucky, when first-place Thomas More hosts second-place Saint Vincent at 6 p.m. ... The five-time defending champion Saints are 15-1 in PAC play after a big PAC road win at Waynesburg Saturday and hold a one-game lead over the Bearcats, but Saint Vincent handed TMC its only league loss, 68-65, on Jan. 14 in Latrobe.

NEWS AND NOTES: Sophomore G **Katie Kitchen** led 2-0 Thomas More in scoring by averaging 18.5 ppg ... Senior F **Ashley Davis** averaged 22.0 ppg on the week for 1-1 Thiel, including 26 in an OT loss to Bethany ... Washington & Jefferson senior F **Ashley Kirkpatrick** averaged a double-double (17.0 ppg, 11.5 rpg, 3.0 bpg) in a 1-1 week for the Presidents ... Senior PG **Hannah Hunter** averaged 14.0 ppg, 8.0 apg, 7.0 rpg and 4.0 spg on the week for 1-1 Waynesburg.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Bethany senior G **Anne Wilson** became just the 15th Bison woman to reach 1,000 career points with 23 at Thiel Saturday ... Grove City junior G **Leah Gibson** averaged 18.0 ppg and 3.0 apg for the 1-1 Wolverines ... Sophomore F **Carly Zelenak** averaged 19.5 ppg and 8.0 rpg for 0-2 Chatham ... Freshman **Chelsea Kaufmann** scored 17 points for Geneva vs. Saint Vincent ... Westminster senior **Emily Montone** scored 10 points for Westminster vs. Thomas More.

PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison (14-9, 10-6 PAC)



The Bison recovered from a tough loss at Waynesburg to pull out a hard-fought overtime at Thiel and maintain a two-game lead over Westminster for fourth place in the PAC ... **Kayla Taormina** scored 14 and **Katelynn Hackathorn** had 11, but Waynesburg pulled away for a 74-56 win over BC Wednesday ... Saturday saw Bethany rally from an eight-point deficit with six minutes to play to force OT and then escape with a 91-87 victory at Thiel ... **Anne Wilson** was 8-for-8 from the foul line in scoring a career-high 23 and became the 15th women's player in BC history to surpass 1,000 career points ... Taormina also netted 23 and Hackathorn totaled 19 points, 14 rebounds and five assists.

Chatham Cougars (4-19, 1-15 PAC)



The Cougars lost both PAC competitions last week ... They fell 67-55 to Grove City Wednesday ... **Carly Zelenak** posted a career-high 20 points, breaking her previous high from last season of 18 ... She scored 16 of these points in the second half ... **Marguerite Sargent** joined Zelenak on the scoreboard with 15 points ... Saturday, the Cougars dropped a 56-40 loss to Westminster ... Again, Zelenak was in the lead for the Cougars with her third double-double of the season ... She posted 19 points and 10 rebounds ... Sargent racked nine rebounds ... The Cougars were dominant in most of the first period, but ended up trailing 26-23 at the buzzer ... Missed free throws and turnovers in the second half resulted in the loss.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (3-20, 2-14 PAC)



In women's action, Geneva dropped games to Thiel and Saint Vincent and have now matched its season-long losing streak of ten straight ... The Golden Tornadoes could not generate enough offense in losses to Thiel and Saint Vincent ... **Beth DeLuca** led Geneva with 13 points in the loss to Thiel, while freshman **Chelsea Kauffman** scored 17 points on Saturday at Saint Vincent ... Geneva will close out the regular season with games at Washington & Jefferson and home against Westminster in the season finale ... DeLuca and **Rachel Rouan** will be honored as Geneva's senior class on Saturday night ... Geneva has a 3-20 overall record and a mark of 2-14 in conference play.

Grove City Wolverines (7-16, 6-10 PAC)



Grove City went 1-1 last week in conference play ... The Wolverines improved to 6-9 in the PAC Wednesday with a 67-55 win over Chatham ... GCC led by 26 early in the second half and maintained its double-digit lead throughout the second half ... **Leah Gibson** paced Grove City with 19 points while senior **Jayne Caldwell** added 11 ... **Annie Wells** grabbed a career-high 11 rebounds ... **Hannah Jo Coney** contributed nine points and nine rebounds ... **Megan Gebrosky** fired in a career-high 21 points Saturday at W&J, but the Wolverines dropped a 74-67 decision ... Gibson added 17 and **Kelsey Shirey** scored 10 ... Gibson also had five assists ... Grove City currently sits in a three-way tie for sixth in the league.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (19-4, 14-2 PAC)



The Bearcats have won 10 of 11 games after going 2-0 last week ... In Wednesday's 73-61 win at W&J, **Brittany Sedlock** and **Devin McGrath** combined for 41 points and 26 rebounds as each posted 13 boards and McGrath scored a game-best 21 points ... Senior G **Emily Fenton** added 12 points while freshman G **Jessica Welch** added eight points off the bench ... Five Bearcats scored in double digits on Saturday as SVC rolled to an 81-45 win against Geneva ... McGrath led the way with 14 points while Sedlock and Fenton added 13 and 12 points, respectively ... Junior F **Kendra Burchfield** and sophomore F **Ariel Rocco** each scored season highs with 11 and 10 points, respectively.

Thiel Tomcats (6-17, 6-10 PAC)



Last week the Tomcats went 1-1 in PAC play, defeating Geneva 72-42 and losing in overtime to Bethany ... In the win over Geneva, payback was on the mind after the GTs defeated the Tomcats in an early season home game ... **Ashley Davis** led a trio of double-digit scorers with a season-high 18 points on 9-of-17 shooting while grabbing eight rebounds ... **Kelly Barzak** added 16 points and a season-high seven blocks while **Kelly Muffley** chipped in 12 points ... As a team, the Tomcats tallied 10 blocks, a new season high ... In the overtime loss to the Bison, once again Davis and Barzak each scored a season-high 26 points ... Muffley added 12 points, six rebounds and three assists.

Thomas More Saints (19-4, 15-1 PAC)



Thomas More went 2-0 last week by defeating Westminster and Waynesburg both on the road ... Three Saints averaged in double-figure scoring last week as sophomore G **Katie Kitchen** averaged 18.5 points per game, sophomore G **Devin Beasley** averaged 17.0 ppg., and junior G **Allison Long** averaged 13.0 ppg. ... Junior C **Katie Kees** led the team on the boards with 9.5 rebounds per game, while Beasley led the team in assists with nine ... For the season, Kitchen leads the team in scoring with 15.4 ppg., and sophomore F **Moriah Corey** leads the team on the boards with 7.6 rpg., while Beasley leads the team in assists with 99 ... The Saints are shooting 42.9 percent from the field.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (11-12, 6-10 PAC)



W&J dropped a PAC home contest, 73-61, to Saint Vincent Wednesday ... W&J cut a 15-point second half deficit to just three before the Bearcats pulled away in the final minutes for a 12-point victory ... Senior **Ashley Kirkpatrick** led the Presidents with 13 points and 12 rebounds ... Classmate **Courtney Walsh** recorded 12 points, eight boards and a team-high four assists ... W&J ended its four-game losing skid by rallying from 11 points down to defeat Grove City 74-67 on Saturday ... Senior PG **Vanessa Rivera** led the comeback by scoring 18 of her 22 points during the second half ... Kirkpatrick produced her third-straight double-double with 21 points and 11 rebounds.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (17-6, 12-4 PAC)



Following a 74-56 win over Bethany Wednesday, the Yellow Jackets hosted Thomas More in a showdown of two of the top three teams in the PAC ... After building a 37-36 lead early in the second half, Waynesburg fell behind by as many as 12 points to the Saints ... The Jackets battled back to trim the deficit to just one point with 3:26 left, but couldn't complete the comeback in a 75-68 loss ... Four Yellow Jackets averaged double digits in points, including junior F **Paige Pearce**, who averaged a team-high 16.5 points per game ... Pearce exploded for a personal collegiate-high 21 points against Bethany while also pulling down seven rebounds and swiping four steals.
