Freshman guard Courtney Zitt led the Westminster Titans with 16.0 points and 7.5 rebounds per game in two PAC wins last week, decided by a combined three points. She sank a 35-foot buzzer beater in a 59-58 victory vs. Thiel, finishing the game with team-highs of 15 points, nine rebounds and three steals. Zitt also posted 17 points and six rebounds in a 55-53 decision vs. Washington & Jefferson.

Also nominated was junior F **Katelynn Hackathorn** of Bethany, senior F **Christine Slater** of Grove City, junior F **Brittany Sedlock** of Saint Vincent, sophomore F **Kelly Barzak** of Thiel, senior C **Nicole Dickman** of Thomas More, junior F **Ashley Kirkpatrick** of Washington & Jefferson, and senior F **Elisha Jones** of Waynesburg.



PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL 2010-11 - Week 12 Conference Notes

TMC-SVC SHOWDOWN SET: Thomas More extended its season-opening winning streak to 23 games last week with a pair of PAC wins ... Thomas More defeated Waynesburg 93-65 and Bethany 87-62 ... The Saints were the top-ranked team in both Division III national polls for the third straight week last week ... Saturday, Thomas More will be hosting Saint Vincent who is No. 2 in the PAC standings ... The Saints have a 6-1 all-time record against Saint Vincent with a 68-66 overtime win this season in Latrobe.

NEWS AND NOTES: Thomas More's **Nicole Dickman** averaged 21.5 points per game, while **Chelsea Tolliver** averaged 14.5 ppg on the week ... **Brittany Sedlock** averaged 20.5 points, 8.0 rebounds, and 5.0 steals in two wins for Saint Vincent ... **Christine Slater** averaged 21 pts and nine rebounds for 2-0 Grove City ... **Courtney Zitt** led Westminster with 16.0 pts and 7.5 rebounds per game ... **Lizz King** led Chatham over Geneva with a game-high 18 pts - all from behind the three point arc.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: **Elisha Jones** had a game-high 22 points and 12 rebounds for Waynesburg in the loss to Saint Vincent ... **Kelly Barzak** led the way for Thiel as she had a season-high 21 points and added seven rebounds in the loss to Grove City ... Geneva's **Beth DeLuca** scored a game high 17 points vs. Chatham ... **Ashely Kirkpatrick** averaged 16.5 points and 7.0 rebounds for W&J ... Bethany's **Katelynn Hackathorn** and **Anne Wilson** both scored 12 points in the loss to Saint Vincent.

Bethany Bison (11-12, 6-8 PAC)



The Bison dropped a pair of contests last week against the top two teams in the PAC ... Bethany fell behind #17 Saint Vincent by 10 at halftime and was held to only 20 pts after the break in suffering an 85-48 setback to the Bearcats ... **Katelynn Hackathorn** and **Anne Wilson** both scored 12 and **Renee Shepherd** grabbed 11 rebounds to help BC hold a 49-42 advantage on the boards ... The Bison dropped their second of the week with an 87-62 defeat to #1 Thomas More ... Shepherd led the BC offense with 11 pts and Hackathorn amassed 9 pts, 8 rebounds and 2 blocked shots.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (8-15)



Geneva struggled to a pair of PAC losses last week to Chatham and Grove City ... In both cases, it was a second half collapse that proved to be the difference ... The Golden Tornadoes were within striking distance in both games at the half but lost 60-48 to Chatham and fell 60-38 at Grove City ... **Beth DeLuca** scored a game high 17 pts against Chatham while senior **Christine Carugati** added 13 pts at Grove City ... The Golden Tornadoes will close out their season this week with a game at Westminster on Wednesday and then the home finale on Saturday night against Waynesburg.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (21-2, 13-1 PAC)



The 17th-ranked Bearcats clinched at least second place in the PAC after a 2-0 week, with conference wins over Bethany and Waynesburg ... In the 85-48 win over the Bison, the SVC defense limited Bethany to just 26 percent shooting and forced 26 turnovers ... Offensively SVC was led by **Brittany Sedlock's** 24 pts and **Emily Fenton's** 18 ... The win clinched Saint Vincent's 15th 20-win season in the program's history ... On Saturday, the Bearcats trailed 30-27 at halftime, before out-scoring Waynesburg 37-27 over the second half ... SVC tallied a season-high 22 steals, while forcing 29 turnovers ... Sedlock again led the way, posting her 10th double-double of the year with 17 pts and 12 rebounds to go with seven steals.

Thomas More Saints (23-0, 14-0 PAC)



Thomas More extended its season-opening winning streak to 23 games last week with a pair of PAC wins ... The Saints were the top-ranked team in both Division III national polls for the third straight week last week ... Four Saints averaged in double-figure scoring last week as **Nicole Dickman** averaged 21.5 pts per game, **Chelsea Tolliver** averaged 14.5 ppg., **Allison Long** and **Amy Stultz** each averaged 11.0 ppg. ... **Katie Kees** led the team on the boards as she averaged 10.0 rebounds per game, in blocked shots with five and steals with four, while Stultz led the team in assists with 10 ... For the season, the Saints are shooting 44.4 percent from the field on 580-of-1,305 shooting.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (16-7, 9-6 PAC)



The Waynesburg women's basketball team faced a pair of nationally-ranked PAC powers this week in number-one Thomas More and 17th-ranked Saint Vincent ... After struggling on the road at Thomas More, the Yellow Jackets led the Bearcats by as many as eight in the second half, but couldn't put the game away ... Though it came in a loss, senior forward **Elisha Jones** put together one of her best performances of the season against Saint Vincent ... She poured in a game-high 22 points, yanked down 12 rebounds and blocked a team season-high six shots.

Chatham Cougars (9-14, 4-10 PAC)



Chatham continued its winning streak this week with a 60-48 victory at Geneva on Wednesday ... **Lizz King** led the Cougars with a game-high 18 pts – all from behind the three point arc, tying a school record for Chatham ... On Saturday, Chatham took on visiting W&J on Senior Day ... Before tip-off, the Cougars honored six senior members of the team – the class with the most wins in school history – including **Courtney Smith**, Petty, **Felicia Brown**, **Kayla Hilko**, **Sonja Hoston**, and **Brittany Brown** ... Chatham held the lead by nine at halftime, but W&J was able to chip away and eventually earn the PAC victory 55-48 ... **Colleen Kiss** and Petty each contributed 11 pts (a season-high for Petty), while **Felicia Brown** added 10 of her own in the loss.

Grove City Wolverines (12-11, 7-7 PAC)



Grove City earned a pair of victories last week, moving back over the .500 mark overall ... In a 75-67 win Wednesday night at Thiel, four Grove City players scored in double figures: **Megan Gebrosky** (18), **Christine Slater** (17), **Leah Gibson** (16) and **Alison Wells** (11) ... The 75 points matched a season high for the Wolverines, who completed a season sweep of their in-county rival ... Saturday, Grove City humbled Geneva, 60-38 ... Slater led Grove City with 25 pts and 11 rebounds ... Gebrosky and Wells each scored 11 ... Wells also blocked five shots ... The Wolverines earned their seventh consecutive victory over Geneva and now lead the all-time series 25-22.

Thiel Tomcats (5-18, 3-11 PAC)



The Tomcat women's basketball team won were defeated in both of their contests this week dropping their record to 5-18 overall and 3-11 in the PAC ... In the first game of the week, Thiel was defeated by Grove City by a score of 75-67 ... **Kelly Barzak** led the way for Thiel as she had a season-high 21 pts and added seven rebounds ... The other two Tomcats in double figures were **Ashley Davis** and **Kelly Muffley** who had 15 pts and 12 pts respectively ... In the second game of the week, the Tomcats were defeated by a single pt 59-58 on a last second three point shot by Westminster guard **Courtney Zitt** ... Davis led all scorers with 16 pts and added seven rebounds and **Rianne Thornton** added 12 pts.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (9-14, 6-8 PAC)



Washington & Jefferson snapped a five-game losing streak with a 55-48 win in Pittsburgh over Chatham Saturday ... The Presidents are now 16-0 all-time against the Cougars ... **Jamie McKittrick** had 10 pts and eight rebounds ... She canned the game-tying jumper with three minutes left ... **Ashley Kirkpatrick** collected 15 pts and six boards, while **Catlyn Kriston** amassed a career-high 12 rebounds ... **Vanessa Rivera** hit two free-throws to break the tie and W&J did not allow a CU point in the final 3:25 ... McKittrick had 14 pts (all in second half) against Westminster Wednesday, but W&J fell just short.

Westminster Titans (6-17, 2-13 PAC)



Westminster won two close games last week to snap two losing streaks ... The Titans' 55-53 at W&J snapped a 13-game PAC losing streak, the Titans' longest since joining the conference in 2000 ... The Titans' 59-58 win over Thiel was Westminster's first home win of the season ... **Courtney Zitt** led the Titans with 16 pts and 7.5 rebounds per game ...
