PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

KELLEY RICHARDSON Bethany College

6-0 Senior Center Follansbee, W.Va./Brooke H.S.

Richardson averaged 26.5 points and 10.5 rebounds per game and shot 68.2 percent (16-of-22) from the field and 92 percent (23-of-25) from the line in two Bison wins last week. Bethany remained unbeaten in PAC play and extended its win streak to a school-record 14 games with wins over Waynesburg (89-63) and Washington & Jefferson (87-74). Richardson scored a career-high 36 points and grabbed 16 boards (one shy of her career-high) in the win over defending PAC champion W&J.

Also nominated was junior G **Abby Moose** of Grove City, senior G **Kerry Gutherie** of Thiel, sophomore G **Leigh Sulkowski** of Washington & Jefferson, freshman G **Steph Petchel** of Waynesburg, and freshman G **Desiree Sterling** of Westminster.

PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison

The Bison have won a school-record 14 consecutive games and remain perfect in the PAC with an 8-0 mark ... Saturday's win at W&J broke the 1997 team's previous school-record of 13 straight wins ... In that game, the Bison clinched at least a tie for first place in the PAC and head coach Jina DeRubbo became the program's all-time wins leader ... Now in her seventh season, she is 127-56 at Bethany ... The previous wins leader, Lisa Campanell Komara, needed 12 seasons to reach 126 victories ... Kelley Richardson poured in a career-high 36 points and missed her career rebounding mark by one with 16 boards against the Presidents ... She went 10-of-15 from the field and 16-of-18 from the line.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J's four-game win streak came to a halt Saturday as Bethany earned an 87-74 road victory ... W&J, which has lost all six games this season on Saturday, started the week with home wins over Pitt-Greensburg and Thiel ... Pitt-Greensburg was ranked fourth in the Great Lakes Region, but sophomore guard Leigh Sulkowski's 20 points, nine rebounds and four steals were too much for the Bobcats ... Sulkowski racked up 18 points in just 21 minutes in Wednesday's 30-point rout of Thiel ... Senior G Shawndra McDonald scored 27 points for W&J in the Bethany loss, while Sulkowski added 22 points and 14 rebounds ... McDonald became W&J's all-time assist leader on Saturday after notching her 449th career assist.

Grove City Lady Wolverines

Grove City evened its conference record with a win at Thiel Saturday ... Junior Abby Moose led Grove City with 14 points while sophomore Tammy Hess came off the bench to score 13 ... Center Sandy O'Keefe added 10 points and eight rebounds ... Moose and Rachel Romance each had four steals ... Moose drained four three-pointers Wednesday night as part of an 18-point night but Grove City fell at home to Westminster ... O'Keefe added 13 points ... Grove City attempted just six free throws in the loss, making three ... Grove City is just 4-4 at home but 7-5 away from home ... Seven different players have scored at least 100 points this season.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg won and lost decisively in a two-day span, as the Jackets led in the first half on Monday against Chatham 44-7 and trailed in the first half to Bethany 30-2 on Wednesday ... The Jackets went on to win by 51 points against Chatham in its final non-PAC game for the program's biggest win in six years, then went on to lose at Bethany (89-63) and on Saturday at Westminster (68-44) in PAC action ... Freshman G Steph Petchel led Waynesburg with her first career double-figure scoring game with 21 points against Chatham, and led Waynesburg with 12 points against Westminster ... Waynesburg's leading scorer sophomore G Candice Eyerman (13 ppg entering the week) scored a combined 12 points in three games this week.

Thiel Tomcats

The Thiel women dropped a pair of PAC matchups last week, losing on Wednesday at W&J 83-53 and falling at home to Grove City 66-53 on Saturday ... W&J led 31-11 at the 4:42 mark of the first half ... Junior G Laura Simonetti scored a team-high 14 markers for Thiel, while freshman F Fontella Jones and senior G Kerry Gutherie each added 10 points ... Thiel was limited to 35 percent (17-for-49) shooting on the night ... Grove City outscored Thiel 35-22 in the first half en route to its 66-53 victory ... Gutherie and Jones had 14 for Thiel in the loss ... Jones finished with a game-best 12 rebounds while Gutherie added seven ... Thiel shot just 34.9 percent (15-43) from the floor and 33.3 percent from three-point range.

Westminster Lady Titans

The Lady Titans ran their win streak to four games and moved into sole possession of second place in the PAC with league wins at Grove City (74-64) and at home vs. Waynesburg (68-44) ... Freshman G Desiree Sterling led the team in scoring in both wins, posting a careerhigh 21 points at GCC then adding 17 against the Yellow Jackets ... Junior G Alyson Gasper banked in a 50-footer as time expired before halftime at Grove City, lifting the Lady Titans to a 29-20 lead ... She finished with 11 points and 10 rebounds, her second double-double of the season ... Junior F Erica Tallo posted 16 points and 10 rebounds at GCC for her 12th double-double of the season, then added 11 points vs. Waynesburg.

Upcoming Game Notes: Bethany will look to wrap up the PAC regular season title and extend its school-record 14-game winning streak this week at Thiel and vs. Westminster ... Bethany last won the PAC regular season title in 2001-02 ... Bethany has already defeated both squads this season; Thiel at home by a score of 82-48 on Jan. 28, and at Westminster on Jan. 31, 82-64 ... With 36 points against W&J, Kelley Richardson moved into second place on the Bethany all-time scoring list ... She now has 1,646 career points, passing current Westminster head coach Rosanne Scott (1,636 career points from 1996-2000).

Junior G **Laura Simonetti**, sophomore G **Heather Abate** and freshman G **Nicole Valentino** each had 10 points in the lopsided loss ... Thiel picked up its only PAC win of the season it its 53-50 win over the Lady Yellow Jackets on Jan. 31 behind freshman F **Fontella Jones**' 12-point, 12-rebound effort.

This season at Grove City, the Jackets lost 76-69, despite leading by 17 points with eight minutes left in the game ... The Jackets host Thiel on Saturday, a team it defeated four times last year before losing at Greenville this season, 53-50.

Grove City has won 17 straight meetings against Waynesburg ... In the first meeting Jan. 28, Waynesburg led 65-48 with 8:28 left in the game but Grove City closed with a 28-2 run.
