#### KELLY BARZAK Thiel

Barzak led the Tomcats to a 2-0 week, which clinched the #6 seed in this week's PAC Tournament for Thiel, by averaging 23.0 points, 6.5 rebounds and 3.5 blocked shots per game. She tallied 20 points and four blocks while shooting 9-of-10 from the field in just 24 minutes in a 76-54 win over Chatham Wednesday. On Saturday in a 63-59 victory against rival Grove City, she tallied 26 points on 10-of-16 shooting while adding seven rebounds, three blocks and a pair of assists.

Also nominated was senior G **Anne Wilson** of Bethany, sophomore F **Carly Zelenak** of Chatham, sophomore F **Hannah Jo Coneby** of Grove City, senior F **Brittany Sedlock** of Saint Vincent, junior G **Allison Long** of Thomas More, senior F **Ashley Kirkpatrick** of Washington & Jefferson, junior G **Brittany Spencer** of Waynesburg, and junior F **Katie Hughes** of Westminster.



## PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL 2011-12 - Week 12 Conference Notes

**TOURNEY TIME!:** The 2011-12 PAC Women's Basketball Tournament gets underway Tuesday night with four first round contests ... Five-time defending PAC champion Thomas More clinched the top seed with a 68-59 home win over second-place Saint Vincent Tuesday ... If the Saints defeat Grove City Tuesday, they will host the weekend "PAC Final Four", with semifinals Friday night and finals Saturday at a time TBA at the Connor Convocation Center.

**NEWS AND NOTES:** Thomas More junior G **Allison Long** averaged 17.0 ppg, 5.0 rpg and 4.5 apg to help the 2-0 Saints clinch the top seed ... Thiel enters the tournament on a two-game win streak after senior **Ashley Davis** posted 19 points and 13 boards in a 63-59 win over rival Grove City Saturday ... Waynesburg clinched the #3 seed with a 2-0 week behind 13.0 ppg, 7.0 rpg and 4.0 apg by **Brittany Spencer** ... Senior F **Ashley Kirkpatrick** averaged a double-double (18.5 ppg, 11.5 rpg) for 1-1 W&J.

**AROUND THE LEAGUE:** Saint Vincent senior F **Brittany Sedlock** scored a career-high 26 points at Thomas More ... Senior G **Anne Wilson** averaged 13.0 ppg, 3.5 rpg and 3.0 spg for 1-1 Bethany ... Senior **Beth DeLuca** finished her career 14th on the Geneva all-time scoring list with 961 points ... **Hannah Jo Coneby** averaged 15.5 ppg and 11.0 rpg for 0-2 Grove City ... **Carly Zelenak** averaged 15.0 ppg and 8.5 rpg for 0-2 Chatham ... **Katie Hughes** averaged 11.5 ppg for 1-1 Westminster.

# PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

## Bethany Bison (15-10, 11-7 PAC)



Bethany wrapped up the #4 seed and a home game in the PAC quarterfinals by knocking off Westminster 63-56 last Wednesday ... The Bison trailed 47-43 with just under six minutes to go when **Renee Shepherd** hit a pair of treys and **Anne Wilson** and **Audra Droginske** both hit one in a 12-3 run that gave BC the lead for good ... Five players scored in double digits, led by Wilson with 16 points and six steals and **Audra Droginske** with 12 points and seven assists ... Shepherd dropped in 11 as well and **Katelynn Hackathorn** and **Kayla Taormina** chipped in 10 apiece ... The regular season closed on a down note with a big loss at Saint Vincent, despite 13 points from Shepherd and 10 from Wilson.

## Chatham Cougars (4-21, 1-17 PAC)



In the 74-56 loss to Thiel, Chatham had four players record double digits ... **Carly Zelenak** recorded her fourth double-double of the season with 12 points and 12 rebounds in addition to three steals ... Additional high scorers were **Lizz King** and **Emily Schmidt** posted 13 points each ... King also had seven rebounds ... **Marguerite Sargent** tallied 10 points and two steals ... The Cougars had the lead early in the first but couldn't hold on ... They also raised money for Play 4Kay by selling t-shirts at this game ... In the 77-60 loss to Thomas More, the Cougars had three players in double figures ... They were Zelenak with 18, Sargent with 16 and King with 14 ... Sargent also racked seven rebounds.

## Geneva Golden Tornadoes (3-22, 2-16 PAC)



Geneva's women's team ended its season with a 58-42 loss to Westminster ... The Golden Tornadoes ended the regular season with 12 straight losses and finished the year with an overall record of 3-22 and a conference mark of 2-16 ... Seniors **Beth DeLuca** and **Rachel Rouan** played their final games for Geneva this past week and were honored for their contributions on Saturday night ... DeLuca finished her career with 961 career points which is good enough for 14th on the all-time list.

## Grove City Wolverines (7-18, 6-12 PAC)



Grove City concluded the regular season last week with hard-fought setbacks against Waynesburg and Thiel ... Wednesday night against Waynesburg, **Leah Gibson** led GCC with 15 points, while **Hannah Jo Coneby** added a 12-point, 11-rebound double-double ... Grove City honored seniors **Megan Gebrosky** and **Jayne Caldwell** prior to the game ... Saturday at Thiel, Coneby recorded another double-double, posting 19 points and 11 rebounds ... Gibson (13) and Gebrosky (10) also scored in double digits ... Gebrosky also had five assists ... The Wolverines went 8-for-18 on three-point goals ... The Wolverines also had just 11 turnovers ... Grove City visits Thomas More Tuesday in the PAC tournament quarterfinals.

## Saint Vincent Bearcats (20-5, 15-3 PAC)



SVC became the first women's team in the PAC to crack the 100-point mark this season Saturday, using its two best scoring halves of the season, 53 and 50 points, to down Bethany, 103-50 at the Carey Center ... Senior G **Emily Fenton** scored a career-high 24 points to lead all scorers, while classmate F **Brittany Sedlock** added 20 points, eight rebounds, five assists and five steals ... Junior F **Devin McGrath** posted a double-double of 13 points and 11 rebounds to go along with seven steals and five assists ... Classmate **Kendra Burchfield** came off the bench to score a season-high 12 points ... Wednesday at Thomas More, Sedlock established a new career high with 26 points in SVC's 68-59 loss.

## Thiel Tomcats (8-17, 8-10 PAC)



The Tomcats closed out the regular season with two wins over Chatham and Grove City ... In the win against the Cougars, Thiel saw three players in double figures ... **Kelly Barzak** led the charge with 20 points and six rebounds ... Joining her was **Ashley Davis** with 12 points and **Kelly Muffley** chipped in 13 ... As a team, Thiel shot 46.4 percent, their second highest performance of the season ... They also forced 21 Cougar turnovers while just committing 10 of their own ... Against the Wolverines, Davis made the best of her senior day as she notched her fourth double-double of the season, with 19 points and a season-high 13 rebounds ... Barzak tied her season-high 26 points while adding seven rebounds.

## Thomas More Saints (21-4, 17-1 PAC)



Thomas More went 2-0 last week by defeating Saint Vincent and Chatham at home ... With the win over Saint Vincent, the Saints won the PAC regular season outright ... It marks the seventh straight year the Saints have won at least a share of the PAC regular season ... Two Saints averaged in double-figure scoring last week as junior G **Allison Long** averaged 17.0 points per game and sophomore G **Devin Beasley** averaged 15.5 ppg. ... Junior C **Katie Kees** led the team on the boards with 10.0 rebounds per game, while Beasley had 11 assists ... For the season, sophomore G **Katie Kitchen** leads the team in scoring (15.3 ppg), and sophomore F **Moriah Corey** leads on the boards (7.4 rpg).

## Washington & Jefferson Presidents (12-13, 7-11 PAC)



Washington & Jefferson earned a season sweep of Geneva with a 69-44 home victory on Wednesday ... Senior **Ashley Kirkpatrick** was a perfect 9-of-9 from the field and 4-of-4 from the free throw line and was the game's high-scorer with 22 points ... W&J scored 30 points off 24 Golden Tornadoes' turnovers ... The Presidents racked up 38 points in the paint, compared to just 14 for Geneva ... Freshman **Valerie Dunlap** grabbed a game-high 13 rebounds off the bench ... W&J fell to Waynesburg 59-57 to conclude the regular season ... Kirkpatrick posted her fourth double-double in the last five games with 15 points and a game-high 14 rebounds.

## Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (19-6, 14-4 PAC)



The Yellow Jackets wrapped up the 2011-12 regular season schedule by sweeping a pair of PAC games this past week ... Waynesburg went on the road to beat Grove City 65-53 and followed that with a thrilling 59-57 home victory on Senior Day over Washington & Jefferson Saturday ... With the game tied 53-53 with 1:24 left to play, the home team combined a three-pointer by senior PG **Hannah Hunter** and a few clutch free throws to seal up the victory ... Junior Gs **Jessi Drayer** and **Brittany Spencer** both averaged a team-high 13.0 points per game to power the Waynesburg offense ... Spencer posted a team-high 15 points and five rebounds at Grove City.

## Westminster Titans (9-15, 9-9 PAC)



The Lady Titans fell to Bethany by a single digit margin for the second time this season by the score of 63-56 on Wednesday ... Junior **Andi Ridge** scored 13 points and grabbed 11 rebounds, recording her fourth career double-double ... The Lady Titans rebounded from their mid-week loss by defeating rival Geneva 58-42 on Saturday ... The Titan defense was essential to the victory as they scored 27 points off of 20 Geneva turnovers ... Junior **Katie Hughes** led with a team-high 12 points while shooting 6-for-7 from the floor ... Ten other players recorded points in the contest for the Titans.
