Dickman helped

lead the top-ranked Saints to a 2-0 record last week, which clinched the Saints at least a share of their sixth straight PAC regular season title and their second undefeated regular season in four seasons. She averaged 12.0 points per game and 9.0 rebounds per game and had two blocks and two assists. She recorded her 19th career double-double in the Saints' win over No. 14 Saint Vincent as she had 12 points and 12 rebounds.

Also nominated was junior G Anne Wilson of Bethany, sophomore G/F Colleen Kiss of Chatham, senior F Christine Slater of Grove City, junior F Ashley Kirkpatrick of W&J, and sophomore G Brittany Spencer of Waynesburg, and freshman G Courtney Zitt of Westminster.

The PAC champion receives an automatic bid to next week's NCAA Division III Tournament.

NEWS AND NOTES: Grove City's Christine Slater posted 18 points and 11 rebounds in her final regular-season home game vs. Westminster ... Against Grove City, Maria Baroffio scored a team-high 17 points for Saint Vincent ... Brittany Spencer averaged a team-high 16.5 ppg and added 8.0 rpg for Waynesburg this past week ... Nicole Dickman and Katie Kitchen both averaged 12.0 ppg for Thomas More on the week ... Geneva's Christine Carugati posted a career best 25 points against Waynesburg.

Westminster's Courtney Zitt and Katie Hughes averaged 11.0 ppg on the week ... Bethany's Anne Wilson averaged 11 points and five rebounds.


Bethany Bison (13-12, 8-8 PAC)

The Bison completed the regular season with a pair of victories to clinch their third .500 season in the last 4 years ... Bethany overcame a sluggish 1st half

against Chatham to score 21 pts from the foul line after halftime and rally for a 65-59 win ... Katelynn Hackathorn scored a season-high 19 and grabbed 8 boards, while Anne Wilson was 9-for-10 from the foul line to total 11 pts ... On Saturday, Bethany closed the game with a 16-4 run to pull out a 65-58 win at W&J ... Tara Harris recorded a double-double with 16 pts and 10 rebounds, Kayla Taormina posted 12 pts, 9 rebounds and 4 assists and Wilson scored 7 of her 11 during the gameclinching run, as BC broke a 6-game losing streak to the Presidents.

the Wolverines to just 15 field goals, including seven in the second half, while forcing 25 turnovers ... Maria Baroffio scored a team-high 17 pts, while Brittany Sedlock tallied her seventh double-double of the year with 14 pts and 13 rebounds ... On Saturday, Thomas More snapped the Bearcats' eight-game winning streak, as the Saints led for the duration of the 40 minutes in the 25-pt win ... Melissa Mansur scored a season-high 14 pts, while Sedlock added 12 pts with nine boards.

Thomas More Saints (25-0, 16-0 PAC)

The Saints went 2-0 last week to clinch at least a share of their sixth straight PAC regular season title and their second undefeated regular season

in four seasons ... The Saints were the top-ranked team in both Division III national polls for the fourth straight week last week ... Four Saints averaged in double-figure scoring last week as Nicole Dickman and Katie Kitchen both averaged 12.0 pts per game, Chelsea Tolliver averaged 11.5 ppg., and Moriah Corey averaged 10.0 ppg. ... Katie Kees led the team on the boards as she averaged 11.0 rebounds per game, in blocked shots with four, while Tolliver led the team in steals with six and Allison Long led the team in assists with nine.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (17-8, 10-6 PAC)

Though it ended with a road loss, the 2010-11 regular season was one of the best in program history for Waynesburg ... The Yellow Jackets accomplished




Chatham Cougars (10-15, 5-11 PAC)

The Cougars completed regular season Presidents' Athletic Conference (PAC) play this week with two road games against Bethany and Thiel ... Although Chatham led at halftime,

Bethany out-scored the Cougars in the second half 48-41 to earn the victory 65-59 ... Senior Barb Petty and sophomore Colleen Kiss each tallied 14 pts in the loss - a season-high for Petty this year ... Against Thiel on Saturday, Chatham battled back from trailing most of the game to earn their 10th win of the season, marking the fourth season of doubledigit wins for the team - the only four in school history Kiss had a career-high 19 pts and Petty led the team in rebounds, grabbing eight in the victory.

Grove City Wolverines (13-12, 8-8 PAC)

Grove City clinched its first winning regular season in six years Saturday by topping Westminster 61-57 ... Senior Christine Slater posted 18 pts and 11 rebounds in her



Thiel Tomcats (5-20, 3-13 PAC)

The Tomcats finished the week with an 0-2 record to finish the season in eighth place (5-20; 3-13 PAC) ... In the first game of the week the Tomcats traveled to

#1 Thomas More where they fell to the top ranked team in the country 74-49 ... Kelly Barzak led the team with 14 pts and eight rebounds ... She also recorded five blocks, which moved her into first place all-time in Tomcat history in blocked shots ... In the second game of the week Thiel once again fell, this time to Chatham University 63-59 ... Kelly Muffley led the way with 20 pts and Ashley Davis added 15...Barzak posted her fifth double double of the season as she posted 10 pts and 10 rebounds.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (9-16, 6-10 PAC)

W&J fell to the No. 6 seed after dropping games to Waynesburg and Bethany ... W&J trailed Waynesburg by only eight midway through the second half, but a 14-4 WU run put the game away ... Ashley Kirkpatrick bucketed 16 pts and posted six rebounds to lead W&J, while

Kara Seamon added 10 pts ... W&J fought back from a hole against Bethany Saturday and eventually grabbed a 57-52 lead, but the Bison answered with another rally and sealed its first win at W&J in eight tries ... Kirkpatrick pumped in 18 pts to score in double figures ... Vanessa Rivera had 10 pts and nine assists ... She has 130 assists this season which marks the second-highest, single-season total in school history.

Westminster Titans (7-18, 2-14 PAC)

Westminster's season came to an end Saturday at Grove City as the Wolverines snapped the Titans' season-long, three-game win streak by

defeating Westminster 61-57 ... The Titans extended their win streak to three games by defeating Geneva, 61-47, at home Wednesday ... Courtney Zitt and Katie Hughes led the Titans by averaging 11.0 pts per game, while Zitt was one of three Titans to average 8.0 rebounds per game ... Gabby Holko led the Titans with 13 pts vs. Geneva, while Danielle Gilmore tied a career high with 11 and Zitt and Hughes each scored 10 ... Zitt and Hughes each scored 12 in the loss to Grove City.












Thiel Tomcats at Thomas More* (2/22)
