Dickman helped lead the top-ranked Saints to a 2-0 record last week, which clinched the Saints at least a share of their sixth straight PAC regular season title and their second undefeated regular season in four seasons. She averaged 12.0 points per game and 9.0 rebounds per game and had two blocks and two assists. She recorded her 19<sup>th</sup> career double-double in the Saints' win over No. 14 Saint Vincent as she had 12 points and 12 rebounds.

Also nominated was junior G **Anne Wilson** of Bethany, sophomore G/F **Colleen Kiss** of Chatham, senior F **Christine Slater** of Grove City, junior F **Ashley Kirkpatrick** of W&J, and sophomore G **Brittany Spencer** of Waynesburg, and freshman G **Courtney Zitt** of Westminster.



## PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL 2010-11 - Week 13 Conference Notes

**TOURNAMENT TIME:** The 2011 PAC Women's Basketball Championship Tournament gets underway on Tuesday with four first round contests: #7 Chatham at #2 Saint Vincent, #5 Grove City at #4 Bethany, #8 Thiel at #1 Thomas More, #6 W&J at #3 Waynesburg ... The semifinals (Friday) and finals (Saturday) will both be held at the highest remaining seed after the first round ... The PAC champion receives an automatic bid to next week's NCAA Division III Tournament.

**NEWS AND NOTES:** Grove City's **Christine Slater** posted 18 points and 11 rebounds in her final regular-season home game vs. Westminster ... Against Grove City, **Maria Baroffio** scored a team-high 17 points for Saint Vincent ... **Brittany Spencer** averaged a team-high 16.5 ppg and added 8.0 rpg for Waynesburg this past week ... **Nicole Dickman** and **Katie Kitchen** both averaged 12.0 ppg for Thomas More on the week ... Geneva's **Christine Carugati** posted a career best 25 points against Waynesburg.

**AROUND THE LEAGUE:** Waynesburg's **Katelynn Hackathorn** had 19 points and grabbed eight boards vs. Chatham ... Against Waynesburg **Ashley Kirkpatrick** posted 16 points and six rebounds for W&J ... **Barb Petty** and **Colleen Kiss** each tallied 14 points in Chatham's loss to Bethany ... Thiel's **Kelly Barzak** had 14 points and eight boards in the loss to Thomas More ... Westminster's **Courtney Zitt** and **Katie Hughes** averaged 11.0 ppg on the week ... Bethany's **Anne Wilson** averaged 11 points and five rebounds.

# PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

## Bethany Bison (13-12, 8-8 PAC)



The Bison completed the regular season with a pair of victories to clinch their third .500 season in the last 4 years ... Bethany overcame a sluggish 1<sup>st</sup> half against Chatham to score 21 pts from the foul line after halftime and rally for a 65-59 win ... **Katelynn Hackathorn** scored a season-high 19 and grabbed 8 boards, while **Anne Wilson** was 9-for-10 from the foul line to total 11 pts ... On Saturday, Bethany closed the game with a 16-4 run to pull out a 65-58 win at W&J ... **Tara Harris** recorded a double-double with 16 pts and 10 rebounds, **Kayla Taormina** posted 12 pts, 9 rebounds and 4 assists and Wilson scored 7 of her 11 during the game-clinching run, as BC broke a 6-game losing streak to the Presidents.

## Chatham Cougars (10-15, 5-11 PAC)



The Cougars completed regular season Presidents' Athletic Conference (PAC) play this week with two road games against Bethany and Thiel ... Although Chatham led at halftime, Bethany out-scored the Cougars in the second half 48-41 to earn the victory 65-59 ... Senior **Barb Petty** and sophomore **Colleen Kiss** each tallied 14 pts in the loss – a season-high for Petty this year ... Against Thiel on Saturday, Chatham battled back from trailing most of the game to earn their 10<sup>th</sup> win of the season, marking the fourth season of double-digit wins for the team – the only four in school history .... Kiss had a career-high 19 pts and Petty led the team in rebounds, grabbing eight in the victory.

## Geneva Golden Tornadoes (9-16)



It has been anything but a smooth ride for the Geneva in the second half of the season ... Despite dropping ten of their last 11 games, the Golden Tornadoes came into Saturday's finale against 17-7 Waynesburg with enthusiasm and desire ... That enthusiasm paid off with a 60-58 victory over the Yellow jackets ... The evening started with seniors **Valerie Hamilton** and **Christine Carugati** being honored for senior night ... Both used that emotion to help Geneva get past Waynesburg ... Hamilton connected on a key free throw in the final moments while Carugati posted a career best 25 pts to lead all scorers ... Geneva finished the season with a 9-16 overall record, which was one victory better than a year ago.

## Grove City Wolverines (13-12, 8-8 PAC)



Grove City clinched its first winning regular season in six years Saturday by topping Westminster 61-57 ... Senior **Christine Slater** posted 18 pts and 11 rebounds in her final regular-season home game ... She now has 1,600 career pts, eighth-most in conference history ... Senior **Alison Wells** added a dozen pts ... Grove City completed a season sweep of Westminster with the win ... Wednesday, Grove City dropped a 58-46 decision to Saint Vincent ... Slater posted a 17-pt, 11-rebound double-double while Wells recorded 11 pts and nine boards ... **Leah Gibson** added 10 pts ... Slater's 473 pts this year are the fifth-most in program history ... **Megan Gebrosky** is tied for fourth all-time at the College with 86 three-point goals.

## Saint Vincent Bearcats (22-3, 14-2 PAC)



The 14/15<sup>th</sup>-ranked Bearcats went 1-1 on the final week of the regular season, defeating Grove City 58-46 before falling 73-48 in the season-finale at number-one Thomas More ... In the Grove City contest, the SVC defense limited the Wolverines to just 15 field goals, including seven in the second half, while forcing 25 turnovers ... **Maria Baroffio** scored a team-high 17 pts, while **Brittany Sedlock** tallied her seventh double-double of the year with 14 pts and 13 rebounds ... On Saturday, Thomas More snapped the Bearcats' eight-game winning streak, as the Saints led for the duration of the 40 minutes in the 25-pt win ... **Melissa Mansur** scored a season-high 14 pts, while Sedlock added 12 pts with nine boards.

## Thiel Tomcats (5-20, 3-13 PAC)



The Tomcats finished the week with an 0-2 record to finish the season in eighth place (5-20; 3-13 PAC) ... In the first game of the week the Tomcats traveled to #1 Thomas More where they fell to the top ranked team in the country 74-49 ... **Kelly Barzak** led the team with 14 pts and eight rebounds ... She also recorded five blocks, which moved her into first place all-time in Tomcat history in blocked shots ... In the second game of the week Thiel once again fell, this time to Chatham University 63-59 ... **Kelly Muffley** led the way with 20 pts and **Ashley Davis** added 15...Barzak posted her fifth double double of the season as she posted 10 pts and 10 rebounds.

## Thomas More Saints (25-0, 16-0 PAC)



The Saints went 2-0 last week to clinch at least a share of their sixth straight PAC regular season title and their second undefeated regular season in four seasons ... The Saints were the top-ranked team in both Division III national polls for the fourth straight week last week ... Four Saints averaged in double-figure scoring last week as **Nicole Dickman** and **Katie Kitchen** both averaged 12.0 pts per game, **Chelsea Tolliver** averaged 11.5 ppg., and **Moriah Corey** averaged 10.0 ppg. ... **Katie Kees** led the team on the boards as she averaged 11.0 rebounds per game, in blocked shots with four, while Tolliver led the team in steals with six and **Allison Long** led the team in assists with nine.

## Washington & Jefferson Presidents (9-16, 6-10 PAC)



W&J fell to the No. 6 seed after dropping games to Waynesburg and Bethany ... W&J trailed Waynesburg by only eight midway through the second half, but a 14-4 WU run put the game away ... **Ashley Kirkpatrick** bucketed 16 pts and posted six rebounds to lead W&J, while **Kara Seamon** added 10 pts ... W&J fought back from a hole against Bethany Saturday and eventually grabbed a 57-52 lead, but the Bison answered with another rally and sealed its first win at W&J in eight tries ... Kirkpatrick pumped in 18 pts to score in double figures ... **Vanessa Rivera** had 10 pts and nine assists ... She has 130 assists this season which marks the second-highest, single-season total in school history.

## Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (17-8, 10-6 PAC)



Though it ended with a road loss, the 2010-11 regular season was one of the best in program history for Waynesburg ... The Yellow Jackets accomplished another in a long list of milestones earlier this week with their 77-56 win over Wash. & Jeff. ... The victory completed the team's first regular season sweep of the Presidents in 18 years ... **Brittany Spencer** went off for a game-high 21 pts in the win ... **Hannah Hunter** had a solid all-around night with 12 pts, eight rebounds and five assists ... Spencer averaged a team-high 16.5 pts per game over a pair of contests this week and also averaged 8.0 rebounds per game ... **Elisha Jones** chipped in 15.5 pts per game and yanked down 6.5 boards per contest.

## Westminster Titans (7-18, 2-14 PAC)



Westminster's season came to an end Saturday at Grove City as the Wolverines snapped the Titans' season-long, three-game win streak by defeating Westminster 61-57 ... The Titans extended their win streak to three games by defeating Geneva, 61-47, at home Wednesday ... **Courtney Zitt** and **Katie Hughes** led the Titans by averaging 11.0 pts per game, while Zitt was one of three Titans to average 8.0 rebounds per game ... **Gabby Holko** led the Titans with 13 pts vs. Geneva, while **Danielle Gilmore** tied a career high with 11 and Zitt and Hughes each scored 10 ... Zitt and Hughes each scored 12 in the loss to Grove City.

## Bethany Bison

With wins in 6 of their last 9, fourth-seeded Bethany opens the PAC Tournament Tuesday by hosting #5 Grove City ... This is the 6<sup>th</sup> time in the last 7 years the Bison have earned a home game in the league quarterfinals ... Bethany and Grove City split their regular season meetings, with each team winning on the road ... **Renee Shepherd** had 10 pts and 11 boards, but GCC scored the final 7 pts in a 66-59 win at BC Jan. 6 ... **Kayla Taormina** dropped in 20 and **Tara Harris** amassed 19 pts and 11 rebounds in the Bison's 69-65 win at Grove City Feb. 5 ... This is just the second time since 2004 the teams have met in the PAC Tournament, with Grove City winning the other match-up 71-68.

## Chatham Cougars

Grove City scored the final nine pts of that game ... **Christine Slater** led Grove City with 24 pts on 10-of-12 shooting ... All-time, the Wolverines are 1-4 at Bethany in the conference tournament ... The Wolverines have won three of their last four games at Bethany overall, including a 66-59 win January 6 ... Slater tied a career high with 28 pts in that win and **Alison Wells** had a career-high 18 pts ... Grove City is in pursuit of its first conference title since 1987.

## Saint Vincent Bearcats

In the two wins this season, **Brittany Sedlock** averaged 19.5 pts and 9.0 rebounds ... SVC's last trip into the postseason was a successful one, as the Bearcats captured last season's ECAC Division-III South championship ... In all, this marks the Bearcats 23<sup>rd</sup> playoff appearance in 27 seasons.

Thomas More comes into the game against Thiel undefeated and ranked #1 in the country ... **Kelly Barzak** (11.8) and **Kelly Muffley** (11.5) rank ninth and 10<sup>th</sup> in the PAC in points per game... Barzak also ranks fourth in the conference in rebounds (7.6) and field goal percentage (.485).

## Thomas More Saints
