TOURNEY TIME: Thomas More College will look to capture its third consecutive PAC title this week, as the Saints are the top seed and have home court advantage throughout the 2009 PAC Championship Tournament ... TMC will open defense of its title Tuesday against eight-seeded Chatham, and will host the weekend "Final Four" in Crestview Hills, Ky., with a win over the Cougars ... #2 W&J, #3 Bethany and #4 Grove City all host first round games on Tuesday as well.

WHO'S HOT: Thomas More is ranked 10th in the nation in both D-III Top 25 polls, while W&J is 21st in <u>D3Hoops.com</u> and 23rd nationally by the WBCA/USA Today poll ... Christine Slater of Grove City averaged 20.5 points and 13.0 rebounds in a 1-1 week ... Michawn Rich of Geneva posted 19 points and 17 boards in a 70-46 win over Thiel ... Renee Brandenburg averaged 17.0 ppg for 1-1 Bethany ... Chatham topped Waynesburg 71-42 for its school-record 11th victory of the season.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Thomas More leads NCAA Division III in team field goal percentage (48.8%) ... Veronica Kust of W&J scored a career-high 17 points in a 93-77 win over Bethany ... Senior G Gina Brunetti of Westminster scored a season-high 22 points in a 64-56 win over Geneva ... Brittany Sedlock of Saint Vincent grabbed a career-high 15 rebounds in a 60-48 win at Grove City ... Sophomore F Elisha Jones averaged 11.5 ppg and 5.0 rpg for 0-2 Waynesburg.

PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison (14-11, 8-6 PAC)

After running their win streak to seven with an 82-74 victory over Westminster, the Bison dropped a 93-77 decision at W&J Saturday in the regular season

finale ... Bethany trailed Westminster by four at halftime, but Tara Harris scored 14 in the 2nd half and Renee Brandenburg tallied 12 to pace the BC comeback ... Brandenburg finished with a game-high 20 and Harris totaled 18 points and eight rebounds ... The Bison were without three regulars because of injury at W&J, but still fought hard before succumbing to the 21st-ranked Presidents ... Kaitlyn McCormick scored a career-high 23 points and added 9 rebounds, while Kelly Goode (15), Brandenburg (14) and Anne Wilson (13) all reached double figures.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (9-15)

Geneva put an end to its seven-game win streak with a 70-46 victory over Thiel Wednesday ... Michawn Rich celebrated Senior Night and her GOLDEN TORNADOES final home game with 19 points and 17 rebounds in

leading Geneva to its ninth victory of the season ... It was Rich's 10th double-double of the season ... The Golden Tornadoes ended their season Saturday with a 64-56 loss to Westminster ... Val Hamilton scored a season-best 16 points and pulled down a team-high seven rebounds, but it wasn't enough to overcome a 51% shooting afternoon for the Titans ... The Golden Tornadoes ended their campaign with a mark of 9-15, including eight losses in their final nine games.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (16-8)

The Bearcats wrapped up the regular season with a 1-1 week, defeating Grove City Wednesday before dropping the finale with Thomas More Saturday ... In SVC's 60-48 win over the Wolverines, Maria Baroffio led both

sides with 21 points, while Brittany Sedlock grabbed a career-high 15 rebounds ... Emily Fenton scored 12 points, all in the second half, and Ashley Campbell tallied seven assists, six steals, and six rebounds ... On Saturday, SVC was unable to knock off PAC leader Thomas More ... Campbell led the Bearcats with 14 points to go with six helpers, while Fenton came off the bench to score 12 ... The Bearcats picked up 14 steals and forced 22 turnovers, but were out-rebounded 49-21.

Thomas More Saints (23-2, 13-1 PAC)

Thomas More, ranked No. 10 last week in both the D3hoops.com Top-25 and the WBCA Top-25 and No. 2 in the NCAA Division III Great Lakes

Regional Poll, swept its two games last week as it defeated Chatham, 77-45, Wednesday and Saint Vincent, 75-59, Saturday to extend its win streak to a season-high 12 games ... Against Chatham, sophomore C Nicole Dickman scored a game-high 20 points and senior G Alex Gee added 12 ... Dickman also pulled down a game-high six rebounds ... In the win over Saint Vincent, senior G Jayme Thiem led three Saints in double-figures with a game-high 20 points ... Dickman added 14 markers and junior G Sarah Yeiser posted 11.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (8-17, 4-10 PAC)

Waynesburg's regular season ended with a pair of losses to PAC opponents this week ... Wednesday, the Yellow Jackets couldn't find their shooting stroke

as they dropped a 51-37 decision to nationally-ranked W&J ... Freshman F Callie White led the visitors with eight points and six rebounds ... Things didn't go any better on Saturday when they concluded the regular season portion of their year with a 71-42 defeat at the hands of Chatham ... Though it came in a loss, sophomore F Elisha Jones had a solid night, going for a game-high 18 points.

Chatham Cougars (11-14, 3-11 PAC)

Chatham won its regular season finale at Waynesburg by a 71-42 score ... The Cougars connected on a sea-

son-high 10 three-point field goal attempts in the win ... Sophomores Barb Petty, Kayla Hilko and Courtney Smith all reached double figures with 16, 15 and 12 points, respectively ... The team's 11th win sets a new Chatham record for the most wins in a season ... Earlier in the week Chatham lost at home to Thomas More by a 77-45 score ... Chatham will face Thomas More again when they travel for the firstround contest in the PAC playoffs on Tuesday night.

Grove City Wolverines (11-14, 7-7 PAC)

Grove City clinched the No. 4 seed in this week's PAC Championship Tournament after earning a 75-64 win at Thiel Saturday ... The 75 points match a season high for

the Wolverines ... Christine Slater matched a career-high with 25 points ... She also scored 25 against Thiel January 21 ... Megan Gebrosky (14), Raeann Szelong (13) and Laura Miller (11) also scored in double figures ... Slater also had 11 rebounds, giving her 10 double-doubles for the season ... Wednesday, the Wolverines fell to Saint Vincent 60-48 ... Slater posted 16 points and 15 rebounds while Gebrosky added 11 points ... Grove City's 7-7 league record is the program's best since 2004-05.

Thiel Tomcats (10-14, 5-9 PAC)

The Thiel College women's basketball team continued their struggles against opponents they beat earlier in the season on Wednesday with a 70-46 loss to

the Geneva College Golden Tornadoes ... This marks the third time the Tomcats have lost to an opponent that they had previously defeated ... Thiel suffered its ninth conference loss of the season Saturday, 75-64, to the visiting Grove City Wolverines.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (22-3, 12-2 PAC)

The 21st-ranked Washington & Jefferson women's basketball team concluded its regular-season schedule with back-to-back PAC-rivalry wins, defeating Waynesburg (51-37) and Bethany (93-77) ... Senior Gs Lindsey Hyre and Veronica Kust both posted career-high scor-

ing performances in the 16-point victory against Bethany ... Hyre scored 13 points, shooting 5-of-7 from the field and 3-of-4 from beyond the arc, while Kust added 17 point on a 6-of-7 shooting effort from the field and 4of-5 showing from three-point range ... The Presidents will be the No. 2 seed in the upcoming PAC Tournament and will host seventh seeded Westminster in the Henry Memorial Center Tuesday at 6 p.m.

Bethany brings a ton of momentum into the PAC Tournament, having won 10 of their last 12 ... The

Bison have earned a quarterfinal home game for the sixth consecutive season, but have lost three of their last four, including a 71-68 setback to Grove City last year ... BC's last conference tournament win was a 65-61 triumph over Waynesburg in the '06 quarterfinals ... Bethany split the season series with Waynesburg, falling 57-52 at home but scoring a 69-56 triumph on the road ... Caelyn DiSanti and Stacy Goode each tallied 13 and Kaitlyn McCormick chipped in 12 in the win ... A Bison win sends them into the semifinals.

Chatham Cougars PAC Tournament 1st Round at Thomas More (2/24)

Chatham will look for its first victory over Thomas More when they travel for the opening game in the PAC playoffs ... Chatham dropped two contests earlier this season by scores of 75-27 and 77-45.

Grove City Wolverines PAC Tournament 1st Round vs. Thiel (2/24)

Tuesday, Grove City will host a PAC Tournament game for the first time since February 24, 2004 ... The Wolverines are 2-0 at home in the PAC Tournament since 2000 ... Both of those wins came over Waynesburg ... This year, Grove City and Thiel split the regular season series with the road team winning each game ... Grove City and Thiel have never met in the postseason ... Saturday, the Wolverines pulled out a 75-64 win at Thiel ... This is the first time that Grove City has played the same team in consecutive games since Jan. 30-Feb. 2, 1999, when the Wolverines played W&J in back-to-back games ... Grove City is 5-9 in the PAC Tournament since 2000.

Saint Vincent Bearcats TBA - awaiting possible bid to ECAC Playoffs (www.redzonemedia.com)

The Bearcats finished the regular season with a 16-8 record, a seven-game turnaround from last season and the team's best mark since the 2002-03 squad finished

21-12 ... Ineligible for PAC postseason play due to their provisional NCAA status, SVC will now await word on possibly receiving a bid to the ECAC playoffs, which would be the first in school history.

Thiel Tomcats PAC Tournament 1st Round at Grove City* (2/24)

Thiel opens the PAC Tournament at Grove City, in a rematch of Saturday's regular season finale won by the Wolverines 75-64 in Greenville.



Thomas More Saints PAC Tournament 1st Round vs. Chatham (2/24) (Insight Cable TV - Channel 16)

Thomas More is riding a 12-game winning streak into the PAC Tournament, where it is the No. 1 seed and have home court advantage throughout the tournament ... The Saints host No. 8 seed Chatham University on Tuesday at 6 p.m. in a PAC Tournament quarterfinal game ... The Saints are 4-0 all-time against Chatham, include a 77-45 win just last week in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania ... Thomas More enters the week ranked No. 10 nationally by the internet Web site, d3hoops.com and by the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) and No. 2 in the NCAA Division III Great Lakes Regional Poll.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents PAC Tournament 1st Round vs. Westminster (2/24)

The Presidents swept the regular-season series with Westminster, claiming a 79-49 victory at home and a 60-41 road victory ... The schools have developed quite a rivalry in PAC Tournament play as they have met in all

six PAC tournaments since Westminster joined the league in 2002-03. Both schools have defeated each other three times in PAC Tournament play, but the Lady Titans have claimed three of the last four, including two straight ... The margin of victory in the six previous tournament contests has not been more than six ... Last season, WC upended the Presidents in overtime, 82-77, in the semifinals at Thomas More.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets PAC Tournament 1st Round at Bethany (2/24)

The Waynesburg women will try to put a threegame, season-ending losing streak behind them as they head to the state of West Virginia to begin their run at a PAC title ... Waynesburg and Bethany split their two regular season meetings this year, with the Jackets winning at Bethany by the final of 57-52, and the Bison taking a 69-56 game at the Rudy Marisa Fieldhouse ... The last time these two teams met in the playoffs, Bethany edged Waynesburg 65-61 in the first round of the 2006-07 postseason ... The Jackets also own a postseason victory over the Bison, which came in the 2005-06 playoffs ... Waynesburg won that showdown 89-83.

Westminster Titans PAC Tournament 1st Round at Washington & Jefferson (2/24)

The Titans take the road in the PAC tournament at W&J ... The Titans upset W&J in last year's

PAC semifinal game, 82-77 in overtime, after the Titans beat Chatham, 61-41, at home in the first round ... Westminster lost at W&J, 79-49, on Jan. 3 and 60-41 at home on Feb. 4 ... Gina Brunetti led the Titans in each of those games with 11 and eight points, respectively ... Brunetti is coming off a season-high 22 points vs. Geneva.
