5-8 sophomore guard/forward Greensburg, Pa. Hempfield H.S.

Ackerman averaged 18.5 points and 9.5 rebounds per game last weekend while leading Westminster to season-opening



wins against Penn State-Altoona (81-64) and Alfred (66-60) at the W&J Holiday Inn Classic. She had a career-high 27 points along with 12 rebounds in the Alfred win. For the weekend, she shot 14-of-26 (.538) from the floor and a perfect 9-of-9 from the free throw line.

Sophomore **Kortni Collins** ripped down 14 boards for the Bison.




# Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Tomcats are 9-5 all-time against La Roche and have won four straight games in the series ... They are 1-2 all-time against Marietta, including a 77-70 home victory last season.

Thomas More will host the Julie Costello Memorial Classic presented by Barleycorn's with home games with Centre and the defending NCAA Div. III National Champion DePauw ... The Saints own a 15-6 lead over Centre, including the last 11 ... DePauw leads the all-time series, 10-3, including the last eight in the regular season ... The Saints only win in the last nine match-ups came in the 2004 NCAA Tournament.

Greensburg ... The Yellow Jackets has won the last two meetings against the last two meetings against the Bobcats, including a 54-49 contest last season in Greensburg ... Waynesburg used a balanced scoring effort in the win with seven players scoring five-plus points and held a 45-40 advantage in rebounds with 14 offensive rebounds.



# Westminster Titans

vs. Pitt-Bradford (11/20)

Westminster is off to a 2-0 start after going 0-2 to start the season last year when it won a team-record 22 games ... The Titans' first win last season was at Pitt-Bradford, 53-35, a team it welcomes for its first home game this season on Tuesday ... Pitt-Bradford is 1-1 after losing at Lycoming (76-54) and defeating York

(80-63) over the weekend ... The Panthers' leading scorer is **Katie Moore** (14.0 ppg) ... **Terese Marszalek** led the Titans with 15 points and nine rebounds vs. Pitt-Bradford last year.
