KELLEY RICHARDSON Bethany College 6-0 Sophomore Center

Follansbee, W.Va./Brooke H.S.

Richardson averaged 22.5 points and 11.5 rebounds in two Bethany wins as the Bison captured the Allegheny Tip-Off Tournament in Meadville. She shot 53 percent (18-of-34) from the field in the two games. Richardson totaled 24 points and 17 rebounds, both career highs, in the title game win over Adrian.

Also nominated was freshman guard **Abby Moose** of Grove City, sophomore guard **Amanda Swanson** of Thiel, junior forward **Lauren Hull** of Washington & Jefferson, and junior forward **Kyana Bradley** of Waynesburg.

PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison

For the second time in three seasons, Bethany opened the year by winning the Allegheny Tip-Off Tournament ... In the Mount Union victory, center Kelley Richardson scored 21 points, while forward Katie Hardie added 15 and guard Kiki Cohen chipped in with 14 ... It was the second consecutive victory for the Bison over Mount Union, who had captured the first 10 meetings between the teams ... In the championship game, Richardson posted career-highs with 24 points and 17 boards to earn Tournament MVP honors ... Freshman guard Nikki Babik tallied 16 and Hardie played her way onto the All-Tournament team with 10 points and six rebounds.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J completed a 1-1 week at the Blue Jay Invitational this past weekend held at Johns Hopkins ... JHU defeated the Presidents, 85-58, on Saturday ... W&J was led by sophomore guard Shawndra McDonald, who netted a team-high 14 points ... Junior forward Lauren Hull was the only other President in double figures with 10 points and eight boards ... W&J jumped out to an 18-1 lead on St. Mary's (Md.) on Sunday and never looked back in cruising to the 22-point victory ... Sophomore guard Rachel Armitage led the way with 17 markers and five rebounds ... Sophomore quard Stephanie Ceraso (14 points), junior forward Amy Strosnider (10) and Hull (10) also scored in double figures for W&J.

Grove City Lady Wolverines

Freshman G **Abby Moose** and senior F **Erica Youngman** were named to the All-Tournament Team at Susquehanna, as Grove City went 1-1 with a first round win over Richard Stockton (74-43) before falling to the host school (54-48) in the title game ... Moose averaged 14.5 points in the two games with three threepointers, while Youngman hit four threes and averaged 9.0 points per game ... Senior G **Stephanie Murphy** also hit four threes at the tournament.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg split a pair of games last week, falling to Franklin and Marshall 50-63 before defeating Rosemont 78-42 ... The team looks to improve upon its 4-20 record last year with three returning starters and several freshman who should contribute ... Junior forward **Kyana Bradley** posted 25 points, 15 rebounds and 11 steals while shooting 60 percent from the field (12-of-20) in the two games last week.

Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats dropped contests to 13thranked Capital (80-50) and host Texas Lutheran (58-47) at the Lutheran Brotherhood Capital Classic last week ... Sophomore guard **Amanda Swanson** led the Lady Cats in scoring during both losses at Classic ...
