AMBER BODRICK **Thiel College**

5-8 sophomore forward Boardman, Ohio/Cardinal Mooney H.S.

Bodrick averaged 31.0 points and 9.5 rebounds per game for the Tomcats, who went 1-1 at the Nan Nichols Classic by posting a 69-65 win over Olivet before fall-



ing to host Wooster 65-58. She totaled 27 points and eight boards in the Olivet win, followed by a 35-point, 11-rebound double-double in the loss to the host Scots.

Also nominated was freshman G Jen Scarborough of Bethany, junior F Rachel McCoy of Grove City, senior F Megan Wood of Thomas More, junior F Maria Hillenbrand of Washington & Jefferson, sophomore F Michaelene Jones of Waynesburg, and junior F Terese Marszalek of Westminster.

Bethany Bison

After falling the opening round of the Allegheny Tip-Off Tournament, the Bison responded with an 82-65 victory over La Roche ... BC shot just 33 percent and committed 25 turnovers in an 82-48 setback to Ohio Northern in the opener

Friday ... A pair of freshmen led Bethany's efforts, as **Nicole Thompson** had 10 points and six assists, while **Jen Scarborough** notched nine points ... In the consolation, a 16-1 run in the second half broke a 36-36 tie ... Four Bison hit for double digits, led by junior **Lisa Mitchell**'s 14 ... Sophomore **Renee Brandenburg** totaled 12 and Scarborough recorded 10 ... Sophomore **Mandi Swiger** registered her second career double-double with 11 points and 10 boards, while sophomore **Caelyn DiSanti** totaled nine points, 13 rebounds, three assists, three blocks and three steals.



Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats opened their season 1-1 at the Nan Nichols Tournament, hosted by the College of Wooster ... Thiel posted a 69-65 opening-round win over Olivet before falling to host Wooster in the championship 65-58 ... Sophomore F Amber Bodrick and senior G Nicole

Valentino were both named to the all-tournament team ... The Tomcats finished with four players in double figures in the Olivet win, led by Bodrick's 27-point, 8-rebound effort ... Against Wooster Bodrick recorded a game-high 35 points and 11 rebounds while Valentino posted 17 points, six rebounds and four assists.



Grove City Wolverines

Sarah Harris' career as Grove City coach began with a pair of tough losses at Frostburg State over the weekend ... Friday, Goucher pulled out a 55-53 semifinal win over Grove City ... **Rachel McCoy** paced GCC with a 14-

point, 13-rebound double-double while **Brittany Anderson** added 12 points and seven rebounds ... **Elyse Bogusz** also fired in 12 points ... Grove City owned a 43-33 edge on the glass but turned the ball over 36 times ... Four players scored in double figures against Immaculata Saturday ... McCoy led with 14 points while Anderson added 13 ... Freshman **Krista Beechy** and sophomore **Jen Wiley** both contributed 10 points ... Beechy started both games at Frostburg ... McCoy earned All-Tournament team honors.

Lee Famous Recipe Classic All-Tournament team ... Wood averaged 15 points and 6.5 rebounds, while Warner averaged 9.5 points, 8.5 rebounds and 4.5 assist ... Sophomore **Alex Gee** connected on back-to-back three-pointers to spark a 13-2 run that sprung the Saints to the win over Centre ... Junior **Kristen Humphrey** scored 15 points and seven boards in the Centre win



Washington & Jefferson Presidents

The Presidents opened the season by hosting the Holiday Inn MeadowLands Classic ... W&J advanced to the title game after defeating OWU Friday ... Freshman PG **Kennan Killeen** scored 15 points and freshman F **Maggie Gibson** ripped down 16 rebounds to lead the Presidents ...

W&J's defense took over in the second half as the Presidents did not allow a point in the final 7:58 ... Mount Union rallied from a five-point deficit with under 10 minutes left to defeat W&J ... The Purple Raiders (2-0) held the Presidents (1-1) to 29 percent shooting (16-of-55), including only 2-of-20 accuracy from three-point range ... W&J was led by junior F **Maria Hillenbrand**, who was named to the All-Tournament Team after scoring 13 points and grabbing seven rebounds ... Gibson added six points and nine boards.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Waynesburg College women's basketball came away with a split in its seasonopening tournament at Penn State-Behrend ... The Yellow Jackets lost to the host Behrend on Saturday, 67-55, before bounc-

ing back with a 67-43 win over Marietta ... Against the Lions, F **Denise Kennedy** led Waynesburg with 10 points, while sophomore F **Michaelene Jones** collected a career-high 13 rebounds (seven offensive) ... In the win over the Pioneers, G **Johnna Deco** and G **Katie Lewandowski** scored 14 and 13 points, respectively ... Kennedy grabbed 13 rebounds and Jones added nine boards, as the Yellow Jackets collected 51 rebounds (15 offensive).



Westminster Titans

Westminster opened the season with a pair of losses at the Manchester Tip-Off Classic ... The Titans lost to the host Spartans, 49-45, in overtime Friday, before suffering a 60-48 loss to Defiance Saturday ... In the OT loss to Manchester, the Titans took their first lead of the game with just under 10 minutes remaining on the second of three consecutive lay-ups by junior F **Terese Marszalek** ... Manchester sent the game to overtime with a three-pointer with 30 seconds left and jumped to a seven-point lead in OT that WC failed to overcome

... Senior G **Desiree Sterling** led the Titans with 12 points, followed by sophomore G **Gina Brunetti** with 11 and Marszalek with eight to go with seven rebounds ... Marszalek was named to the all-tournament team after scoring 21 points in the loss to Defiance.

SVC lost to perennial NAIA powerhouse Warner Southern on a buzzer-beater ... After a charging call on SVC, Warner Southern drove the length of the court and scored with 0.5 seconds remaining ... Laura Klimchock scored 22 against Macomb, then followed with 12 against

Warner Southern ... Lauren Reilly grabbed 17 rebounds in two games in the tournament ... Freshman Ashley Benzio made her collegiate debut off the bench against Macomb, pulling down six rebounds ... The next night, she scored nine points against WSC in 17 minutes.

The Bison have a trio of contests this week, all on the road ... First up is a tilt at Denison Tues-

day against the defending NCAC Tournament champions ... Bethany leads the all-time series with the Big Red 6-1, including a 74-59 victory in the teams' last meeting in 2002 ... BC then heads to the Wilmington Tournament after the Thanksgiving holiday ... In Saturday's game, Bethany will take on Albion in just the third-ever meeting between the schools ... The Bison squared the series at 1-1 with a 74-57 win over the Britons in 1999 ... BC will face Olivet on Sunday ... It will be the first time the Bison and Comets have ever played each other in women's basketball.
