PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

LEIGH SULKOWSKI Washington & Jefferson College 6-0 Senior Guard Upper St. Clair, Pa./Upper St. Clair H.S.

Sulkowski was named the MVP of the Holiday Inn Meadow Lands Classic after averaged 27.5 points, 7.0 rebounds and 6.5 steals per game as W&J went 1-1 with a win over Penn State-Altoona (77-48) and an overtime loss to Otterbein (87-80). She shot 44 percent (15-of-34) from the field in the two games, including 50 percent (5-of-10) from three-point range.

Also nominated was senior F Jenny Place of Bethany, sophomore F/C Rachel McCoy of Grove City, freshman F Amber Bodrick of Thiel, junior G Christian Stefanopoulos of Thomas More, senior G Candice Eyerman of Waynesburg, and sophomore F Terese Marszalek of Westminster.

Bethany Bison

Bethany's season got off to a rocky start Friday, as #17 B-W used a huge run late in the first half to erase a six-point BC lead and go on to a 90-38 victory ... PG **Renee Shehady** led the way with nine points and five assists ... The Bison

rebounded the next day in the consolation game, as a basket by sophomore **Lisa Mitchell** as time expired gave the Green and White a 72-71 OT win over St. Lawrence ...St. Lawrence sent the game to OT on a basket with a second left in regulation ...That set the stage for Mitchell 's game-winning score, which capped off a 16-point night for the Bison guard ... Senior **Jenny Place** tallied 22 in the win to earn All-Tournament team honors, while **Renee Brandenburg** had 13 points and 10 rebounds and Shehady gave out 10 assists.



Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats opened their 2005-06 season Friday at the National City Tip-Off Tournament, hosted by Allegheny in Meadville ... The Tomcats fell to John Carroll 82-77 in overtime in the first round ... Senior G **Heather Abate** finished with 19 points, six rebounds and five assists ...

Freshman F Amber Bodrick posted a double-double in her first collegiate contest with 18 points and a team-high 14 rebounds ... Sophomore G Ariel Venesky added 14 points ... Allegheny's Valery Medwid hit a three-pointer with 3.9 seconds left, giving the Gators a 63-60 victory in the consolation game ... Bodrick, named to the all-tournament squad, scored a game-high 18 points, while junior G Nicole Valentino and Abate scored 13 and 11, respectively.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents

W&J hosted the Holiday Inn Meadow Lands Classic last weekend and placed second after routing Penn State-Altoona before dropping a heartbreaking overtime decision to Otterbein Saturday ... Senior All-American G Leigh Sulkowski paced the Presidents with 20 points, 10 rebounds and seven assists in Friday's win ... The Presi-

dents started the first 12 minutes on a 31-9 run ... Sophomore F Maria Hillenbrand added 11 points, while senior F Lauren Slampak chipped in 10 ... The Presidents rallied from a 19-point deficit with 15 minutes left to send the Saturday game to overtime, but the Cardinals pulled out the win ... Sulkowski, who scored a careerhigh 35 points, drilled a three-pointer and was fouled to tie the game with 11 seconds left ... Her free throw, however, rimmed out to send the game to the extra session.

Westminster Lady Titans



Westminster suffered a pair of losses at the Penn State-Behrend Tipoff Tournament in Erie to open the season ... The Lady Titans fell 68-57 to the host Lions Friday in the opening round, then dropped a 60-40 decision to Mount Union in the consolation game ... Against Behrend, Westminster was led by junior F **Talley Felger**, who posted a team- and career-high 14 points and 14 rebounds in the loss ... Sophomore F **Terese Marszalek** was the only other Lady Titan to posted double digits in scoring with a career-best 11 points ... Junior G **Nicole**

Fee dished out four assists ... Marszalek posted team-best totals of 12 points and nine rebounds in the Mount Union loss en route to All-Tournament honors, while Fee recorded three assists.



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City went 1-1 at the Messiah Invitational last weekend, bouncing back from a semifinal loss to Messiah with a 69-63 win over 2005 NCAA Tournament qualifier Alvernia Saturday ... Sophomore F Rachel McCoy poured

in 24 points and grabbed 11 rebounds against Alvernia ... She shot 12-of-15 from the floor ... Junior **Elyse Bogusz** added 17 points and four assists while senior **Tammy Hess** chipped in 14 points on 5-of-7 shooting ... Bogusz earned All-Tournament honors ... **Brittany Anderson** grabbed a game-high 12 rebounds ... Grove City shot 55 percent (28-of-51) from the floor in the win ... McCoy had 11 points while Bogusz tossed in 10 against Messiah ... The Wolverines shot just 5-of-25 (20 percent) in the first half at Messiah.



Thomas More Saints

Hot shooting led the Saints past Juniata as they opened up a 20-point halftime lead shooting 80 percent from

behind the arc (8-of-10), including freshman **Alex Gee** connecting on 5-of-6 ... Junior G **Christian Stefanopoulos** and sophomore F **Amanda Link** were named to the All-Tournament team as they each reached double figures in both games ... Link averaged 13.0 points, 3.5 rebounds per game off the bench, while Stefanopoulos chipped in with 11.5 points, 4.5 rebounds and 4.5 assists ... In the Wilmington game, the Saint cut a 20-point deficit down to one in the second half before the Quakers iced the game with some clutch shots.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Yellow Jackets opened the season in dramatic fashion before junior G **Candice Eyerman** set a personal milestone in the championship game of the Allegheny Tournament ... Against the host Gators in the opener, junior transfer **Denise Kennedy** hit the game-winning shot with 0.3 second remaining to give Waynesburg a 63-62 vic-

tory ... Kennedy finished with a double-double in her first game with 11 points and a team-best 11 rebounds ... Eyerman and junior G **Katie Lewandowski** each added 18 points in the win ... The Yellow Jackets advanced to face John Carroll in the championship, which they lost 78-65 ... Eyerman, who earned all-tournament honors, again added 18 points to become the first player in recent program history to surpass 1,000 points in a career.

at Kenyon (11/22 - 7 p.m.) at Wilmington Tournament (11/26-27)

Bethany is on the road for three more games this week, beginning Tuesday with a trip to last

year's regular season NCAC champion, Kenyon ... The Ladies lead the all-time series 3-2 after taking last year's contest in Bethany 66-46 ... F **Courtney Irwin** had 14 points and **Lisa Mitchell** had 11 in the setback ... The Bison will then face Wilmington in the first round of the Quakers' tourney over the weekend ... WC leads the series between the teams 3-1, which includes an 82-66 win in the second round of the 2002 NCAA Tournament ... Bethany will play either DePauw or Hanover in game two.



Thiel Tomcats

vs. Denison (11/22 - 7 p.m.) vs. Carnegie Mellon (11/26 - 6 p.m.)

Thiel will host two home games this week, welcoming Denison Tuesday (7 p.m.) and CMU Saturday (6 p.m.) ... Tuesday's meeting with

Denison will be just the second all-time between the two schools with the Big Red earning a 65-43 victory in Granville, Ohio last season ... **Heather Abate** led the Tomcats with 20 points in the loss ... Thiel and CMU have met 31 times with the Tartans holding a 19-12 advantage ... Thiel posted a 75-70 win in Pittsburgh last season, led by **Nicole Valentino**'s 19-point effort...Thiel had lost nine straight to CMU before last season's victory.

The Saints are 5-1 in the Julie Costello Classic, and have won the last eight match-up with their opening round opponent, Centre ... Thomas More holds on 11-4 edge over MSJ, including wins in 10 of the last 11 contests.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents

at Allegheny (11/22 - 7 p.m.) at Pitt-Greensburg (11/26 - 2 p.m.)

The Presidents will travel to Allegheny Tuesday for the 20th meeting all-time ... The Gators lead the all-time series 12-7, but the current W&J senior class holds a perfect 3-0 record vs. AC ...

Senior G Leigh Sulkowski has averaged 14.6 points, 7.7 rebounds, 2.8 steals and 2.8 blocks in three career meetings with the Gators ... The Presidents have claimed five of seven lifetime meetings with Pitt-Greensburg ... W&J claimed an 86-74 decision in Washington overUP-G in the 2003-04 season as Sulkowski and senior F Amanda Stanonik combined for 35 points, 18 rebounds and eight steals.



at Marietta (11/22 - 7 p.m.)

Westminster will look for its first win of the 2005-06 seaso nwhen the Lady Titans travel to face Ohio Athletic Conference (OAC) member Marietta College on Tuesday ... The two teams faced off in New Wilmington early last season, with Westminster recording a 56-32 victory ... **Desiree Sterling** led the Lady Titans with 15 points, while **Erica Tallo** grabbed a team-best nine rebounds against the Pioneers.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets vs. Pitt-Greensburg (11/22 - 6 p.m.)

Waynesburg opens the home portion of its schedule Tuesday when it hosts Pitt-Greensburg ... The Bobcats have won the last five meetings against the Yellow Jackets dating back the 2001-2002 season, including a 65-48 victory in Greensburg

last season ... In that contest, G **Katie Lewandowski** was the lone Waynesburg player to reach double figures, scoring 14 points off the bench, while three Pitt-Greensburg players posted double-digits ... The Yellow Jackets look to start a season 2-1 for the first time since the 2002-2003 season when they finished the season above .500 for the first time since 1994-1995.
