PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

ALYSON GASPER

Westminster College

5-5 Senior Guard Beaver Falls, Pa./Blackhawk H.S.

Gasper earned Tournament MVP honors at the Muskingum Invitational after leading the Lady Titans to the championship with wins over NAIA member Geneva (61-47) and Denison (50-33). In the two wins, she averaged 10.0 points, 6.0 rebounds and 7.0 assists, including team-high totals of 15 points and seven assists in the title game.

Also nominated was senior C Katie Resanovich of Bethany, freshman F Rachel McCoy of Grove City, junior G Leigh Sulkowski of Washington & Jefferson, and junior G Candice Eyerman of Waynesburg.

Bethany Bison

The Bison lost two hard-fought games over the weekend at the PS-Behrend Tournament ... The weekend started with a 75-73 double-OT loss to Adrian in the opener ... Bethany led for the majority of the game, but Adrian came back to take the lead and a Nikki Babik lay-up sent the game to a first OT ... The game went to a second OT when the Bulldogs drained a triple with 21 seconds left to knot the score at 71 ... Adrian took the lead for good with a jumper with 26 seconds remaining ... Jenny Place led the way with 24 points, while Babik had 15 ... Against Juniata (a 50-46 loss), senior C Katie Resanovich tallied 11 points and 13 rebounds to earn a spot on the All-Tournament team.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J, ranked No. 25 in the preseason D3hoops.com Top 25 poll, dropped its season opener to Albion Saturday, 82-66 ... Albion, who was receiving votes in the first Top 25 poll, raced out to a 27-9 lead in the first nine minutes and led by as many as 20 three times in the first half ... W&J junior All-America guard Leigh Sulkowski led W&J with 19 points, seven rebounds and four steals, while junior G Dayna Greenfield added 11 ... Freshman F Maria Hillenbrand also chipped in with 10 points and seven boards off the bench ... Sulkowski scored a game-high 22 points and pulled down a game-high 11 rebounds in the 20point rout of Pitt-Bradford ... Junior G Courtney Janczak added 12 points, six rebounds and three assists.

Grove City Lady Wolverines

Grove City hosted the Howard Johnson Tip-Off Classic last weekend ... Senior Sandy O'Keefe and freshman Rachel McCov earned All-Classic honors ... McCov poured in a career-high 21 points and added 10 rebounds against NAIA Walsh Saturday ... O'Keefe recorded a 12-point, 7-rebound, 4-block effort against Walsh ... Abby Moose led Grove City with 23 points against Heidelberg Friday, with 19 coming in the first half ... She moved over the 900-point mark for her career Saturday ... With 901 points, she needs 29 to move past Kathy Hair (1988-92) for ninth on Grove City's all-time scoring list ... Junior **Tammy Hess** and sophomore Lee Anne Lukcic each made their first career start Friday night.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

For the second straight season, Waynesburg lost both of its games at the season-opening tip-off tournament ... The Yellow Jackets shot just 29 percent in the first game ... Bree Williams scored a career-high nine points to lead the Jackets, while Candice Eyerman and Katie Lewandowski each added eight points ... Trista Murphy led the team with a career-high nine rebounds ... In the consolation game, the Jackets continued to struggle, shooting just 31 percent including 27 percent (8-of-30) from beyond the arc ... Eyerman was the lone Jacket to record double-digit points with 18 points ... Transfer Jessica Hemphill led the team with nine rebounds and added nine points off the bench ... Eyerman earned all-tournament honors.

Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats got off to a rough start in their 2004-05 campaign, dropping a pair of contests at the Capital University Classic last weekend ... Thiel fell to the host Crusaders 84-46 in opening-round action Friday before losing to Calvin 72-44 in the consolation game Saturday ... The Tomcats struggled from the floor against Capital, hitting just 33.3% (17-51) of their shots ... The Crusaders, ranked 13th in Division III, finished with a 48-26 edge in rebounds ... Sophomore G Nicole Valentino led the way offensively, finishing with 15 points while senior F Kristen Benjamin added 10 points and a team-high five boards ... Freshman G Ariel Venesky led Thiel vs. Calvin with 12 points and a game-best eight caroms.

Westminster Lady Titans

The Lady Titans started the 2004-05 season with a bang, as Westminster rolled to wins over NAIA member Geneva (61-47) and Denison (50-33) to capture the championship at the Muskingum Invitational ... Following the invitational, senior G Alyson Gasper was named Tournament, while sophomore G Desiree Sterling was also named to the All-Tournament team ... Strong rebounding was key for the Lady Titans in both wins, as Westminster outrebounded Geneva 44-21 and Denison 46-29 ... Senior F Erica Tallo posted a pair of double-doubles, tallying 12 points and 12 boards against Geneva before totaling 10 points and 10 caroms vs. Denison ... Senior F Mary Jane Eaton had three steals vs. Denison.

Aloysius shot just 32 percent in the victory, while Waynesburg shot a season-low 21 percent from the field ... Eyerman was the lone Jacket to reach double-digits with 18 points ... She posted her first career double-double as she also grabbed 10 rebounds.

WESTMINSTER LADY TITANS (2-0 Overall, 0-0 PAC)

Marietta is 1-1 on the season, having topped PAC member Waynesburg 51-47 before falling to the host Lady Gators 52-42 at the Allegheny College Tip-Off Tournament in Meadville over the weekend ...
