## PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

#### **LEIGH SULKOWSKI**

Washington & Jefferson College 5-11 Freshman Guard Upper St. Clair, Pa./Upper St. Clair H.S.

Sulkowski earned the first PAC Women's Basketball Player of the Week award of the 2002-03 season after averaging 23.5 points, 6.5 rebounds and 3.5 steals en route to Tournament MVP honors at the Nan Nichols Classic this weekend. She scored 27 points on 10-of-13 shooting in a 74-63 first round win over Daemen on Friday, then notched 20 points and seven boards in a 69-46 title game win over host Wooster on Saturday. She shot 68% from the field for the weekend (19-of-28).

Also nominated was sophomore guard **Nikki Babik** of Bethany, senior forward **Christy Faller** of Grove City, junior forward **Amanda Swanson** of Thiel, freshman guard **Candice Eyerman** of Waynesburg, and senior guard **Jennifer Petures** of Westminster.

## PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

### **Bethany Bison**

The 24th-ranked Bison split a pair of games at the Wilmington Tournament ... In Friday's opener, #3 Wilmington shot 54 percent from the floor and outrebounded the Bison 43-25 en route to an 89-73 victory over the Bison ... C Kelley Richardson totaled 19 points, while G Nikki Babik hit five of 10 three-point attempts and scored 15 ... In the consolation game, Bethany rebounded in a big way with a 93-68 drubbing of Guilford ... A 7-7 effort from the foul line helped Babik post a game-high 18 and also help her earn All-Tournament team honors ... F Katie Hardie totaled a double-double with 17 points and 12 rebounds, while G Kiki Cohen fired in 16 and C Katie Resanovich tallied 11 off the bench.

### Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Freshman G Leigh Sulkowski led the Presidents to the championship of the Nan Nichols Classic this past weekend ... Sulkowski was named tournament MVP after scoring 23.5 points and adding 6.5 rebounds and 3.5 steals per game ... She notched a game-high 27 points and six boards in Saturday's win, while senior F Amy Strosnider notched a double-double with 14 points and 10 caroms ... Junior G Shawndra McDonald added 11 points and three assists ... Sulkowski once again led the way in the championship game against Wooster with 20 points, seven rebounds and four steals, while Strosnider. who was named the tournament's defensive MVP added 18 points ... The Presidents opened the season with two victories for the first time since 1993-94.

## **Grove City Lady Wolverines**

Grove City dropped both games at its Howard Johnson Tip-Off Classic last weekend ... Both setbacks came against NAIA schools ... All-Classic selection **Christy Faller** recorded 11 points and seven boards in a 53-47 loss to Walsh Friday night, while no Grove City player reached double-figures in a 64-37 loss to 7-1 Cedarville Saturday ... **Abby Moose** currently leads the team in scoring at 9.5 points per game ... It is Grove City's first 0-2 start since the 1994-95 season when two season-opening losses capped a 28-game skid.

### Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg opened the new season by splitting two games at the National City Bank Tournament hosted by Allegheny College over the weekend ... Waynesburg lost to the host Gators, 79-54, as freshmen **Candice Eyerman** scored 16 points in her college debut, while senior **Kyana Bradley** grabbed nine boards to go with her eight points ... In the consolation game, Waynesburg topped PAC foe Thiel, 50-43, in non-conference action behind Eyerman's 18 points and eight rebounds, while fellow freshman **Rachel Dillon** netted 12 points.

### **Thiel Tomcats**

Thiel went 0-2 at the National City Tipoff Tournament, hosted by Allegheny this weekend ... The Tomcats fell to College Misericordia 63-56 in the opener and lost to Waynesburg 50-43 in the consolation game ... Senior G Mayumi Sasaki had 13 points and three assists against Misericordia ... Junior F Amanda Swanson finished with six points and a game-high 14 rebounds against Misericordia and had game highs in points (20) and rebounds (14) versus Waynesburg ... Junior F Danielle Mezzullo scored eight points and grabbed four rebounds in the Waynesburg loss...Swanson was the lone Tomcat to be named to the All-Tournament Team.

### Westminster Lady Titans

Westminster captured the 2002 Penn State-Behrend Tipoff Tournament with wins over Alfred (65-53) and the host school (69-41) this weekend ... The Alfred win was the first collegiate head coaching win for new Lady Titan mentor Rosanne Scott ... Senior G Jennifer Petures had a game-high 16 points against Alfred. while sophomore F Erica Tallo and senior F Samor Himes each added "double-doubles" ... Petures was named Tournament MVP after recording 16 points, eight rebounds and team-high totals of five assists and five steals in the title game ... She was joined on the all-tournament team by senior G Ashley Kenney and Tallo ... Kenney bucketed a game-high 23 points on 11-of-17 shooting against PS-B.
