READY TO ROLL: The 2008-09 PAC women's basketball season got underway on November 15 ... Two-time defending PAC champion Thomas More was picked to again capture the conference title in the coaches/media poll released at PAC Basketball Media Day at the Heinz History Center in Pittsburgh on October 23 ... The Saints of head coach Brian Neal finished the 2007-08 season at 29-1 overall and were ranked as high as third in the nation in the USA Today national poll.

WHO'S HOT: After opening the season 4-0, Saint Vincent is off to its best start since the 1999-2000 campaign ... Ashley Campbell of Saint Vincent was named MVP of the St. John Fisher Invitational ... Thomas More senior G Jayme Thiem earned All-Tournament honots at Centre after averaging 12.0 points and 6.5 rebounds ... Bethany senior Kaitlyn McCormick was named to the All-Tournament team at Wooster after averaging 10.0 ppg ... Elisha Jones of Waynesburg earned All-Tourney honors at Allegheny.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Two new coaches debuted in the PAC last week, as Geneva interim coach Amy Russin opened 2-1 while new Waynesburg mentor Sam Jones dropped two games by a combined three points at Allegheny ... Westminster's Kaitlyn McCarthy earned All-Tourney honors at Behrend ... Thiel sophomore F Kim Stitt garnered All-Tournament recognition at Bluffton with 10.5 ppg and 12.0 rpg ... Grove City junior F Laura Miller averaged 12.3 points and 5.3 rebounds for the 0-3 Wolverines.

Bethany Bison (1-1, 0-0 PAC)

Bethany began the new season by finishing third at the Wooster Tournament ... The Bison shot 62 percent in the first half against Manchester to build a


Thomas More Saints (2-0, 0-0 PAC)
