5-7 senior guard Newton Falls, Ohio/Newton Falls H.S.

Sterling averaged 22.0 points per game while adding seven assists and six steals for Westminster last week, leading the Ti-tans to wins at Pitt-Bradford (53-35) and at



home vs. Wooster (58-53). She tallied a career-high 32 points in the Wooster win. For the week, she shot 13-of-25 (52%) from the field, including 60% (6-of-10) from three-point range.
