PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL 2011-12 - Week 2 Conference Notes

READY TO ROLL: The PAC women's basketball schedule for 2011-12 gets underway this Wednesday and Saturday with a full schedule of PAC contests on each date ... Five-time defending PAC champion Thomas More opens defense of its conference title on the road, as the Saints travel to Beaver Falls Wednesday to face Geneva in the first PAC contest for the Golden Tornadoes since securing NCAA Division III active membership status this past summer.

NEWS AND NOTES: Washington & Jefferson senior F **Ashley Kirkpatrick** posted new career-highs in points (21) and rebounds (15) in W&J's win at Allegheny ... Thomas More junior G **Allison Long** (19.5 ppg) was named MVP of the TMC Costello Classic ... Chatham junior G **Julianne Speeney** recorded 15 points in just 18 minutes in a Cougar win at Wilson ... Junior G **Jessi Drayer** averaged 17.0 points, 5.7 rebounds and 2.7 assists for 1-2 Waynesburg, including 28 points vs. Allegheny.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: **Brittany Sedlock** of Saint Vincent averaged 14.5 points and 10.0 rebounds in a 1-1 week ... **Chelsea D'Urso** bucketed a team-best 16 points for Geneva in a setback to NAIA member Carlow ... Senior F **Ashley Davis** also scored 16 markers for Thiel in a defeat at Denison ... Senior F **Emily Dolsak** recorded 12 points and seven rebounds for Westminster in a setback at Hiram ... **Leah Gibson** had 10 points for Grove City in a loss to Carnegie Mellon ... Bethany was off last week.

Bethany Bison (0-3, 0-0 PAC)

The Bison have been off since Nov. 19 when they dropped a 69-54 decision to Hiram in the Penn State-Behrend Tournament consolation game ... Senior F **Renee Shepherd** had 13 points and eight rebounds to earn All-Tournament team honors ... Bethany will be back on the court for a trio of games this week, beginning Monday with a home date against Franciscan.



Chatham Cougars (2-2, 0-0 PAC)

The Cougars opened up scoring on Tuesday and went on to beat Wilson 75-50 ... The Cougars shot 44% from the floor ... Five players scored in double digits ... **Julianne Speeneey** led in points with 15 ... She was joined by **Lizz King** and **Marguerite Sargent** who both recorded 14 points ... Sargent also recorded a game-high of six steals in favor of the Cougars ... **Carly Zelenak** earned her first double-double of the season with 10 rebounds and 10 points.



Geneva Golden Tornadoes (1-3, 0-0 PAC)

Geneva dropped a 57-54 decision to Penn State Beaver Tuesday after falling behind the Lions 12-0 to start the game ... The Golden Tornadoes battled back and led by 10 with less than nine minutes remaining ... Geneva could not hold the lead despite a game-high 14 points from **Rachel Rouan** and 10 each from **Kristland McCracken**, **Beth DeLuca** and **Chelsea Kauffman** ... The GTs watched Carlow pull away in the second half Saturday in a 54-40 loss to the Celtics ... **Chelsea D'Urso** served as one of Geneva's bright spots scoring 12 of her 16 points in the second half ... Geneva opens PAC play against 17th ranked and defending PAC champion Thomas More Wednesday.



Grove City Wolverines (1-3, 0-0 PAC)

The Grove City College women's basketball team dropped a 73-43 decision to Carnegie Mellon Tuesday night in the Wolverines' home opener ... Cold shooting doomed Grove City, which shot just 26 percent (18 of 70) from the field ... **Leah Gibson** led Grove City with 10 points ... Grove City had just 11 turnovers and committed only nine fouls ... The Wolverines are now 3-11 in their last 14 home openers ... Grove City opens conference play this week with a home bout against Bethany Wednesday night ... Grove City then visits Thomas More Saturday.



Saint Vincent Bearcats (3-1, 0-0 PAC)

The Bearcats had their unbeaten streak to begin the season snapped for the second straight year by Juniata as the Eagles posted a 76-63 win at the Carey Center Saturday ... Despite holding a nine-point lead, 38-29, at the half, SVC was unable to corral the Juniata offense in the second half as the Eagles shot 60.0 percent (15-of-25) from the floor and 45.5 percent (5-of-11) from three-point range in the second stanza ... Junior F **Devin McGrath** posted a season-high 17 points and pulled in six rebounds in the loss while **Brittany Sedlock** finished with a double-double of 14 points and 10 rebounds ... In the 80-32 win over Pitt-Bradford earlier in the week, 13 different players scored for SVC.



Thiel Tomcats (0-5, 0-0 PAC)

The Tomcats dropped a pair of contests last week, pushing their losing streak to five heading into PAC play ... In the first contest, Thiel dropped a 65-58 decision to Denison ... Senior F **Ashley Davis** led the way for Thiel in the contest as she has her best offensive night of the season, scoring 16 points on 6-of-9 shooting ... Junior C **Kelly Barzak** also had a solid performance as she notched her first double-double of the season with an 11-point, 11-rebound game ... In the second game of the week, the Tomcats dropped a close 61-59 decision to Hiram ... Junior G **Kelly Muffley** notched 16 points in the game and Davis added 13 ... Barzak had a solid day on the glass as she pulled down 12 rebounds.



Thomas More Saints (2-1, 0-0 PAC)

Thomas More opened the season with a 2-1 record as it defeated in-state rival Centre, 80-79, in **Jeff Hans'** first game as the Saints' mentor and defeated Shawnee State, 64-62, but fell, 65-59 to Capital ... Sophomore G **Katie Kitchen** scored a single-game school-record 39 points in the Saints' season-opening win at Centre and then followed it up with 25 points against Capital and nine against Shawnee ... Kitchen was named to the Julie Costello Memorial Classic All-Tournament team as she averaged 17 points per game in the Saints' games against Capital and Shawnee ... Junior guard **Allison Long** was named Most Valuable Player of the Costello Classic as he averaged 19.5 points per game.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents (2-2, 0-0 PAC)

W&J defeated Allegheny for the fourth time in the last five years 75-71 on Tuesday ... Senior **Ashley Kirkpatrick** scored notched career-highs in both points (21) and rebounds (15) ... Senior PG **Vanessa Rivera** tallied 19 points and nine assists ... W&J trailed by eight points at halftime but held Allegheny to 27 percent shooting in the second half (11-41) ... The Presidents defeated the Gators for the 12th time in 26 all-time meetings.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (2-2, 0-0 PAC)

The Waynesburg women opened up this past week on a high note with a 69-45 home victory over Hood College ... Unfortunately, the week didn't end as well, as the Yellow Jackets went 0-2 at the Mount Union M Club Shootout ... Junior G **Jessi Drayer** led the Jackets by averaging a team-high 17.0 points and 5.7 rebounds per game, while also dishing out eight assists and swiping four steals ... Drayer poured in a game-high 28 points against Allegheny, while also going for 12 against Manchester and an 11-point, 10-rebound double-double against Hood ... Sophomore **Elaine Hasek** averaged 11.7 points per game over three starts.



Westminster Titans (0-4, 0-0 PAC)

Westminster lost 65-55 at Hiram Saturday in a nonconference game ... The Titans remain winless at 0-4 while the Terriers improve to 2-2 ...
