# PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

#### CANDICE EYERMAN

Waynesburg College 5-5 Sophomore Guard Cranberry Township, Pa./Seneca Valley H.S.

Eyerman scored a game-high and season-high 23 points, including 7-of-15 accuracy from behind the three-point arc, while adding six rebounds in leading the Yellow Jackets to their first win of the season, a 53-49 triumph over La Roche in the team's only game of the week.

Also nominated was senior C Kelley Richardson of Bethany, junior C Adrienne Mowry of Thiel, senior G Shawndra McDonald of Washington & Jefferson, and freshman G Desiree Sterling of Westminster.

### PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

#### Bethany Bison

Bethany split a pair of home games last week, topping Penn State-Behrend 82-58 on Tuesday before dropping an 85-67 decision to Otterbein on Saturday ... Senior forward Katie Hardie scored her 1,000th career point in Saturday's loss to Otterbein ... She finished the game with 17 points and now has 1,004 in her career ... She is the second team member to eclipse 1,000 points in her career, joining senior center Kelley Richardson, who reached her 1,000th point last season ... Richardson, with 24 points against Otterbein, now has 1,276 points in her career.

#### Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Senior G Shawndra McDonald netted 19 points and added five assists to lead W&J to a 62-55 victory at Allegheny Tuesday ... The win was the Presidents' first-ever victory over the Gators in Meadville in nine tries ... Sophomore F Katie Gress scored with 1:23 left in the first half to give the Presidents a 31-28 lead, but an AC jumper 23 seconds later to bring the Gators to within one point at the half ... The Gators trailed 53-50 with 4:09 left, but sophomore G Leigh Sulkowski drilled a three pointer to make it a 56-50 game with 3:22 left ... McDonald made 7-of-21 shots from the field and added six rebounds and three steals ... Sulkowski added 15 points, nine rebounds and three assists, while Gress posted her first career double-double with 13 points and 11 rebounds.

### Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg saw a 19-point, second-half lead shrink to four points before holding for a non-conference win over visiting La Roche on Tuesday ... The Jackets prevailed, 53-49, for their first win of the season in the home opener ... The Redhawks went on an 11-0 run with 6:24 left when the Jackets led 49-32 ... Waynesburg didn't score until 1:28 remaining ... Sophomore guard Candice Eyerman shot 7 of 15 from the field, all of which were three-pointers ... She finished with a gamehigh 23 points to go with her six rebounds ... Sophomore forward Trista Murphy also found her stroke from three-point range hitting three treys ... She finished with 11 points and team-high seven rebounds and four steals ... The Redhawks out-rebounded the Jackets, 49-39 ... Rachel Dillon dished out a game-high six assists

#### Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats finished the week 1-2, capped by a third-place finish at the Ramada Inn Tournament ... Thiel opened the week with a 56-62 loss to Carnegie Mellon in its home opener on Tuesday ... Sophomore G Heather Abate finished with game-high 16 points, hitting 5-of-6 from beyond the arc ... Thiel dropped its opening game of the Ramada Inn Tournament (hosted by St. John Fisher College) to Staten Island 42-64 on Saturday before defeating D'Youville 81-47 in the consolation game Sunday ... Senior G Kerry Gutherie had 13 points and seven rebounds and junior C Adrienne Mowry added 10 points and three boards in the CSI loss ... Mowry had a career-best 22 points and led a trio of Tomcats in double figures in their win over D'Youville.

#### Westminster Lady Titans

Westminster went 1-2 last week, dropping its home opener versus Pitt-Greensburg 63-56 before splitting two games at the Julie Costello Memorial Tournament at Thomas More ... The Lady Titans topped Emory 73-59 in the first round before falling to the hosts 65-37 in the title game ... Junior G Alyson Gasper scored 13 points against UP-G, followed by junior Fs Erica Tallo and Mary Jane Eaton with 12 apiece ... Tallo also snared a game-high 18 rebounds in the loss ... Gasper has a near "triple-double" with 15 points, nine boards and nine assists against Emory ... Freshmen Gs Nicole Fee and Desiree Sterling added 13 and 11 points, respectively, while junior G Erin Morrow posted 10 ... Sterling had 12 points in the loss to TMC and was the lone Lady Titan named to the alltournament team.
