PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL 2008-09 - Week 2 Conference Notes

PAC PLAY TO BEGIN: Conference play in the Presidents' Athletic Conference (PAC) begins this week, as each team will play three league contests prior to Christmas ... League action opens Monday night (Dec. 1), as Washington & Jefferson travels to Grove City, followed by a full slate of PAC contests on Wednesday (Dec. 3) and Saturday (Dec. 6) ... After the holiday break, the conference schedule will re-open on Saturday, January 3 and continue through February 21.

WHO'S HOT: Thomas More improved to a perfect 5-0 with a 3-0 week and are outscoring opponents by 27.0 ppg ... Chatham improved to 3-1, its best start in 20 years of intercollegiate basketball, with a 62-35 win over Franciscan behind 13 points and five steals by **Barb Petty** ... Senior **Michawn Rich** recorded 20 points and 17 rebounds for Geneva in a 78-75 home win over Penn State-Beaver ... Senior **Amber Bodrick** posted 21 points, 12 rebounds and five assists for Thiel in a 72-62 win over Kenyon.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Westminster junior G **Amy Dolsak** recorded 19 points and 11 rebounds in a 68-60 OT win at Mount Union ... Sophomore F **Christine Slater** had 17 points and eight rebounds for Grove City in a 60-48 loss at Case Western Reserve ... Senior F **Emily Hays** averaged 16.5 ppg for 1-1 W&J last week ... **Renee Brandenburg** of Bethany was named to the All-Tournament team at Wilmington ... Junior G **Jen Scarborough** led Waynesburg with 10 points in a 59-47 loss at La Roche.

PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison (1-1, 0-0 PAC)



Bethany began the new season by finishing third at the Wooster Tournament ... The Bison shot 62 percent in the first half against Manchester to build a 35-21 halftime lead, but a six-minute scoring drought late in the game allowed the Spartans to rally for a 59-52 victory ... **Kaitlyn McCormick** was the only Bison in double digits with 13, while **Tara Harris** had eight points and six rebounds ... BC nearly saw a 43-28 halftime margin get away Sunday against Pitt-Bradford, but they held on for a 76-73 triumph when a Panther three at the buzzer was off the mark ... **Kelly Goode** tallied 18, while **Annie Wilson**, who scored Bethany's final 7 points, notched 15 and **Renee Brandenburg** had 14.

Chatham Cougars (3-1, 0-0 PAC)



Chatham women's basketball team to a 62-35 non-conference victory over visiting Franciscan University ... With the win, Chatham improves to 3-1 overall, its best start in 20 seasons of intercollegiate basketball ... Sophomore **Barb Petty** scored a game-high 13 points, including the first seven of the game, and collected five steals to lead the victorious Cougars ... Fellow sophomore **Kayla Hilko** added 11 points, while sophomore **Courtney Smith** tallied six steals ... Senior **Allason Holt** added a game-high six rebounds, and connected on both of her free throw attempts to become the program's career leader in free throws made (181).

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (3-1)



Geneva won its only game of the week on the strength of senior **Michawn Rich** ... Rich posted 20 points and 17 rebounds in Geneva's 78-75 victory over Penn State-Beaver ... The victory moved Geneva to a 3-1 record in the first two weeks of the season ... The Golden Tornadoes will open PAC play this week with road games at Grove City and W&J ... Geneva featured four players in double figures in the victory over PS-Beaver, including a 17 point effort from sophomore **Val Hamilton** ... Hamilton also pulled down eight rebounds in the victory. Geneva was 30-of-37 from the foul line, including perfect 8-of-8 performances from **Rachel Barry** and **Renee Rawding**.

Grove City Wolverines (0-4, 0-0 PAC)



Grove City dropped a 60-48 decision to host Case Western Reserve Tuesday night in Cleveland ... Sophomore F **Christine Slater** paced GCC with 17 points and eight rebounds while senior G **Raeann Szelong** fired in 11 points ... **Jenna Johnston** pulled in a career-high 10 rebounds ... The Wolverines committed 23 turnovers and shot 35 percent (20 of 57) from the field ... Grove City will play three games in six days this week, starting with Monday's night clash against Washington & Jefferson ... Geneva will visit Grove City Wednesday night while Saturday, the Wolverines play at Westminster ... It's the fifth time in six years that Grove City opens conference play at home.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (4-0)



After playing four games over seven days to open the season, the Lady Bearcats had the week off ... With a 4-0 record to open the season, the team is off to its best start since the 1999-2000 campaign ... It's been a well balanced scoring effort for the squad thus far, as six players average at least 6.0 points per game, led by senior **Janelle Reed's** 20.0 ppg ... The team has also forced 94 turnovers while committing just 66, with Reed grabbing 16 steals on the year and **Ashley Campbell** 15 ... Campbell also tops the PAC with an average of 8.0 assists per game.

Thiel Tomcats (3-2, 0-0 PAC)



Thiel women's basketball picked up its third victory of the season after dismissing Kenyon, 72-62 ... The game was much closer than the final score would indicate, with the lead changing hands a total of eight times ... With less than ten minutes to play, the Ladies went up 49-45 ... This last shift on the scoreboard seemed to ignite the Tomcats, as they dismantled Kenyon with a 27-13 run to finish out the game ... Thiel was led by senior F **Amber Bodrick**, who put on an excellent all-around performance stuffing the stat sheet with 21 points, 12 rebounds, five assists and two steals ... Bodrick also finished the day shooting 8-of-8 from the charity stripe... Freshmen F **Towanda-Michelle Warren** finished with 12 points.

Thomas More Saints (5-0, 0-0 PAC)



The Saints extended its season-opening winning streak to five games last week with wins over Mt. St. Joseph Wednesday and Calvin and Centre in the Julie Costello Memorial Tournament over the weekend ... Against MSJ, the Saints had four players score in double-figures led by senior G **Jayne Thiem** with 16 points ... In the win against Calvin, the Saints were led by Thiem with 20 points, while sophomore C **Nicole Dickman** and senior PG **Gabby Johnson** added 16 and 14 points, respectively ... Against Centre, Dickman had a double-double as she scored 22 points on 9-of-12 shooting from the floor and 2-of-3 shooting at the free throw line and also pulled down 10 rebounds.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (3-1, 0-0 PAC)



The Washington & Jefferson women's basketball program suffered its first loss of the season last Saturday, dropping a 60-53 decision against the No. 13 Baldwin-Wallace ... For the second straight season, W&J battled a nationally-ranked Baldwin-Wallace squad for 40 tough minutes, before eventually falling in both games by a combined 12 points ... Senior F **Emily Hays** leads the Presidents in points (17.8 ppg), while junior forward Maggie Gibson leads the squad in rebounds (12.3 rpg) ... The Presidents open PAC play tonight, traveling to Grove City for a 6:00 pm tip-off.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (0-3, 0-0 PAC)



The 2008-2009 season has gotten off to a rough start for the Waynesburg women's hoopsters ... On Monday, Nov. 24, the Yellow Jackets fell to 0-3 overall with a 59-47 defeat at the hands of La Roche ... Junior **Jen Scarborough** recorded her first double-digit scoring effort as a member of the Waynesburg women's team, putting up 10 points in 31 minutes of work ... Sophomore F **Elisha Jones** added eight points and eight rebounds, while freshman G **Hannah Hunter** also added eight points in the loss.

Westminster Titans (2-2, 0-0 PAC)



Junior G **Amy Dolsak** tied a career high with 19 points as Westminster came back to beat previously unbeaten Mount Union, 68-60, in overtime Saturday in the Titans' lone game of the week ... Dolsak, who also pulled down a career-high 11 rebounds, posted her second career double-double ... Westminster came from behind to secure the win as its eight-point differential to end the game was its largest lead of the game ... Senior G **Gina Brunetti** sent the game to overtime with a jumper that tied the game at 55-55 with nine seconds remaining ... Brunetti and sophomore **Kaitlin McCarthy** were the other double-figure scorers for the Titans with 11 and 12 points, respectively.

Bethany opens PAC play this week with a road trip to two-time defending league champion Thomas More before finally playing a home game when they host Waynesburg Saturday ... Thomas More leads the series with the Bison 7-1, including a pair of wins last year by scores of 71-60 in Bethany and 81-55 at TMC ... BC's win over the Saints was a 71-65 decision in 2003 ... Bethany has claimed three straight from Waynesburg and holds a 26-15 advantage in the all-time series ... The Bison posted a 65-47 triumph on the road before besting the Yellow Jackets 77-50 at home last year ... **Kelly Goode** averaged 20 points and 4.5 steals in the two wins.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes at Grove City* (12/3) at Washington & Jefferson* (12/6) (www.msasportsnetwork.com)



Grove City defeated Geneva for the first time at home since 1992 a year ago ... The Golden Tornadoes dropped a 54-45 decision to the Wolverines, which was one of only six losses all year ... Geneva did defeat Grove City at Metheny Fieldhouse by the count of 67-53 ... Geneva leads the all-time series with GCC, 22-19 ... The Golden Tornadoes swept the season series from Washington & Jefferson a year ago and lead the all-time series 6-2 ... **Allyson Clarke** posted 28 points in Geneva's 78-75 victory at W&J last year.

Saint Vincent Bearcats vs. Westminster* (12/3) (www.redzonemedia.com)



The Lady Bearcats return from a 10-day layoff on Wednesday, hosting PAC foe Westminster at 6 p.m. ... Since Saint Vincent joined the PAC in the 2006-07 season, the Lady Bearcats have posted just a 1-3 record against the Titans ... SVC's lone win over the span came on January 26th last season, a 91-64 home triumph ... **Janelle Reed** exploded for 31 points in the win, connecting on six three-pointers, while also grabbing five steals and dishing five assists ... **Ashley Campbell** added 15 points and five helpers, and then-senior **Caryn Glassbrenner** scored 11 points and set a team record with seven blocked shots.
