Bodrick averaged 29.0 points, 11.0 rebounds, 3.0 assists, 2.5 blocks and 2.0



Bethany Bison



Pioneers used a 19-4 run in the second half to score a 74-63 victory ... **Kelly Goode** had a good all-around game, notching 19 points, eight rebounds, five steals, four assists and two blocks, while **Renee Brandenburg** recorded 16 points, six rebounds and four blocks ... Against #14 Thomas More, BC fell behind by as many as 19 in the first half and was never able to pull out of the hole ... The setback came despite a season-high 28 points from **Lisa Mitchell**, which included four three-pointers.



Geneva Golden Tornadoes

A busy four-game week came to an end on Saturday with Geneva defeating its first PAC opponent of the season in Grove City ... In doing so,

the Golden Tornadoes set a new school record by opening the season with its sixth straight win, a record that was set originally by the 1987-88 Geneva team ... Geneva won three games in three days to start the week with impressive victories over Fredonia, Carlow and Franciscan ... **Allyson Clarke** picked up a pair of double-doubles on the week, including a 21 point-12 rebound effort in the win over Grove City.



Saint Vincent Bearcats

The Lady Bearcats continued to struggle, dropping all three games last week ... Tuesday against former NAIA rival Ursuline, SVC squandered a 41-34 halftime lead, falling 77-71 ... Laura Klimchock

led the way with 22 points, while **Janelle Reed** scored 20 and **Ashley Campbell** had 14 points, 10 rebounds and six assists ... At PSU-Altoona, SVC shot just 27 percent from the field ... Klimchock scored 18 and Reed 14, while **Gabbie Kassis** grabbed 11 rebounds, blocked six shots, and scored eight points ... Saturday, the Bearcats shot 24 percent at Westminster ... Kassis scored 10 points to lead the way, while Campbell picked up six steals.



Thomas More Saints

Three players scored in double figures as No. 14 Thomas More remained unbeaten with a 71-60 win over Westminster ... Junior **Jayme**

Thiem and freshman **Nicole Dickman** each recorded 12 points in the victory, while senior **Tandrea Sellers** added 11 points ... The Thomas More lead grew to as much as 23 before the Bison made a late charge.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Yellow Jackets have lost four straight games by double digits after opening the season with a victory ... Without two of its starters, Waynesburg

lost to Carnegie Mellon, 60-50, on Wednesday ... Junior G Sarah Gossett led the team with 10 points, while sophomore G Johnna Deco and junior F Michaelene Jones each added nine ... The Yellow Jackets held a 40-30 rebound edge vs. the Tartans with four starters collecting eight or more rebounds, led by 10 from junior F Jeanette Wonsettler. Waynesburg dropped its PAC opener at Thiel on Saturday, 69-57 ... Wonsettler led the team with 15 points, while sophomore G Kristen Lucci added a career-high 14 points.

Chatham Cougars

Chatham fell to Washington and Jefferson College by a score of 58-49 in its first PAC action on Saturday ... The first half was a tight contest with five lead

changes ... W&J went on a 7-0 run to end the first half and extend its lead to six points ... Chatham kept the game close throughout the second half and cut the lead to two points (50-48) with just over three minutes remaining ... W&J finished the second half with another 7-0 run to secure the victory ... **Kayla Hilko** and **Barb Petty** each scored 10 points in the loss ... The Cougars return to action when they travel to Saint Vincent on Wednesday night.



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City dropped to 2-3 with a pair of setbacks last week, as scoreless droughts in the second half of both games helped doom the Wolverines ... Against Case Western Wednesday, Grove City

did not score for over seven minutes in the second half in a 55-43 setback ... Raeann Szelong led GCC with 11 points, while Brittany Anderson added eight points and a team-high 10 boards ... Saturday at Geneva, the Wolverines did not record a field goal during a six-minute stretch of the second half of a 67-53 loss ... Shannon Overdorff scored 13 points, while Christine Slater chipped in 11 points in her return to her native Beaver County.



Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats finished the week 2-0 and won its first PAC contest of the season against Waynesburg ... Junior G **Amber Bodrick** collected a career-high

18 rebounds vs. Waynesburg and a season-high in points with 34 in the win against Hiram ... Defensively, Bodrick was stellar, posting five blocks and four steals for the week Junior G Jena Cook scored a combined 27 points last week ... Sophomore F Jasmin Jones posted a career-high 17rebounds in the Waynesburg victory ... Freshman F Kim Stitt finished the week with a combined 18 points and 12 rebounds, while junior G Catie Sieber had five steals last week ... The Tomcats outrebounded their opponents 97-78.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents

The Presidents went 2-0 last week to improve to 5-1 for the third time in four seasons ... Sophomore F Maggie Gibson notched her fourth double-double of the season Wednesday as W&J ran away from John Carroll, 79-64 ... Gibson finished with 15 points

and 10 rebounds ... Junior F **Emily Hays** added 19 points, while sophomore PG **Kennan Killeen** added 14 points, five assists and four rebounds ... Sophomore G **Stephanie Smith** fired in a gamehigh 14 points, including a key three-pointer with just under two minutes remaining, to help W&J open PAC play with a 57-48 victory at Chatham ... Senior F **Maria Hillenbrand** added 11 points.



Westminster Titans

Westminster (5-0) is off to its best start since starting 7-0 in 1988-89 after posting two wins last week ... The Titans won 64-54 at Wooster Wednesday before routing Saint Vincent, 77-45, at home Saturday ... Senior G/F Emilee Ackerman scored a game-high 24 points vs. Saint Vincent, while snaring 11 rebounds for her sixth career "double-double" ... Including a game-high 24 points against Wooster, Ackerman has now scored

at least 24 points in her last four games ... Sophomore C **Rachel Martinko** had 13 points and 13 rebounds vs. SVC ... Sophomore G **Gina Brunetti** bucketed a career-high 16 points at Wooster.

Bethany Bison

at Waynesburg* (12/5) vs. Geneva* (12/8)

Bethany will try to even its PAC record at 1-1 Wednesday when the Bison travel to Waynesburg ... BC leads the series with the Yellow Jackets 24-15, with the teams splitting the last eight meetings ... The Bison did win the last match-up, a 65-61 triumph in last year's PAC Tournament Quarterfinals, but they have lost their last three trips to Waynesburg, including a 74-69 overtime setback last season ... Bethany has won six of the 10 all-time meetings with Geneva ... GC won the last contest, 70-65, at home in 2001.



Geneva Golden Tornadoes

vs. Washington & Jefferson* (12/5); at Bethany* (12/8)

Geneva has not played Bethany since the 2000-01 season and have not faced W&J since 1987-88, which ironically was the last time GC opened the season by winning the first five games of the season ... Geneva holds a 4-2 advantage over the Presidents in the series that started in 1981 ... Meanwhile, Geneva has defeated Bethany in six of 10 meetings, beginning with a 71-70 win during the 1990-91 campaign.



Saint Vincent Bearcats

SVC will look to get back into the win column this week, with a pair of games against PAC foes ... On Wednesday, the Bearcats will face Chatham, a team which they defeated 76-46 on January 29th of last season ... On Saturday, SVC takes on Waynesburg, and the two teams split the series last season, with each team winning at home.



Thomas More Saints

vs. Thiel* (12/5) vs. Westminster* (12/8)

No. 14 Thomas More will host a pair of PAC match-ups this week, including a rematch of last year's PAC final Saturday when Westminster comes to town ... Thomas More leads the Westminster series, 7-0, including all three last season ... On Wednesday, Thomas More hosts Thiel, and they lead the series, 4-0.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

vs. Bethany* (12/5) at Saint Vincent* (12/8)

In their last four games (all losses), the Yellow Jackets are shooting just 33.0 percent (76-of-230) from the field, including 24.6 percent (17-of-69) from beyond the arc, and have committed a combined 86 turnovers ... Bethany won two of three meetings against WU last year, including a 65-61 contest in the PAC Tournament ... In those three games against the Bison, F Jeanette Wonsettler averaged a double-double with 13.7 points and 10.0 rebounds ... The Yellow Jackets split the season series with Saint Vincent last year, with each home team winning.



Chatham Cougars

at Saint Vincent* (12/5) at Thiel* (12/8)

Chatham hits the road for a pair of PAC contests this week, as the Cougars travel to Latrboe to meet Saint Vincent on Wednesday and head to Greenville on Saturday to face Thiel.



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City hosts Westminster Wednesday night at 6 p.m. in the Wolverines' PAC home opener ... Westminster ousted Grove City from the 2007 PAC Championship Tournament in the quarterfinals ... Grove City leads the all-time series 33-25 ... Westminster won all three meetings last year ... Saturday, Grove City visits Washington & Jefferson ... Grove City is seeking its first win in the Henry Center since Feb. 12, 2005.



Thiel Tomcats

at Thomas More* (12/5) vs. Chatham* (12/8)

Thiel will look to build on its two-game win streak when the Tomcats travel to Kentucky to face nationally-ranked Thomas More on Wednesday night ... Saturday, Thiel returns home to host new PAC member Chatham.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents

at Geneva* (12/5) vs. Grove City* (12/8)

The Presidents and Golden Tornadoes meet on the hardwood for the first time since Jan. 26, 1988 ... Geneva earned a 68-65 victory in that contest ...

The last time the two schools played in Beaver Falls came the year before (2/16/1987), as the Golden Tornadoes rolled to an 82-56 win ... W&J claimed the first two meetings in the all-time series ... W&J holds a 32-22 lead in the series with Grove City ... The Presidents have won 14 of the last 18 games versus the Wolverines, including 63-51 and 67-49 decisions a year ago.



Westminster Titans

at Grove City* (12/5) at Thomas More* (12/8)

Westminster looks to improve to 7-0 to start the season to match its best start since 1988-89 with PAC games at Grove City and Thomas More ... Three of the Titans' seven losses last season were against Thomas More, including a 59-50 loss in the PAC finals - the other two

were a one-point loss at home and a 13-point loss in overtime ... The Titans won all three games vs. Grove City last year, including a 67-46 win at home in the PAC Tournament.
