# PAC Women's Basketball Player of the Week

## KELLEY RICHARDSON

#### **Bethany College**

6-0 Sophomore Center Follansbee, W.Va./Brooke H.S.

Richardson averaged 20.6 points and 12.3 rebounds as Bethany went 2-1 on the week, with the only loss coming to #16-ranked Messiah. She posted "double doubles" in al three games, stretching her "double double" streak to five straight contests. She had 17 points and 15 rebounds vs. Pitt-Greensburg, 18 points and 11 boards vs. Messiah, and 24 points and 11 rebounds against Frostburg State.

Also nominated was senior forward **Sarah Snyder** of Thiel and sophomore guard **Shawndra McDonald** of Washington & Jefferson.

# PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

## **Bethany Bison**

The sophomore duo of Kelley Richardson and Katie Hardie carried the Bison to a 2-1 week ... Richardson recorded three more double-doubles, stretching her streak to five consecutive, while averaging 20.6 points and 12.3 rebounds ... Hardie, who scored 25 of her careerhigh 31 points in the second half of the loss to 16th ranked Messiah, averaged 20.6 points and 7.7 boards for the week ... Both were named to the Bethany Holiday Invitational All-Tournament team ... In the consolation win over Frostburg, the 95 points were the most scored by the Bison since a 102-63 victory over Waynesburg in 1999 ... Freshmen Nikki Babik and Katie Resanovich added 18 and 16 points respectively, vs. Frostburg.

## Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J finished a 2-2 week with a 90-39 rout of Hilbert on Saturday afternoon in the consolation game of the Lake Erie Tournament ... The Presidents jumped out to a 58-19 halftime lead and were led by sophomore guards Stephanie Ceraso and Shawndra McDonald, who each scored 20 points ... On Friday evening, Calvin came back from a 30-25 halftime deficit to defeat W&J, 60-51 ... Sophomore guard Rachel Armitage led W&J with 15 points, but the Presidents could not overcome 23 turnovers in the loss ... McDonald led W&J to the overtime victory against Penn State-Behrend with 32 points on 12-of-24 shooting ... Penn State-Altoona edged W&J on a put-back at the buzzer on Monday evening.

## **Grove City Lady Wolverines**

Grove City recovered from a 30-point loss with a 27-point victory Saturday at Pitt-Greensburg ... Eleven players dented the scoring column in the win over UP-G, led by junior Christy Faller's 11 points ... Junior Cara Denniston had a teamhigh eight rebounds in the victory ... Grove City held host Pitt-Greensburg to 26.5% shooting (13-49).

## Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg dropped to 3-3 after losses to Carlow (72-43) and Penn State-Altoona (74-55) last week.

## Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats are 3-3 after their first six in 2001 after starting last season 1-5 through six games...Senior Sarah Snyder scored a career-high 26 points in the Cats 72-56 win over Notre Dame (OH) on December 1...Freshman Tanisha Franklin has helped the Cats so far this season, averaging 5.8 points per game and leading the team with 2.8 assists a game and 2.5 steals per ... Snyder leads the team in points, averaging 13.5 points per game and is second in rebounding, averaging 6.3 rebounds per game.

## Westminster Lady Titans

After opening the season 0-3, the Lady Titans broke into the win column with victories over Allegheny (65-62) and Mount Aloysius (65-51) this week ... Westminster trailed much of the game against Allegheny until junior Samor Himes scored two of her team-high 14 points on an eight-foot jumper with 26 seconds to play, giving Westminster a 63-62 lead it would not relinquish ... Senior guard Robin Thayer led the way against Mount Aloysius with a seasonhigh 25 points, while juniors Teale Ganster and Jennifer Petures had 10 points each and Ashley Kenney dished out seven assists.
