PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

KELLEY RICHARDSON

Bethany College
 6-0 Senior Center

Richardson was named MVP of the Bethany College Holiday Tournament and averaged 21.7 points, 9.0 rebounds, and 2.3 steals for the 2-1 Bison last week. She shot 77.4% from the field (24-of-31) and 71% from the line (17-of-24) for the week. Richardson posted 24 points and 13 rebounds in an overtime loss at Pitt-Greensburg and added 27 points and eight boards in a win over Case Western Reserve.

Also nominated was junior C Sandy O'Keefe of Grove City, sophomore G Leigh Sulkowski of Washington & Jefferson, junior F Michelle Collins of Waynesburg, and junior F Erica Tallo of Westminster.

Bethany Bison

Bethany went 2-0 in the Bethany College Holiday Invitational over the weekend, defeating Case Western Reserve and Thomas More ... Senior forward Kelley Richardson was named tournament MVP, while senior Katie Hardie was also named to the all-tournament team.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J finished the Bethany Holiday Classic this past weekend with a 1-1 record ... W&J knocked off previously-unbeaten Thomas More on Friday night in double overtime ... Senior G Shawndra McDonald canned a three pointer with eight seconds left in the first overtime to tie the game and then sophomore G Leigh Sulkowski drilled a triple to open the scoring in the second OT ... W&J made all six of its free throws down the stretch to earn the win ... McDonald scored 25 points and dished out a career-high 11 assists ... Sulkowski netted 20 markers, while grabbing six rebounds ... The Presidents played all but 11 minutes without McDonald on Saturday as she was taking the LSAT ... Sulkowski, who was named to the all-tournament team, scored a team-high 22 points in just 24 minutes of action.

Grove City Lady Wolverines

Grove City recorded its first 3-0 start since the 1982-83 season with a win at Carnegie Mellon ... No Grove City player scored more than 10 points in the win but nine different players scored from the field ... Jocelyn Kempema had her first double-double with 10 points and 10 rebounds in the win while Sandy O'Keefe and Abby Moose each had 10 points ... O'Keefe led Grove City with 14 points against Baldwin-Wallace in a matchup of 3-0 teams Thursday night ... B-W broke the game open with a 17-0 run during the middle portion of the game ... Six Grove City players are averaging at least 24.3 minutes per game but none more than 25.8 per game.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg is on a four-game win streak after starting the season 0-2 ... The Jackets won three road games this week over La Roche (81-68), Penn State-Altoona (64-59), and Mount Aloysius (73-68) ... Against La Roche, junior F Michelle Collins had a career-high in points (19) and rebounds (17) ... Against Altoona, sophomore G/F Trista Murphy shot 5-of-12 from three-point range before finishing with a team-high 15 points ... Against Mount Aloysius, it was sophomore G Candice Eyerman's turn to show her range; she made 8-of-15 treys for a game-high 24 points for her fourth game of her career with eight or more three-pointers ... The Jackets four-game win streak ties the longest streak under fifth-year head coach Terry Acker.

Thiel Tomcats

After a 17-day layoff, the Thiel women's basketball squad will return to action on Saturday, traveling to Notre Dame College (OH) for a 2 p.m. contest ... The Tomcats will play four more contests before Christmas break.

Westminster Lady Titans

The Lady Titans went 1-1 last week, falling at Otterbein 82-52 on Wednesday before snapping a two-game losing streak with a come-from-behind 66-58 home win over Allegheny on Saturday ... At Otterbein, the lone double-digit scorer was junior F Erica Tallo, who posted team-high totals of 16 points, eight rebounds and four steals ... Freshman G Desiree Sterling added nine points and tied classmate Rachel Eaton for team assist honors with three apiece ... The Lady Titans trailed Allegheny 36-29 at the half, but outscored the Gators 37-22 from there ... Sterling led the team off the bench by bucketing a career-high and team-best 15 points ... Tallo added 14 points and a game-high 14 rebounds for her third double-double of the season, while junior forward Mary Jane Eaton chipped in with 11 points.
