

GCC SHOCKS W&J: The PAC league schedule got underway last week with a full slate of games on both Wednesday and Saturday ... The upset of the week came on Saturday, as 1-4 Grove City shocked previously unbeaten and nationally-ranked Washington & Jefferson 72-70 in Washington ... Defending PAC champion Thomas More jumped out to the early PAC lead with conference wins over Waynesburg and Chatham ... Saint Vincent is 5-1 on the season after two wins last week.

NEWS & NOTES: Thomas More is ranked 13th in NCAA Division III by both <u>D3Hoops.com</u> and WBCA/USA Today ... Sophomore G Katie Tierney averaged 14.0 points and 4.0 rebounds per game for the 2-0 Saints ... Sophomore G Morgan Hoone averaged 12.7 ppg for 2-1 Waynesburg, including 15 in a win over Penn St.-Greater Allegheny ... Junior G/F Kayla Hilko of Chatham posted her first career double-double with 15 points and 10 rebounds vs. Waynesburg.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Renee Rawding of Geneva needs just seven points to become the 12th 1,000-point scorer in GT women's basketball history ... Maria Baroffio scored 22 points for Saint Vincent in a win over Thiel ... Senior PG Kennan Killeen averaged 19.0 ppg for 1-1 W&J, including 24 points in a loss to Grove City ... Senior G Amy Dolsak averaged 13.3 ppg, 3.7 rpg and 2.0 spg for 1-2 Westminster ... Kayla Taromina of Bethany had 18 points and 18 rebounds in a loss at Westminster.

PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison (1-5, 0-2 PAC)

The Bison string of hard luck continued last week with two PAC losses by a combined three points ... So far, BC's five losses have come by a combined

total of 16 points, an average of 3.2 per setback ... A foul shot with twotenths of a second to play propelled Westminster over Bethany 53-52 Wednesday, spoiling strong efforts from Kayla Taromina, who had 18 points and eight rebounds, and Audra Droginske, who tallied 12 ... The Bison nearly rallied from a nine-point second half deficit at Waynesburg, but a three-pointer at the buzzer was off and the Jackets escaped with a 60-58 win ... Anne Wilson posted three three-pointers to finish with a career-high 19 points and Droginske chipped in with 13.


Chatham Cougars (4-3, 1-1 PAC)

Chatham began Presidents' Athletic Conference (PAC) play this week as they hosted Waynesburg University

before traveling to Kentucky to take on defending PAC champions Thomas More College ... The Cougars earned a victory at home against Waynesburg, marking the team's first win in a conference opener since they joined the PAC ... Junior Kayla Hilko led Chatham with 15 points and 10 rebounds, and earned her first career "double-double" ... On the road in Kentucky, the 13th-ranked Saints handed the Cougars their first PAC loss of the season ... Hilko was the only Cougar to finish in double digits, scoring a team-high 13 points in the loss.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (3-4)


Grove City Wolverines (2-4, 1-1 PAC)


Thiel Tomcats (2-5, 0-0 PAC)

W&J, ranked 19th by D3hoops.com and 21st in the WBCA USA Today/ESPN Top 25 last week, suffered its first defeat of the season Saturday, falling to Grove City 72-70 at the Henry Memorial Center ... The Presidents shot a season-best 55 percent (27-of-49), but the Wolver-



ines connected on a school-record 12 three pointers to secure the upset victory ... Senior PG Kennan Killeen kept the game close for W&J, as she fired in a season-best 24 points in the two-point loss ... The Presidents used a strong defensive effort in a 72-55 victory against Geneva to begin the week ... W&J held the Golden Tornadoes defense in check, allowing them to shot just 32 percent (19-of-60) from the field.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (2-3, 1-1 PAC)

Thomas More Saints at Westminster* (12/12)




