## PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

#### LEIGH SULKOWSKI

Washington & Jefferson College 5-11 Freshman Guard Upper St. Clair, Pa./Upper St. Clair H.S.

Sulkowski averaged 26.0 points per game and shot 71% (37-of-52) from the field last week, leading W&J to a 3-0 week and the program's first-ever 6-0 start. She was named MVP of the Bethany Classic after averaging 22.0 points, 6.5 rebounds and 4.0 steals in two wins. She added a career-high 34 points on 15-of-22 shooting in a 70-41 win over Penn State-Behrend.

Also nominated was junior forward **Katie Hardie** of Bethany, junior forward **Leigh LaGare** of Grove City, junior guard **Amanda Swanson** of Thiel, freshman guard **Candice Eyerman** of Waynesburg, and senior guard **Jaime Lynn** of Westminster.

## PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

#### Bethany Bison

Bethany ran its winning streak to six with three home wins last week ... Ten different Bison hit the scorebook, led by Katie Hardie's 16 points and 13 rebounds, in Bethany's 80-47 drubbing of Point Park ... In Bethany's Holiday Classic over the weekend, the Bison went 2-0 ... In Friday's 66-61 win over Ohio Wesleyan, guard Nikki Babik went 6-6 from the foul line in final 26 seconds to seal the win ... In the Frostburg win, Kelley Richardson erupted for 31 points and 13 rebounds in the 25-point victory (92-67) ... Hardie (21.5 points, 10 rebounds, 3.5 assists) and Babik (18 points, 4.5 rebounds) earned All-Tournament Team honors.

#### Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J has won its first six games for the first time in school history ... The Presidents are winning with defense as they have held opponents to 49.3 points per game and are forcing 25.3 turnovers per contest ... Freshman G Leigh Sulkowski recorded her first collegiate double-double with a career-high 34 points and 11 rebounds in leading W&J past Penn State-Behrend on Wednesday ... She drained 15-of-22 shots in posting the fifth-highest single-game point total in school history ... Senior F Amy Strosnider added 16 points, five rebounds and five steals ... Junior G Shawndra McDonald netted 13 points and dished out nine assists against Frostburg State, while Strosnider added 12 points and four boards.

#### **Grove City Lady Wolverines**

: Grove City continues to search for its first victory of the season after two losses against Ohio colleges ... Leigh LeGare led Grove City with 15 points and 12 boards against Otterbein, her first career double-double ... Abby Moose also scored a season-high 15 points for Grove City ... Jocelyn Kempema led the Lady Wolverines with a career-high 12 points at Baldwin-Wallace ... Grove City has dropped five straight to teams from Ohio ... The Lady Wolverines last defeated an Ohio college Jan. 13, 2001 when they beat Ursuline, 55-40, in Pepper Pike, Ohio.

#### Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg continues to ride the sharp shooting of freshman Candice Eyerman, as the Jackets split two games at the Salisbury Optimist Classic this weekend after home wins versus Chatham (72-40) on Tuesday, and Penn State-Altoona (88-83) on Wednesday ... The Jackets needed double overtime to defeat Penn State-Altoona, as Eyerman broke a school record with eight three-pointers in the game ... Everman shot 8-of-17 from behind the arc, scoring 28 points ... She broke her own school record in the consolation game of the Optimist Classic on Saturday with nine treys, leading the Jackets with 31 points over Lehman (97-74) ... Waynesburg lost to Newport News Apprentice (70-52) in the first round.

#### **Thiel Tomcats**

Thiel picked up its first wins of the season last week, finishing 2-1 with wins over Pitt-Greensburg (75-57) and Medaille (65-44) ... The Tomcats held a 37-18 advantage in rebounds in their 18-point victory over Pitt-Greensburg ... Junior G Amanda Swanson led four scorers in double figures with 15 points and a game-high seven rebounds ... Thiel shot just 32% from the field in their 89-51 loss at Case Western Reserve, who is ranked 17th in the nation in the latest D3Hoops.com poll ... Freshman Erin Leyde led the Tomcats with 10 points in their 21 point win over Medaille.

#### Westminster Lady Titans

Westminster dropped three games last week, giving the Lady Titans four straight losses since winning their first two games ... In a 59-48 loss to undefeated Otterbein on Tuesday, sophomore F Erica Tallo tallied a game-high and season-high 18 points, while also grabbing nine rebounds and posting a team-best three blocks ... Senior F Samor Himes tied her season-high in rebounds with a gamehigh 13 boards, while senior G Jennifer Petures dished out a team-high five assists ... Senior G Ashley Kenney had team-high totals of 15 points, nine rebounds and four steals versus Alma ... Senior G Jaime Lynn scored 10 points against Hope and was the lone Lady Titan named to the Hope All-Tournament team.
