# PAC Women's Basketball Player of the Week

5-7 Sophomore Guard Clearfield, PA/Clearfield H.S.

Swanson averaged 13.3 points and 9.7 rebounds per game in three Thiel games last week, as the Tomcats went 2-1 with wins over Pitt-Greensburg and La Roche and a loss to #21-ranked Case Western Reserve. She registered her first "double double" of the season vs. La Roche, posting 14 points and 12 rebounds. For the season, she ranks first on the team in rebounding (7.7 rpg) and second in scoring (11.3 ppg).

Also nominated was sophomore forward **Kelley Richardson** of Bethany and sophomore guard **Shawndra McDonald** of Washington & Jefferson.

## Bethany Bison

Cold shooting did in any hopes the Bison had of upsetting Division II West Liberty State last Wednesday, as the Bison fell 89-67 ... Bethany shot just 29 percent (20-70) for the game, while the Hilltoppers buried 16 three-point attempts ... Forward **Kelley Richardson** continued her streak of double-doubles, with 22 points and 12 rebounds, marking the sixth game in a row that the 6-0 sophomore has posted double figures in points and rebounds ... Forward **Katie Hardie** was the only other Bison in double figures with 12 points, while adding a team-best nine rebounds.

### Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Sophomore guard Shawndra McDonald scored a game-high 19 points and added 12 rebounds, eight assists and five steals to lead Washington & Jefferson to a 69-63 victory over Point Park on Tuesday evening in Washington, Pa.... The Presidents trailed by as many as nine points in the first half and 34-31 at halftime, but fought back to claim the six-point win ... Sophomore guard Rachel Armitage helped bring the Presidents back by draining a three pointer with 1:46 left to tie the game at 63-63 ... Freshman center Tracy Weaver scored 17 points and grabbed 10 boards. while Armitage notched 15 markers ... Freshman forward Bobbi Jo Hibbitts added 12 points and seven rebounds.

## **Grove City Lady Wolverines**

The Lady Wolverines suffered a pair of lopsided losses last week, shooting just 26.4% (32-121) from the floor and averaging 26 turnovers per game ... Three of their four defeats this season have been decided by 19 points or more ... On the flip side, their two victories were decided by margins of 31 and 27 points.

## Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg dropped its only game of the week at Mount Aloysius ... No score was reported.

## Thiel Tomcats

The Cats played to a 2-1 week, with wins over Pitt-Greensburg (74-54) and La Roche (49-46) sandwiched around a loss to #21 Case Western Reserve (77-57) ... Amanda Swanson led Thiel in scoring in both of the final two contests, recording 17 points and 9 rebounds in the CWRU game and 14 points and 12 boards in the victory over La Roche.

### Westminster Lady Titans

Westminster posted a 1-2 week, starting with a 78-55 loss at NCAA Division II Slippery Rock on Wednesday ... Over the weekend, the Lady Titans went 1-1 and placed third at the Nan Nichols Classic host by the College of Wooster, falling to eventual champion Thomas More 65-57 before topping Notre Dame (OH) 70-66 in the consolation game ... On Wednesday at SRU, senior guard Robin Thayer became just the fifth player in Lady Titan basketball history to surpass the 1,000point plateau with a jumper just three minutes into the game ... Thayer was named to the All-Tournament team at the Nichols Classic, averaging 14.0 ppg in the two games... She now ranks fourth all-time in scoring at WC (1,036 points).
