Thiel College 5-8 sophomore forward Boardman, Ohio Cardinal Mooney H.S.



Bodrick earned her second PAC Player of the Week honor this season after averaging 31.5 points, 13.5 rebounds, 2.5

steals, 2.0 blocks and 2.0 assists for the 1-1 Tomcats last week. She posted a 25-point, 11-rebound double-double in a 57-49 non-league win at Hiram Wednesday, then recorded a PAC season-high 38 points along with 16 rebounds, four steals, three assists and two blocks in a 76-75 loss at Bethany in Thiel's PAC opener.

Also nominated was sophomore C **Renee Brandenburg** of Bethany, senior G **Elyse Bogusz** of Grove City, junior F **Kristen Humphrey** of Thomas More, freshman G **Stephanie Smith** of Washington & Jefferson, sophomore F **Michaelene Jones** of Waynesburg, and senior G **Desiree Sterling** of Westminster.

Bethany Bison

The Bison ran their win streak to three with a triumph at Chatham and a buzzer-beater win over Thiel ... In the 63-38 win at Chatham, G **Brooke Orange** hit five three-pointers for a career-high 19 points ... BC held the Cougars to

15 second half points and held a 50-29 advantage on the glass ... Saturday vs. Thiel, G **Nicole Thompson** banked in a three-pointer as the horn sounded to give Bethany a 76-75 win ... The Bison trailed by nine at halftime, but a back-and-forth second half saw 11 ties and 11 lead changes ... G **Lisa Mitchell** scored 19 of her 21 points in the second half and Thompson finished with 15 points and four rebounds ... C **Renee Brandenburg** delivered her second career double-double with 12 points and a career-high 17 boards.



Thiel Tomcats

Thiel went 1-1 last week, earning a 57-49 win at Hiram Wednesday before falling at Bethany in its PAC opener Saturday, 76-75 ... Sophomore F **Amber Bodrick** finished with 25 points and 11 rebounds at Hiram ... Senior F **Fontella Jones** scored 11 points, grabbed 10 rebounds and added five steals and

two assists ... A three-point buzzer-beater lifted Bethany to a 76-75 victory over Thiel Saturday ... The Tomcats were down 73-70 when senior G **Nicole Valentino** hit her biggest shot of the day, a three-pointer to tie the contest with 47 seconds left ... Bethany's next possession resulted in a turnover, and Bodrick netted the go-ahead jumper with 23 seconds left ... Bodrick scored 38 points and grabbed 16 rebounds ... Valentino added 20 points, while Jones netted 10 points with 10 boards.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents

Westminster snapped the Presidents' four-game win streak following a 64-54 victory Saturday ... W&J has lost back-to-back games at Buzz Ridl Gymnasium ... W&J held the lead for a majority of the first half and stretched the lead to seven points three minutes into the second half before

a three-pointer gave the hosts the lead for good with 5:50 left ... Freshman G **Stephanie Smith** connected on five triples in the first half and finished with 16 points to lead W&J ... Freshman PG **Kennan Killeen** was the only other President in double figures with 11 ... Four players scored in double digits in the seven-point win over CMU Tuesday ... Sophomore G **Kaleigh Bangor** posted a teamhigh 14 points and freshman F **Maggie Gibson** collected a doubledouble with 12 points and 11 boards ... W&J forced 21 turnovers.



Westminster Titans

Westminster has now won five of its last six games after splitting two games last week ... The Titans lost at Allegheny, 73-66, Tuesday before beating Washington & Jefferson, 64-54, Saturday in PAC play ... Senior G **Desiree Sterling** led the team with 20 points at Allegheny and 14 vs. W&J, while junior F/C **Emilee Ackerman** bucketed 15 and a team-high 16, respectively ... Westminster had an 18-point lead erased in the Allegheny game, as the Gators went on a 21-4 run covering six minutes between the first and second

halves ... The Titans led with two minutes remaining before Allegheny scored the game's final nine points ... The Titans then came back from seven points in the second half to beat the Presidents on Saturday.



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City took an early share of first place in the PAC Saturday with a 57-44 win over Waynesburg ... The Wolverines yielded just 12 first-half points ... **Shannon Overdorff** fired in 17 points while **Elyse Bogusz** added 15

... GCC committed a season-low 15 turnovers ... Overdorff also had eight boards and four assists ... Grove City earned its first victory of 2006-07 Thursday by pulling out a 69-66 win at Carnegie Mellon ... Junior C **Rachel McCoy** scored twice in the final minute to help erase a 66-63 hole ... Overdorff and Bogusz each had 18 points while freshman **Krista Beechy** added 13 points, five assists and four steals ... Tuesday, Bogusz fired in five three-pointers in a 21-point outing, but the Wolverines fell to visiting Juniata, 55-53.



Thomas More Saints

Winners of six straight, the Thomas More Saints are off to its best start in school history – tying the 1997-98

season at 6-1 ... Thomas More kicked off its PAC slate with a 10point win over Saint Vincent after downing traditional NCAC power Wittenberg earlier in the week ... It was strong defense that enabled the Saints to post the wins they allowed just an average of 42 points ... Junior **Kristen Humphrey** averaged 10.5 points and 5.5 rebounds, while senior **Megan Wood** added 10 points and 6.5 boards ... Senior **Brooke Warner** average nine rebounds and six assists for the Saints.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Yellow Jackets opened the week and the home portion of their schedule in dramatic fashion Monday, as senior G **Katie Lewandowski** hit the game-winning shot with four seconds left in a 61-59 win over

Penn State-Altoona ... Lewandowski scored 13 points off the bench, including eight of the final 12 Yellow Jacket points ... Fellow senior **Jenna Pratte** had a season-high 14 points, while sophomore **Sarah Gossett** added 11 off the bench ... Waynesburg made an 18-point comeback Saturday, but fell 57-44 in the PAC opener at Grove City ... Sophomore F **Michaelene Jones** registered a double-double with 12 points and a career-high 15 rebounds ... Waynesburg struggled from the field against the Wolverines, shooting only 27.6 percent (16-of-58).
