## PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL 2011-12 - Week 4 Conference Notes

**HOLIDAY BREAK:** The PAC women's basketball schedule for 2011 concluded on Saturday with the final of four PAC December playing dates, as league action will now resume on Jan. 4, 2012 ... Five-time defending PAC champion Thomas More is one of three teams that remain unbeaten atop the PAC standings at the holiday break, as the 4-0 Saints are joined by fellow NCAA Division III national playoff participant Saint Vincent and 2011 ECAC titlist Waynesburg at the top.

**NEWS AND NOTES:** Junior G **Allison Long** helped Thomas More remain unbeaten in the PAC by averaging 14.0 ppg and 5.0 apg in a 2-0 week ... Freshman G **Elle Collins** averaged 15.5 ppg for 2-0 Saint Vincent ... Waynesburg junior G **Jessi Drayer** poured in a career-high 31 points vs. Chatham ... Junior G **Leah Gibson** accounted for nearly half her team's offense as she fired in 23 points for Grove City in a 48-36 PAC win over Geneva ... Junior G **Kelly Muffley** fired in 20.5 ppg for 1-1 Thiel.

**AROUND THE LEAGUE:** Junior F **Katie Hughes** came off the bench to average 13.5 ppg and 9.5 rpg for 1-1 Westminster ... Junior G/F **Kayla Taormina** led Bethany to a 1-1 week by averaging a double-double with 11.5 ppg and 10.5 rpg ... Senior G **Marguerite Sargent** averaged 15.0 ppg for 0-2 Chatham, including 18 markers and five assists at Waynesburg ... **Beth DeLuca** had 17 points for Geneva in a loss to Grove City ... Senior PG **Vanessa Rivera** averaged 7.0 ppg for 0-2 W&J.

# PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

## Bethany Bison (4-4, 3-1 PAC)



The Bison ran its win streak to four with a convincing win at Chatham, but the string was broken with a loss to Thomas More Saturday ... A 22-3 run in the second half allowed BC to pull away from the Cougars for a 72-48 win and take their PAC record to 3-0 for the first time since 2003-04 ... **Audra Droginske** hit for 17 off the bench and **Anne Wilson** and **Kayla Taormina** each had 12, while Taormina grabbed 11 rebounds for a double-double ... Taormina made it back-to-back doubles-doubles with 11 points and 10 rebounds against Thomas More, but the Saints pulled away in the 2<sup>nd</sup> half for an 83-64 win ... Bethany was led by **Taylor Verrico**, who hit four three-pointers for a career-high 14 markers.

## Chatham Cougars (2-6, 0-4 PAC)



Basketball ended the week 0-2 with a home loss against Bethany, 72-48, and a loss at Waynesburg, 81-54 ... **Andie Gaetano** and **Margeurite Sargent** were the scoring leaders in both games ... Gaetano led the team with 14 points and pulled down six rebounds Wednesday, while Sargent added 12 points ... **Lizz King** also added six boards ... Against Waynesburg, Sargent led the team with 18 points and five assists ... Gaetano added 11 points ... **Carly Zelenak** led the Cougars with eight rebounds ... Zelenak is currently ranked 5th in the PAC averaging 7.5 rebounds a game.

## Geneva Golden Tornadoes (1-7, 0-4 PAC)



Geneva has dropped seven straight games and is still in search of its first win in the PAC ... Last week, the Golden Tornadoes dropped games to PAC foes Waynesburg and Grove City ... Geneva has an overall record of 1-7 and a 0-4 mark in PAC play ... **Beth DeLuca** tried to carry Geneva to its first victory Saturday, as she scored a team best 17 points in the loss at Grove City ... The GTs should get a lift from the return of **Samantha Fisher**, who joined the team for the first time Saturday after spending the first semester in Rome ... The Golden Tornadoes will have an extended time off the court before heading to New Orleans after Christmas for two games at the Big Easy Classic.

## Grove City Wolverines (2-6, 1-3 PAC)



Grove City earned its first PAC win Saturday by warding off Geneva 48-36 ... The Wolverines' iron-clad defense limited Geneva to 18 percent (5-of-27) shooting from the floor and just 13 points in the second half ... GCC held Geneva without a field goal for the final 7:22 of the fray ... **Leah Gibson** led Grove City with 23 points and **Kelsey Shirey** added 11 points ... The Wolverines have won seven straight against Geneva ... Shirey fired in 15 points and **Megan Gebrosky** added 13 points Wednesday night in a setback at Saint Vincent ... **Hannah Jo Coneby** contributed 10 points ... Gebrosky became the fourth player in program history with 100 or more three-point goals.

## Saint Vincent Bearcats (7-1, 4-0 PAC)



SVC remained unbeaten in PAC play this week, earning wins over Grove City and Thiel ... Wednesday, SVC used a 20-0 run in the first half to pull ahead early against the Wolverines ... Reigning PAC Player of the Year **Brittany Sedlock** led all scorers with 21 points on 7-of-10 from the field ... Freshman **Elle Collins** was the only other Bearcat in double-figures as SVC used a balanced scoring attack in the win ... In Saturday's 79-66 win at Thiel, four-players scoring in double-digits, led by Collins pouring in a season- and game-high 19 points ... Senior **Emily Fenton** added 13 points and junior **Devin McGrath** finished just shy of a triple-double with a final line of 12 points, 12 rebounds, eight assists and three steals.

## Thiel Tomcats (2-7, 2-2 PAC)



The Tomcats split a pair of contests to move to 2-2 in PAC play ... In the first contest of the week, the Tomcats defeated the Titans of Westminster 57-52 in overtime ... A three-pointer by Titan **Emily Dolsak** with 52 seconds to play sent the game into OT ... In the overtime frame, the Tomcats outscored Westminster 11-6 ... Junior G **Kelly Muffley** was vital in the Tomcat victory, with seven of her game-high 23 points coming in the extra frame ... In the second game of the week, Thiel was defeated by Saint Vincent 79-66 ... The Tomcats showed a lot of heart as they cut a 26-point Bearcat lead to just eight, but were unable to make it any closer as they fell for the first time at home ... Muffley notched 18 points.

## Thomas More Saints (6-1, 4-0 PAC)



Thomas More, which is ranked No. 17 in the WBCA Top-25, won a pair of PAC games last week as it defeated W&J, 63-43, and Bethany, 83-64 ... Junior G **Allison Long** led the team in scoring with 14.0 ppg as she had 11 against W&J and 17 against Bethany ... Sophomore G **Katie Kitchen** and junior C **Katie Kees** both also averaged in double-figures with 12.5 and 12.0 ppg respectively ... Sophomore F **Moriah Corey** led the team on the boards with 7.5 rebounds per game, while Long led the team in assists with 10 ... For the season, Kitchen leads the team in scoring with 16.9 ppg., and Corey leads the team on the boards with 7.1 rpg. ... The Saints are shooting 45.5 percent from the field.

## Washington & Jefferson Presidents (3-5, 1-3 PAC)



W&J has lost three straight PAC games overall following defeats to Thomas More and Westminster last week ... W&J made just 1-of-18 three-point attempts against the Saints and shot 31 percent (15-49) for the game ... Senior F **Courtney Walsh** led the Presidents with a game-high 14 points on 5-of-7 shooting ... W&J opened up with five straight points against Westminster, but the Titans answered with a 30-3 run and the Presidents were unable to recover ... Senior F **Ashley Kirkpatrick** and Walsh both scored 10 points to pace the team ... Senior PG **Vanessa Rivera** moved into fifth place all-time on the career assist list at W&J with 288.

## Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (6-2, 4-0 PAC)



The Yellow Jackets continued on its current four-game win streak, all against PAC opponents, with wins over Geneva and Chatham ... The Jackets jumped out to a big early lead and never looked back in their 78-28 win over the GTs ... Waynesburg followed the same formula in an 81-54 home triumph over Chatham ... Four different Jackets averaged double digits in scoring over the two victories, including junior G **Jessi Drayer**, who poured in a career-high 31 points vs. Chatham and averaged 17.5 ppg ... Senior PG **Hannah Hunter** averaged 12.5 points, 8.5 assists, 7.0 rebounds and two steals per contest ... Freshman G **Hayden Giuliani** and sophomore **Elaine Hasek** each averaged 12.0 ppg.

## Westminster Titans (1-7, 1-3 PAC)



After losing the first seven games of the season, including four by five points or fewer, Westminster picked up its first win in decisive fashion as the Titans won at W&J, 65-49, Saturday ... The Titans finished 1-1 on the week after losing to Thiel, 57-52, in overtime at home Wednesday ... Sophomore G **Gabby Holko** tied a WC school record for 3-pointers in a game vs. W&J ... Holko came off the bench and scored a career-high 18 points, all coming on six three-pointers ... Holko shot 6-of-9 from the field and 6-of-8 from three-point range ... Holko tied **Desiree Sterling** for the record,, who had six 3-pointers vs. Waynesburg Feb. 10, 2007. Senior F **Emily Dolsak** posted 15 points and seven boards in the win.
