She had 22 points and 11 rebounds in a 74-63 win at Hiram, then recorded a game-high 24 points and five boards in Grove City's 65-63 win over 6-0 Waynesburg. Slater scored 17 of her 24 points in the second half, helping the Wolverines erase an eight-point halftime deficit.




Bethany Bison (5-4, 1-1 PAC)

Saint Vincent Bearcats (7-1, 3-0 PAC)


Thomas More Saints (7-0, 3-0 PAC)

For the season, the Saints are led in scoring by Tolliver with 15.7 ppg., and Dickman with 11.7 ppg., and is led on the boards by Dickman with 8.4 rpg.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (6-1, 2-1 PAC)

Waynesburg lost for the first timethis season, 65-63 at Grove City ... The Yellow Jackets led 63-62 with just over a minute to play, but Grove City made



Chatham Cougars (4-6, 1-3 PAC)

Chatham took on visiting Westminster and Saint Vincent this week ... The Cougars earned their first ever victory over Westminster in school history wining 60-50 ... Chatham went on a 12-2 run, with nine of these pts coming from the charity stripe ... Kayla Hilko scored a season-high 22 pts, 19 of them in the second half, including nine in the final 3:34 of play ... Brittany Brown tallied 14 pts and seven rebounds ... Against St. Vincent, the Cougars were able to hold the Bearcats to their lowest pts scored this season, but they were unable to come away with the win ... Chatham was held to 27% shooting from the field in the loss and committed 22 turnovers ... Brown led with 12 pts and eight rebounds, followed closely by Hilko with 11 pts.

Grove City Wolverines (4-4, 1-2 PAC)

Grove City earned wins over two previously undefeated teams last week to move to 4-4 overall ... Wednesday, Leah Gibson rifled in 28 pts as the Wolverines downed

4-0 Hiram, 74-63 ... Gibson hit five three-pt goals ... Christine Slater recorded a 22-pt, 11-rebound double-double ... Megan Gebrosky had a career-high seven assists ... Saturday, Grove City pulled out a 65-63 win over 6-0 Waynesburg ... Slater fired in 17 of her game-high 24 pts in the second half ... Gibson added 11 pts and eight rebounds while Alison Wells chipped in with nine pts ... The Wolverines own a 17-game win streak against Waynesburg ... Slater moved into fourth all-time at Grove City in scoring with 1,271 pts.

Thiel Tomcats (1-7, 0-2 PAC)

The Tomcats finished the week with an 0-2 record dropping a non-conference game to Denison University and falling to 0-2 on the conference after los-

ing to W&J 75-39 ... Freshman forward Leanna Yeager was the lone bright spot for Thiel this week as she had 13 points on 6-13 shooting against Denison and was one of two Tomcats with 8 points against W&J ..Thiel will look to get back on track against Hiram on Sunday the 19th.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (4-5, 2-0 PAC)

W&J clamped down defensively Saturday at the Henry Memorial Center and held Thiel to four second-half field goals in a 75-39 rout of the Tomcats ... W&J has held opponents to 40 or less points eight times since the start of the 2007-08 season ... Sophomore guard Emily

Abraham hit 3-of-4 three-pointers and led all scorers with 15 points, while juniors Blair Cotton (11 points, 4 rebounds) and Kayla Strimel (10 points, six rebounds) both scored in double figures ... W&J held a 43-29 rebounding advantage and shot 58 percent in the second half ... The Presidents had 11 different scorers and outscored Thiel 41-17 in the second half.

Westminster Titans (2-7, 0-4 PAC)

Westminster is in the midst of a six-game losing streak after two PAC losses last week at Chatham, 60-50 and No. 11-ranked Thomas

The Titans' starting five combined for just 17 pts at Thomas More as Gabby Holko led the Titans with nine pts in just 12 minutes on 3-4 shooting from 3-point range.







The Wolverines return to conference play January 6 at Bethany ... Grove City senior Christine Slater has 1,271 points, which ranks fourth all-time at Grove City ... Christine Carlson (1987-91) is third with 1,337 points and Theresa Berg (1989-93) is second at 1,347 points ... Carlson will be inducted into Grove City's Hall of Fame in February ... Berg entered the Hall last January.
