a 70-50 win over Hilbert in the consolation game of the Behrend Winter Classic Saturday ... Grove City let sizeable halftime leads against 8-2 Geneva (32-22) and 8-0 Montclair State (36-29) dissipate earlier in the week ... Misty Wadowsky earned All-Tournament honors at Behrend Saturday with a 15-point, 11-rebound double-double while guard Abby Moose added 14 points in Saturday's win ... Leigh LeGare led Grove City with an 18point, 13-rebound effort Friday night while Jocelyn Kempema tossed in 15 ... LeGare also had a dozen points and nine boards against Geneva while Sandy O'Keefe blocked six shots ... Grove City is idle until Jan. 3.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg lost its lone game of the week to visiting Pitt-Greensburg, as the Bobcats went on a 13-0 run late in the second half to win 73-60 ... The Jackets led by as much as 10 points in the first half, before trailing by as much as 16 in the second half ... The Bobcats led by 10 points, before Waynesburg was able to cut the lead to 56-53 with 6:21 left on a three-pointer by Rachel Dillon ... Pitt-Greensburg then went on its 13-0 run, as it held the Jackets scoreless for four minutes ... Candice Eyerman led the Jackets with 16 points, including four three-pointers ... Her trey with 2:49 left in the first half gave Waynesburg its largest lead at 35-25 ... Junior F Michelle Collins posted her second double-double of the season with 10 points and 10 rebounds.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel returned to the court Saturday after a 17-day layoff and lost to Notre Dame College 85-48 in South Euclid, Ohio ... The Tomcats shot just 19 percent from the floor in the first half and finished the game shooting just 29 percent ... Thiel got out to an early 6-2 lead, but was outscored 18-2 over the next 6:06 and trailed 44-16 at the half ... The Falcons managed to extend their second-half lead and register the 37-point win ...
