PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL 2009-10 - Week 5 Conference Notes

SAINTS STILL UNBEATEN: The final slate of PAC contests prior to the holiday break took place on Saturday (Dec. 12) ... Defending PAC champion Thomas More led by just four at the half, but pulled away in the second half of a 78-55 win at Westminster to stay unbeaten ... W&J and Saint Vincent have just one loss each, as the Presidents topped Thiel 67-42 and the Bearcats edged Chatham 76-66 ... Bethany defeated Geneva 60-55, while Grove City won at Waynesburg 76-56.

NEWS & NOTES: Thomas More is ranked 9th in NCAA Division III by WBCA/USA Today and 10th by D3Hoops.com ... Chatham junior G **Barb Petty** bucketed a career-high 24 points in a PAC loss to Saint Vincent ... **Brittany Sedlock** paced SVC with 20 points and 13 boards against the Cougars ... Sophomore G **Anne Wilson** scored a game-high 18 points for Bethany in a PAC win over Geneva ... Senior F **Maggie Gibson** averaged 18.0 ppg and 9.5 rpg for 2-0 Washington & Jefferson.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Senior **Renee Rawding** of Geneva became the 12th 1,000-point scorer in GT women's basketball history against P.S.-Greater Allegheny ... Grove City junior F **Christine Slater** averaged 22 ppg, 5.5 rpg and 5.0 apg in two wins ... Westminster freshman G **Jenn Cantella** averaged 13.5 ppg for the 1-1 Titans last week ... Junior F **Elisha Jones** of Waynesburg had 16 points and seven rebounds against Grove City ... **Ashley Davis** had 10 points for Thiel in a loss to W&J.

PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison (3-5, 0-2 PAC)



Bethany picked up a pair of wins at home last week, besting Pitt-Bradford 68-55 and Geneva 60-55 ... In the UP-B victory, **Renee Shepherd** went 5-for-6 from the arc and set career-highs with 19 points and 13 boards, while **Anne Wilson** tallied 13 and **Kayla Taormina** notched 12 ... Against Geneva, the Bison led by as many as 10 in the second half and held off a GT rally for the victory ... Wilson tossed in a game-high 18 points off 4-for-5 shooting from the arc ... **Taylor Kress** recorded her first career double-double with 11 points and 12 rebounds, while Shepherd had eight points and set a new career-high by hauling down 14 boards to help the Green & White hold a 52-35 rebounding advantage.

Chatham Cougars (4-5, 1-2 PAC)



Chatham fell in both of its PAC match-ups last week, first on the road to Westminster and then at home to Saint Vincent ... Because of Saint Vincent's NCAA Division III provisional status, however, the result does not count in the PAC standings ... Against Westminster, the Cougars were led by first year F **Andre'a Thompson**, who scored a team- and game-high 19 points and also grabbed nine rebounds ... Teammate **Lizz King** added 11 points ... Vs. St. Vincent, Barb Petty connected on 6-of-9 three-point attempts and finished with a game- and career-high 24 points ... Petty tied the school record for most three-pointers in a single game, and as a team, Chatham set a new school single-game record with 12 three-pointers made.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (4-5)



Geneva's women's basketball team split a pair of games last week including a victory over Penn State Greater Allegheny and a loss to PAC foe Bethany Saturday ... In the 88-49 victory over Penn State, senior **Renee Rawding** become the 12th female player in school history to reach the 1,000-point plateau ... She joins her sister **Jen Rawding**, who is the school's all-time leading scorer ... **Val Hamilton** and **Beth DeLuca** led the scoring against the Lions with 13 points each with **Liz DePietro** adding 12 points off the bench ... Saturday, Geneva was just 4-of-22 from three-point range and allowed 21 offensive rebounds in falling to Bethany ... **Alyse Scarsella** led Geneva with 15 points.

Grove City Wolverines (4-4, 2-1 PAC)



Grove City improved to 2-1 in the PAC Saturday by pulling away to a 76-56 win at Waynesburg ... **Christine Slater** paced Grove City with 24 points, eight rebounds and six assists while **Krista Beechy** added 15 points ... **Leah Gibson** also reached double figures with 14 points, including a dozen in the first half ... That trio scored Grove City's first 34 points of the game ... Defensively, the Wolverines forced 30 turnovers ... Wednesday, Grove City earned a 60-36 non-conference win over visiting Hiram ... Slater led Grove City with 19 points while **Megan Gebrosky** added 11 ... The 36 points allowed represents the lowest opponent point total by a Grove City foe since GCC downed Westminster on December 6, 2008, 40-36.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (6-1)



The Bearcats were victorious in their only action of the week, running their winning streak to five with a 76-66 comeback win at Chatham on Saturday afternoon ... Trailing by as many as 12 points in the second half, SVC ended the game on a 30-12 run to seal the win ... Sophomore **Brittany Sedlock** was the star of the game for SVC, scoring 20 points to go with 13 rebounds and three steals ... **Emily Fenton** added 11 points and **Devyn McGrath** 10, as six Saint Vincent players scored at least six points ... The Bearcat defense forced 32 turnovers and tallied 14 steals, with **Melissa Mansur** and McGrath ending up with four thefts apiece.

Thiel Tomcats (2-6, 0-1 PAC)



The women of Thiel College basketball couldn't make up for a first half shooting performance of 21 percent as they lost, 67-42, to the Presidents of Washington & Jefferson College.

Thomas More Saints (7-0, 3-0 PAC)



The Saints, which moved up four spots in last week's WBCA Top-25 to No. 9, defeated Westminster, 78-55, to remain undefeated ... Junior C **Nicole Dickman** led the way with a game-high 16 points and six rebounds ... Also reaching double-figure scoring against the Titans was junior F **Amy Stultz** and freshman G **Chelsea Tolliver** with 11 points each, and junior F **Dana Bors** with 10 points ... The PAC-leading Saints are led in scoring and rebounding by Dickman, who averages 13.4 points per game and 9.0 rebounds per game ... As a team, Thomas More is shooting 49 percent from the field on 200-of-408 shooting and have 91 steals and 25 blocked shots.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (7-1, 1-1 PAC)



After suffering its first loss of the season last Saturday against Grove City, W&J regrouped and earned back-to-back victories against Ohio Wesleyan (65-54) and Thiel (67-42) ... W&J senior F **Maggie Gibson** leads the PAC in rebounding (10.3 rpg) and is the only player in the conference to average a double-double (13.1 ppg) ... She is five boards away from becoming the all-time leading rebounder in school history (**Heather Dawkins** - 942) ... The Presidents are idle for two weeks before returning to action at the Surf City Classic in Irvine, Calif. (Dec. 29-30) ... W&J opens the tournament against Wisconsin-River Falls and takes on SUNY-Purchase on day two.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (2-4, 1-2 PAC)



The Waynesburg women's hoopsters fell to Grove City by the final of 76-56 on Saturday ... Turnovers played a big part in the defeat, as the Yellow Jackets turned the ball over 30 times in the contest ... Junior F **Elisha Jones** led the Jackets in scoring with 16 points and tied for the team high in rebounds with seven ... She also blocked a game-high four shots.

Westminster Titans (3-6, 2-1 PAC)



Westminster posted a 1-1 record in two PAC home games last week, including a 62-50 win over Chatham Wednesday and a 78-55 loss to No. 9 Thomas More Saturday ... Freshman G **Jenn Cantella** was the only Titan to average double figures during the week with 13.5 ppg, including a sizzling 7-of-11 (.636) shooting from 3-point range ... Cantella came off the bench and scored 13 points vs. Chatham before tying a career-high with 14 points vs. Thomas More in her first career start ... Cantella started for the team's leading scorer **Amy Dolsak**, who was injured vs. Chatham and did not play vs. TMC ... Sophomore F **Emily Dolsak** scored nine points in the Chatham win.

PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL PREVIEWS

Bethany Bison at Denison (12/15) at Ohio Wesleyan (12/18)



The Bison will close out the first semester with two road games against NCAC opponents this week ... On Tuesday, they travel to Denison, who Bethany is 7-2 against all-time ... Last year, BC shot 52 percent from the floor en route to a 76-63 triumph over the Bid Red, who would later go on to win 16 straight and capture the NCAC regular season title ... The team that beat Denison in the NCAC Tournament to earn the conference's bid to the NCAA Tournament was Ohio Wesleyan, who hosts Bethany Friday night ... It will be the first meeting between the schools since 2002 when Bethany grabbed a 66-61 victory over OWU ... The Bishops lead the series 6-2.

Chatham Cougars No Games Scheduled



Chatham will not be in action again until after the New Year, when they will host Penn State-Fayette in a non-conference contest on Sunday, January 3rd at 5 p.m. ... The Cougars will pick up PAC play that same week, as they host Grove City College on Tuesday, January 5th and round out the week by traveling to Geneva College on Saturday, January 9th ... Due to Geneva's NCAA Division III provisional status, the result of this contest will not count towards overall PAC standings ... Tip-offs are scheduled for 7 p.m. and 3 p.m., respectively.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes No Games Scheduled



Geneva will not play until it hosts Carlow on December 30th ... The Golden Tornadoes return to PAC play on January 2nd when they travel to Thomas More.

Grove City Wolverines No Games Scheduled

Saint Vincent Bearcats No Games Scheduled



The Bearcats will have a nine-day layoff for finals before returning to action on Dec. 21st, when they travel to John Carroll for the first ever meeting between the two teams... Over the past two seasons, Saint Vincent is 9-3 against non-PAC opponents, and 7-1 against non-conference D-III foes... Through the first seven games of the season, SVC has boasted a balanced scoring attack, as five players average at least eight points, led by **Maria Baroffio's** 13.1 points per game and **Brittany Sedlock's** 12.9... The team's defense has been just as impressive, as SVC has forced an average of 34 turnovers per game, while committing 18.
