Moose led the Lady Wolverines to their first win of the season, a 75-39 victory at Hiram, in the team's only game last week. She scored a season-high 22 points and added five assists against the Terriers, shooting 8-of-14 from the field and 3-of-6 from three-point range.

Also nominated was sophomore guard **Nikki Babik** of Bethany, senior guard **Mayumi Sasaki** of Thiel, and freshman guard **Candice Eyerman** of Waynesburg.

Bethany Bison

The Bison had a six-game winning streak stopped at Otterbein before rebounding with a win at Denison ... The Cardinals shot 53 percent from the floor as they upended Bethany ... Kelley Richardson had 23 points and 13 rebounds, while Jenny Place totaled a career-high 20 points on 9-13 shooting ... At Denison, the game was tied 26-26 before a 12-0 Bison run before halftime ... Nikki Babik had nine of the 12 points during the run and 18 for the game ... Katie Hardie shook off a sluggish first half to record 21 markers and 13 boards, while Kiki Cohen fired in 12 ... The win was the 99th in the career of Bethany head coach Jina DeRubbo, who will try to become the second Bethany coach to reach 100 wins.

W&J, which has won its first six games for the first time in school history, was off last week ... The Presidents will not play again until the Elizabethtown Tournament on Jan. 4-5, 2003.

Grove City Lady Wolverines

The Lady Wolverines snapped a sevengame losing streak dating back to last season with a 36-point victory at Hiram on Wednesday night ... **Abby Moose** fired in 22 points and tallied five steals while **Jocelyn Kempema** added 10 points in her first collegiate start ... Grove City went 17-for-18 at the foul line and held Hiram to 5-of-26 (19 percent) shooting from the field in the second half ... Grove City also dominated on the glass, grabbing 18 offensive rebounds while Hiram had just 16 defensive boards ... In all, Grove City out-rebounded the Terriers, 49-30.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

In the team's lone game of the week, Waynesburg fell victim to Pitt-Greensburg's home-court dominance Saturday, as the Jackets lost 68-57 in non-conference action ... The Bobcats (4-3) have won eight straight games at home dating back to Jan. 28 ... Jess Porter led the team with 16 points ... Waynesburg (5-3) led at the half, 36-34, but could only manage 21 second-half points ... Freshman Candice Eyerman netted 14 points, including four threes, while classmate Trista Murphy pitched in with 10 points ... The Jackets won five of their last six before Saturday's game.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel defeated Pitt-Bradford 72-42 Saturday in the only action of the week for the Tomcats ... The Tomcats outscored the Panthers 43-26 in the second half and finished shooting 45% from the floor after averaging 34% through their first six games ...
