The PAC conference schedule will re-open with a full slate of contests on Saturday, Jan. 3, 2009 ... The next PAC women's basketball release will be available on Monday, Jan. 5, 2009. WHO'S HOT: Despite not playing last week, Thomas More (7-0) moved up to No. 5 in both the WBCA and <u>D3Hoops.com</u> polls ... Michawn Rich of Geneva posted 31 points and 19 boards in a 65-55 loss to Bethany ... Renee Brandenburg averaged 15.0 points, 9.5 rebounds and 2.0 blocks for 2-0 Bethany ... Saint Vincent improved to 6-0 with a 70-67 win at Waynesburg, as freshman Emily Fenton bucketed a career-high 19 points ... Waynesburg sophomore F Elisha Jones tallied 20 points in a 70-67 loss to Saint Vincent. AROUND THE LEAGUE: Catie Sieber averaged 14.5 ppg for 2-0 Thiel last week ... W&J junior F Maggie Gibson is averaging a double double (12.1 ppg, 11.1 rpg) this season ... Grove City extended its win streak to three with a 54-51 win over Allegheny, as **Raeann Szelong** broke a 49-49 tie with a three-point play in the final minute ... **Kaitlin McCarthy** scored 15 points for Westminster in an 82-65 loss at Point Park ... **Bria Battocchi** posted 10 points and six rebounds for Chatham in a 61-41 loss to Thiel.

PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison (3-6, 0-2 PAC)

The Bison snapped out of an early-season slump with victories over Denison and at Geneva ... Bethany scored 15 consecutive points after Denison

notched the opening basket of the game and built a 32-12 lead in the 1st half ... The Big Red, the 4-time defending NCAC Tournament champions, cut it to four at one time in the 2nd half, but BC used a 15-4 spurt to pull away ... Kelly Goode scored 18 and Renee Brandenburg recorded her 5th career double-double with 17 points and 10 rebounds ... The Bison raced to a 21-3 lead out of the gate at Geneva, but GTs rallied to get within 2 early in the 2nd half ... BC would gradually pull away, aided by a 13-5 run midway through the period.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (3-4)



The Golden Tornadoes could not overcome a slow start that saw them fall behind Bethany 21-3 in the first six minutes Saturday ... Geneva rallied behind GOLDEN TORNADOES senior Michawn Rich to cut the lead to just three

points at halftime, but the GTs could never gain the lead ... The loss was Geneva's third straight as it fell to 3-4 before a 17-day lay-off for the Christmas holiday ... Despite the loss, Michawn Rich turned in a career performance ... With 20 points in the first half, Rich ended the game with a career high 31 points and a career best 19 rebounds ... Beth DeLuca, who was making her first collegiate start, posted 14 points in the game . Geneva will be back in action at Carlow on December 30.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (6-0)

The Lady Bearcats remained perfect on the season, improving to 6-0 with a 70-67 comeback win at Waynesburg Saturday ... Freshman Emily Fenton spurred the comeback, scoring 12 straight points over

a two-minute span midway through the second half, giving SVC its first lead of the night, 46-44, with eight minutes left to play ... SVC's lead stretched to 11 with just over a minute left, before the Lady Bearcats put down a late Waynesburg rally to earn the road win ... Fenton led the victors with a career-high 19 points, going 8-of-11 from the field ... Janelle Reed scored 15 points to join Fenton in double figures, while a total of 10 Lady Bearcats scored at least three points.

Thomas More Saints (7-0, 2-0 PAC)



Thomas More (7-0, 2-0 PAC) moved up to No. 5 last week in both the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) and D3hoops.com polls ...

Through the Saints' first seven games, senior G Jayme Thiem leads the team in scoring as she is averaging 14.6 ppg., and has dished out a team-high 28 assists ... Sophomore C Nicole Dickman leads the team in rebounding with 6.9 rpg, and is also shooting 68.3 percent from the floor as she has connected on 41-of-60 shots from the field.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (2-4, 2-0 PAC)



Waynesburg put a scare into unbeaten Saint Vincent on Saturday, but ultimately fell 70-67 to the Bearcats, ending a modest two-game winning streak ... After

leading for almost the entire first half, the Yellow Jackets lost the lead in the second and fell behind by 11 with 1:57 left on the clock ... However, the Jackets were able to close the gap to just two points with 25 seconds left ... Unfortunately for the home team, Saint Vincent was able to hit key free throws down the stretch to seal the win ... Freshman Jacket F Callie White led all scorers with 21 points ... Sophomore F Elisha Jones chipped in 20 points, five rebounds and three blocks ... Junior Johnna Deco ripped down a game-best 13 rebounds.

Chatham Cougars (3-3, 0-2 PAC)



Chatham University dropped a conference game to Thiel by a final score of 61-41 ... The contest was close through

most of the contest as Thiel held a three-point lead midway through the second half ... The Cougars were outplayed on both ends of the floor over the final 10 minutes and Thiel pulled away to earn the PAC win ... Chatham was led by first-year Bria Battocchi with 10 points and six rebounds.

Grove City Wolverines (3-5, 1-1 PAC)



Grove City extended its win streak to three Wednesday night by humbling Allegheny, 54-51 ... Raeann Szelong broke a 49-49 tie in the final minute with a three-point

play while Laura Miller sealed the win with a pair of free throws Christine Slater led GCC with a game-high 18 points and a game-high nine rebounds ... Miller added nine points while Jenna Johnston contributed eight points and nine boards ... Krista Beechy had four assists and a pair of blocks ... Grove City limited Allegheny to just 36.7 percent shooting from the field ... The game featured just three ties and one lead change ... The Wolverines will visit Carnegie Mellon December 31 in non-conference play ... PAC play resumes January 3 against Chatham.

Thiel Tomcats (5-4, 1-2 PAC)



After dropping their first two conference games, Thiel picked up its first PAC victory with a 61-41 win over Chatham ... Senior F Amber Bodrick broke out of her

recent slump by scoring a season-high 28 points and grabbing 13 boards, while senior G Catie Sieber dropped in 15 and amassed seven rebounds ... The Cougars could only manage shooting 30% from the field against a Tomcat defense that forced 23 turnovers ... Thiel out-rebounded Chatham 54-30 and scored a total of 34 points off Cougar turnovers... Defense was key in Thiel's second game of the week as they defeated Hiram, 51-37... Leading the way for Thiel was Bodrick, who posted 13 points, 11 rebounds, two blocked shots and three steals.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (6-1, 2-0 PAC)

The Washington & Jefferson women's basketball program was idle this past week, but will return to action on Thursday evening, traveling to Cleveland, Ohio, for a 6 p.m. contest with Case Western Reserve ... The Presidents are currently in a three-way tie with Thomas More



and Waynesburg for first place in the conference ... Senior F Emily Hays, who is averaging 16.4 points a game, is the leading scorer for W&J and ranks fourth in the PAC in the same category ... Junior F Maggie Gibson is one of only two players in the PAC to average a double-double (12.1 ppg, 11.1 rpg).


Westminster Titans (2-5, 0-1 PAC)
