In just 15 minutes of action, Gee tallied 18 points on 7-of-9 shooting from the floor, including 4-of-6 beyond the three-point arc, to lead unbeaten and No. 9 ranked Thomas More to a 90-43 non-conference home win over Cincinnati city rival Mount St. Joseph on Saturday.

Bethany Bison

The Bison completed the first half of their season on December 8 with an overtime loss to Geneva ... The narrow defeat gave Bethany a 4-5 record for the second consecutive year ... The Bison, who were off last week, return to action on Saturday, January 5 at PAC rival Thiel.



Chatham Cougars

Chatham was off last week and returns to the hardwood this Wednesday at Gallaudet ... The Chatham University basketball team recently made a \$1,000 donation to Coaches vs. Cancer® and the American Cancer Society ... The money was collected during the 1st Annual Chatham University Tip-Off Tournament hosted by Chatham November 16-17, 2007 ... The team sponsored a 'Purple Reign' promotion where the proceeds from t-shirt sales, donations, and a portion of the admission fee would be given to Coaches vs. Cancer and the American Cancer Society.



Geneva Golden Tornadoes

Geneva extended its school record for wins to start a season to nine with a 24-point win over Penn State Beaver on Saturday ... Head coach **Ron Galbreath** notched his 100th victory in his six-year career with the Golden Tornadoes ... **Renee Rawding** posted 20 points and **Michawn Rich** registered her third double-double of the season with 16 points and 12 rebounds ... Geneva will enjoy three weeks off before looking to extend its streak in 2008 ... Geneva ended the year 2007 with a combined record of 26-3 dating back to the spring ... The Golden Tornadoes are just three wins shy of tying the school record of 12 consecutive victories set in 1978.



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City concluded 2007 Dec. 10 with a 57-44 loss at Penn State Behrend ... Grove City led early in the second half, 24-23, but Behrend pulled away down the stretch ... Sophomore **Krista Beechy** led Grove City with 13 points and nine rebounds ... It is Beechy's third straight double-digit scoring effort ... Forwards **Brittany Anderson** and **Christine Slater** both added 10 points each ... After scoring 77 points in the season opener, Grove City has not scored more than 60 points since ... The Wolverines are holding opponents to just 59 points per game.



Saint Vincent Bearcats

The Bearcats participated in the Warner Southern College Holiday Classic in Lake Wales, Fla., over the weekend, dropping a pair of close contests ... In Friday's 68-60 defeat to Goshen, SVC junior **Janelle Reed** led all scorers with 23 points, while classmate **Lauren Reilly** recorded a double-double with 11 points and 11 rebounds while adding five steals ... Saturday vs. Pikeville, Reed again led everyone with 21 points, while senior C **Caryn Glassbrenner** scored 16 points and grabbed a career-high 15 rebounds ... Reed has now scored at least 21 points in four straight contests, averaging 25.8 points over that span.

Dickman grabbed a team-high seven rebounds while junior **Gabby Johnson** and sophomore **Alicia Williams** each dished out four assists.

The two teams have a long rivalry, as both were former members of the NAIA's American Midwest Conference before joining the PAC ... The Golden Tornadoes beat Saint Vincent 71-55 on November 25th of last season, but the Bearcats have won 12 of 17 games against Geneva dating back to the 1998-99 campaign.

Thiel is 17-32 all-time against Bethany, despite winning three of the last five meetings ... The Tomcats claimed a 76-73 victory over the Bison on Jan. 27, 2007 at Beeghly Gymnasium ... Junior G/F **Amber Bodrick** finished with 20 points and seven rebounds ... Bodrick has averaged 35.3 points and 11.5 rebounds in four contests (2-2) vs. the Bison.

The Yellow Jackets then return to PAC play Saturday with a home game against nationally-ranked Thomas More, who has won three of the four meetings since joining the conference.

The Titans also won all three meetings with W&J, including a 57-51 win in the PAC semifinals.
