Bethany Bison

Bethany played its final game before the semester break on Dec. 9, when the Bison pulled out a 76-75 victory over Thiel at the buzzer off a three-pointer from **Nicole Thompson** ... Bethany will return to the floor Jan. 3 in a home game

against Case Western Reserve before starting PAC play again on Jan. 6 against Grove City.



Grove City Wolverines

Slow starts to each half helped doom Grove City in a 66-50 loss to Allegheny ... Allegheny opened the game with a 21-7 run ... Grove City closed to within 31-29 at the break but Allegheny opened the second half with a 13-

0 run ... **Shannon Overdorff** led Grove City with a dozen points while **Rachel McCoy** added 11 points ... Grove City shot just 8 of 30 (27 percent) from the floor in the second half ... The Wolverines will now play four straight and six of seven games on the road.



Thiel Tomcats

Thiel earned a 68-55 home victory over La Roche Saturday in its only action of the week ... Senior G **Nicole Valentino** and sophomore G **Jena Cook** each finished with 25 points in the win ... Valentino finished with 25 points on 7-of-15 shooting (3-of-5 from three-point range), 10

rebounds and four assists ... Cook totaled a career-high 25 points on 10-of-17 shooting (3-of-4 from three-point range) and five rebounds ... The Tomcats finished with a 52-41 advantage in total rebounds and outscored La Roche 31-7 in bench points.



Thomas More Saints

Thomas More overcame a 13-point deficit in the second half to get off to the best start in school history with a

7-1 start after topping local rival Mount St. Joseph 66-59 on Saturday ... Junior **Tangie Sellers** scored a career-high 18 points with six rebounds in the win ... It was the second time this season she has reached double figures in scoring ... Senior **Megan Wood** recorded 15 points and six rebounds, and has now scored in double figures in six of eight games ... Junior **Kristen Humphrey**, who has also reached double digits in six of eight games, added 11 points and nine boards.
