CANDICE EYERMAN Waynesburg College

5-5 Senior Guard Cranberry Township, Pa./Seneca Valley H.S.

Eyerman scored a game-high 17 points, including two gamewinning free throws with less than a second to play, and added seven rebounds as the Yellow Jackets overcame an 11-point second half deficit to edge La Roche 55-54. Her 12 points (on four three-pointers) led a 20-8 run over a three-minute span which helped Waynesburg erase the double-digit deficit.

Also nominated was freshman G **Caelyn DiSanti** of Bethany, sophomore G **Shannon Overdorff** of Grove City, junior F **Megan Wood** of Thomas More, and senior PG **Dayna Greenfield** of Washington & Jefferson.

But the Bison ran cold again, hitting just one of eight from the floor, while the Cardinals went 12 of 15 from the line to clinch the win ... **Jenny Place** recorded 18 points, while DiSanti and Zemba each scored 14.



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City erased a nine-point deficit in the second half to earn a 72-60 win at Allegheny Wednesday ... The 72 points are a seasonhigh for GCC ... The Wolverines held Allegheny to just 29 percent (8-of-28) shooting from

the floor in the second half ... Shannon Overdorff led Grove City with 18 points while Elyse Bogusz added 13, all in the second half ... Bogusz scored eight straight points during one stretch in the second half, helping Grove City take the lead for good ... Tammy Hess added 10 points while Rachel McCoy blocked six shots ... As a team, the Wolverines swatted a season-high 10 shots ... F Brittany Anderson hit two three-point goals in the win ... She had just one three in 35 career games prior.



Thomas More Saints

The Saints returned to action on Saturday, after taking a week off for exams, to post a 68-58 win over rival Mt.

St. Joseph ... It was the second time this season TMC was victorious over the Lions ... Juniors **Brooke Warner** and **Megan Wood** each scored 13 points for the Saints in the win ... Sophomore **Jennifer Teski** added a career-high 10 points off the bench as the TMC reserves dominated their Ohio counterparts, 24-3.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents

Washington & Jefferson, ranked 21st in the latest <u>D3hoops.com</u> national poll, dominated Marietta on the glass Wednesday by holding a 52-26 edge and cruised to a 28-point triumph ... Senior G **Leigh Sulkowski** posted a double-double with 21 points and 10 rebounds to lead the Presidents ... W&J ran out to a 19-point halftime lead and

senior PG **Dayna Greenfield** put the game away with four secondhalf three-pointers as Washington & Jefferson cruised home ... Greenfield finished with 17 points, while senior C **Sheana Malyszka** added eight points, seven rebounds and two assists ... W&J shot 46 percent and handed out 23 assists, while limiting the Pioneers to 35 percent shooting.

During the run, Eyerman scored 12 points - all three-pointers - including a trey to cut the lead to a one-point deficit, 49-48 ... Freshman F **Michaelene Jones** converted a lay-up with 3:04 to give WC its first lead of the game, 50-49 ... Junior F **Denise Kennedy** joined Eyerman in double figures, as she scored 13 and added six rebounds.

Bethany Bison

vs. Heidelberg (12/30 - 7 p.m.)

Bethany is off until just before the new year, when they will host Heidelberg on Dec. 30 ... This will be just the fourth all-time meeting be-

tween the teams, with HC holding a 2-1 advantage ... The last time the teams squared off will be exactly six years to the day, as the Bison knocked off Heidelberg 66-60 on Dec. 30, 1999 ... It will be the third of four contests this season for the Bison against OAC opponents ... The Bison have lost to Baldwin-Wallace and Otterbein and will play Capital on Jan. 3 just before opening conference play.



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City is off until a home date with Pitt-Greensburg on Jan. 3, 2006 ... The Wolverines will play seven games in a 15-day span, starting with the Pitt-Greensburg game.

In the second game of a stretch in which the Saints will play five of six at home, Thomas More will face old-AMC rival Bluffton ... Thomas More holds a slim 13-12 margin but has dominated the series of late, claiming seven straight – including last season 's 69-58 win at Bluffton ... **Megan Wood** had 17 points and six boards, while **Brooke Warner** added 13 points in the win ... The Saints then close 2005 with a home contest against Wisconsin-Platteville on Dec. 30.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents

vs. Capital (12/19 - 6 p.m.) at Land of Magic Classic (12/28-29)

W&J and Capital meet Monday in one of the region's top games of the year ... The only previous meeting between the two schools occurred in the first round of the 1995 NCAA D-III playoffs

when the Crusaders took a 74-50 decision in Columbus ... Fifthranked Capital (8-1) had its eight-game win streak snapped by #10 Baldwin-Wallace Saturday (59-54) ... The Presidents will travel to Daytona Beach on Dec. 28-29 for their first-ever meetings with Minnesota-Morris and Presentation ... Minnesota-Morris enters the Land of Magic Classic at 3-5 overall, while Presentation is 2-3 ... The games will be the first-ever played by a W&J women's basketball team in the state of Florida.

Westminster Lady Titans

The Lady Titans play three games to conclude 2005, starting with a non-league road contest at La Roche ... Westminster posted a decisive 70-42 victory over the Redhawks in New Wilmington last season, as **Erin Morrow** led a balanced scoring attack with 10 points and **Katie Roycroft** grabbed a team-best seven re-

bounds ... The Lady Titans host Carnegie Mellon on Tuesday, whome they defeated in Pittsburgh 67-64 last season behind a 17-point, 12-rebound double-double from **Erica Tallo** ... A matchup at NAIA member Seton Hill in Greensburg ends the year.
