# PAC WOMEN'S BASKETBALL 2009-10 - Week 6 Conference Notes

**HOLIDAY GIFTS:** Thiel earned an early Christmas gift with a 52-48 win over Hiram, snapping a three game losing streak ... Waynesburg split its two games last week, ending up with a win last week over La Roche, 79-67 ... Thomas More remained undefeated after a 70-55 triumph over Wittenberg ... Many PAC teams are on a break for the holiday, some returning to tournaments the last week of the month ... Wash. & Jeff. will travel the furthest by competing in the Surf City Classic in California. **NEWS & NOTES:** Thomas More takes on two new opponents for its women's basketball program when it travels to Florida for the Daytona Beach Shootout ... On Dec. 28, the Saints face Emory & Henry and then will play either Rutgers-Camden or Trinity (Conn.) on Dec. 29 ... Geneva and Carlow will meet on Dec. 30 in a rematch from a game earlier this season at the La Roche College Tourney ... The Golden Tornadoes defeated the Celtics 70-60 that night and hold a decisive 32-10 edge in the all-time series. **AROUND THE LEAGUE:** Thiel's **Kelly Barzack** came out as the Tomcats most well-rounded performance with13 points, 11 rebounds and three steals in the game against Hiram ... Teammate **Rianne Thornton** finished the same game with a team-high 14 points, six rebounds and two steals ... Saint Vincent is averaging a PAC-high 79.9 points per game, and all six wins have come by 10 points or more, including four by 30+ points ... Defensively, the Bearcats force 34.4 turnovers/game and earned 120 steals.

first half, but the Big Red rallied to take 11-point halftime lead and went on to a 61-48 victory ... **Kayla Taormina** fired in 15 and **Renee Shepherd** tallied 12 in the setback ... After sitting through more than hour delay at Ohio Wesleyan because of a mix-up with the officials, the Bison fell behind by 11 at halftime and suffered a 58-45 defeat at OWU ... **Katelynn Hackathorn** recorded her first career double-double by totaling 16 points and a career-high 10 boards off the bench, while Taormina amassed 12 markers, eight rebounds and five assists.

Senior **Renee Rawding**, who recently eclipsed the 1000 point plateau for her career, leads Geneva


