PAC TOURNAMENT FIRST ROUND GAMES - 2/20/07

First Round Game #1 - Bethany, W.Va. - 6 p.m. #4 BETHANY 65, #5 Waynesburg 61

The homestanding Bison raced to a 10-point (32-22) halftime, only to see the Yellow Jackets rally to tie the game late, the last at 59-59 with a minute to place. Bethany went ahead for good on a driving layup by junior G Lisa Mitchell (Burgettstown, PA/Avella H.S.) with 47.6 seconds left, then secured a charging call on Waynesburg's next possession to take control down the stretch. Mitchell led four Bison scorers in double figures with a game-high 16 points, while freshman G Nicole Thompson (Wheeling, WV/ John Marshall H.S.) added 14 markers of 5-of-5 shooting from the floor to go along with a game-high six assists. Waynesburg was paced by senior G Katie Lewandowski (Pittsburgh, PA/North Catholic H.S.) with team-high totals of 13 points and five assists, while sophomore F Michaelene Jones (Steubenville, OH/ Steubenville H.S.) added 10 points in the loss.

First Round Game #2 - Washington, Pa. - 6 p.m. #3 WASHINGTON & JEFFERSON 73, #6 Thiel 48

The defending PAC champion Presidents raced to a 42-24 halftime lead and were not threatened in the second half as they advanced to the semifinals with a 25-point win over the Tomcats. For W&J, sophomore F Emily Hays (Youngstown, OH/Boardman H.S.) led the way with 16 points and eight rebounds. Freshman G Kennan Killeen (Pittsburgh, PA/Mount Lebanon H.S.) added 13 points and four assists for Washington & Jefferson. Thiel was paced by sophomore F Amber Bodrick (Boardman, OH/Cardinal Mooney H.S.) with a team-high 14 points, while senior G/F Nicole Valentino (Sharon, PA/Sharon H.S.) added nine markers in defeat.

First Round Game #3 - New Wilmington, Pa. - 7 p.m. #2 WESTMINSTER 67, #7 Grove City 46

The Titans led 33-18 at the half, only to see Grove City rally early in the second period and cut the lead to five points (38-33) early in the second half. Westminster then went on an 8-0 run to take control and held a double-digit lead the rest of the way. Senior G **Desiree Sterling (Newton Falls, OH/Newton Falls H.S.)** paced the victors with 17 points, while junior G/F **Emilee Ackerman (Greensburg, PA/Hempfield H.S.)** added 14. No players scored in double figures for the Wolverines, who were paced by junior C **Rachel McCoy (East Liverpool, OH/Beaver Local H.S.)** with nine points.

PAC TOURNAMENT SEMIFINAL GAMES - 2/23/07 Semifinal Game #1 - Crestview Hills, Ky. - 6 p.m.

<u>#2 Westminster 57, #3 Washington & Jefferson 51</u> The Titans took a 30-24 halftime advantage and led by as many 17 points (51-34) with 3:54 to play before holding off a furious W&J rally to post the win. Senior guard **Desiree Sterling (Newton Falls, OH/Newton Falls H.S.)** led the way for Westminster with gamehigh totals of 16 points and nine rebounds. Senior G **Nicole Fee** (**New Castle, PA/Neshannock H.S.**) added 12 markers off the bench, while senior G **Rachel Eaton (Rimersburg, PA/Union H.S.)** totaled 11. For the Presidents, sophomore F **Emily Hays (Youngstown, OH/Boardman H.S.)** and junior F **Maria Hillenbrand** (**Berwyn, PA/Conestoga H.S.)** led a balanced scoring attack with 10 points each.

Semifinal Game #2 - Crestview Hills, Ky. - 8 p.m. #1 THOMAS MORE 62, #4 Bethany 49

The top-seeded Saints struggled early, trailing the Bison by six points early before taking a narrow one-point (26-25) halftime lead. TMC broke a 35-35 tie with 13:18 to play and outscored Bethany 27-14 the rest of the way. Senior G **Brooke Warner (Maineville, OH/Kings H.S.)** paced the victors with 21 points, while junior F **Tangie Sellers (Florence, KY/Boone County H.S.)** added 10 points and a game-high four blocks off the bench. Bethany was led by junior G **Lisa Mitchell (Burgettstown, PA/Avella H.S.)** with 21 points, while senior **F Courtney Irwin (Sturgeon, PA/South Fayette H.S.)** added 17 points and a game-high eight rebounds

PAC TOURNAMENT CHAMPIONSHIP - 2/24/07 Crestview Hills, Ky. - 2 p.m.

#1 THOMAS MORE 59, #2 Westminster 50 The homestanding Saints controlled play for much of the opening half and took a 29-18 advantage into halftime. Westminster crept back late in the game, closing within four points (54-50) with a minute to play. However, Thomas More held on to score the final five points and capture its first-ever PAC women's basketball title. Three Saint players scored in double figures, led by senior F Megan Wood (Falmouth, KY/Pendleton County H.S.) with a team-high 16 points on 7-of-8 shooting from the floor. Senior G Brooke Warner (Maineville, OH/Kings H.S.) and junior F Kristen Humphrey (New Richmond, OH/CHCA) each added double-doubles in the victory, with Warner tallying 13 points and 11 rebounds and Humphrey adding 14 points and 10 boards. For the Titans, junior G/F Emilee Ackerman (Greensburg, PA/Hempfield H.S.) scored a team-best 16 points, while senior G Desiree Sterling (Newton Falls, OH/ Newton Falls H.S.) and freshman C Rachel Martinko (Greensburg, PA/Hempfield H.S.) added 13 and 12 points, respectively.
